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Clementine

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Finished Quilt Size: 60" x 60"

Be sure to read through instructions before beginning. Cutting instructions include 1/4" seam allowance. Yardage is based on 42" of usable fabric width. All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) unless otherwise stated. Press all seams as you assemble your blocks. Border lengths given are exact measurements. You may want to cut borders slightly longer to allow for variations in seams and mitering corners.

Fabric Requirements & Cutting Instructions: _____

Dorothy Yellow 113.104.05.1 1 yard

Cut (2) 14-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut into (4) 14-1/2" squares and then cut each square on the diagonal in each direction to form (16) quarter square triangles (you will only need 14).

Oh My Darling Taupe 113.104.02.1 1 yard

Cut (2) 14-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut into (3) 14-1/4" squares and then cut each square on the diagonal in each direction to form (12) quarter square triangles (you will only need 10).

In The Orchard Taupe 113.104.06.1 1/2 yard

Cut (1) 14-1/4" x WOF strip. Subcut into (2) 14-1/4" squares and then cut each square on the diagonal in each direction to form (8) quarter square triangles.

Kiss the Cook Coral 113.104.03.1 1/2 yard

Cut (1) 14-1/4" x WOF strip. Subcut into (2) 14-1/4" squares and then cut each square on the diagonal in each direction to form (8) quarter square triangles.

Clementine Ticking Orange 113.104.07.1 1 yard

Cut (2) 14-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut into (3) 14-1/4" squares and then cut each square on the diagonal in each direction to form (12) quarter square triangles.
Cut (6) 1-1/2" x WOF strips from the remaining fabric for the inner border.

Clementine Blossom Ivory 113.104.01.1 1-1/2 yards

Cut (2) 5" x WOF strips. Subcut into (13) 5" squares and then cut each square on the diagonal in each direction to form (52) quarter square triangles.
Cut (6) 5-1/2" x WOF strips for outer border.

Spoonful of Sugar Yellow 113.104.04.3 1 yard

Cut (1) 19" x WOF strip. Subcut into (2) 9 squares and then cut each square on the diagonal in each direction to form (8) quarter square triangles.

Cut (1) 14-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut into (1) 14-1/2" square and then cut each square on the diagonal in each direction to form (4) quarter square triangles.

Spoonful of Sugar Taupe 113.104.04.2 1/2 yard

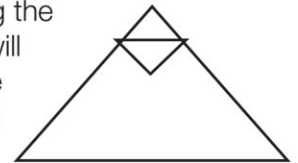
Cut (6) 2-1/2" x WOF strip for binding.

Backing - Any Clementine Print 3-3/4 yards

Piecing Instructions: _____

You will start by sewing (1) of the quarter square from the Clementine Blossom print to each of the other larger quarter square triangles (excluding the Spoonful of Sugar Yellow). You will be adding a total of (4) quarter square triangles to the Clementine Blossom squares to form your block.

Once you have finished joining the quarter square triangles you will trim away the excess from the larger quarter square triangles and press well.



Follow the picture provided - Join (4) of the completed units together to form the larger blocks; there will be 13 in total. Press well and square all blocks to 13".

To assemble the quilt top you will be working on the diagonal; starting and ending each row with the larger Spoonful of Sugar Yellow quarter square triangles. As a last step add the smaller Spoonful of Sugar Yellow quarter square triangles to each of the corners.

Add inner border first; left and right side followed by the top and bottom. Repeat for the outer border. Press.

Finishing: _____

Layer quilt top, batting and backing piece, wrong sides of fabrics both toward batting & baste. Hand quilt, machine quilt or tie as desired. Sew (6) 2-1/2" binding strips together in one continuous strip, iron in half lengthwise and sew to raw edge of quilt top.

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
