Splendid Hues

Please read all instructions carefully before starting. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut from selvage to selvage unless otherwise stated. This quilt contains multiple borders so sew all strips side by side to create a border set to be mitered once.

Green/Pink Quilt Instructions approximate size: 87" x 106"

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - *cut 6 - 11 1/2" x 11 1/2" squares (center designs evenly)

Fabric B - cut 6 - 8" x 8" squares (center designs evenly)

Fabric C - cut lengthwise 4 identical borders - 10 1/4" x LOF (approximately 117")

Fabric D - cut 2 - 12 1/2" strips, subcut 6 - 12 1/2" squares

cut 2 - 18 1/4" strips, subcut 3 - 18 1/4" squares, cut squares in half diagonally from both directions for 10 side triangles ☒

cut 2 - 9 3/8" x 9 3/8" squares, cut squares in half diagonally for 4 corner triangles ☐

Border - cut 10 - 2 1/2" strips

Fabric F - *cut 8 - 1" strips, subcut 12 - 1" x 11 1/2" and 12 - 1" x 12 1/2"

cut 3 - 6 7/8" strips, subcut 12 - 6 7/8" squares, cut squares in half diagonally for 24 triangles ☐

Fabric G - Borders: cut 10 - 2" strips

cut 10 - 1 1/2" strips

Fabric H - **cut 6 - 1" strips, subcut 12 - 1" x 8" and 12 - 1" x 9"

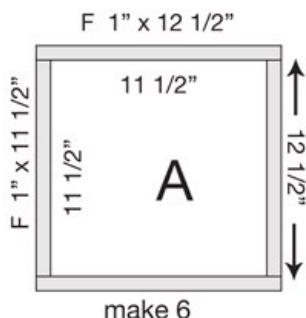
Cornerstones: cut 1 - 2" strips, subcut 17 - 2" squares
cut 1 - 3 3/8" strip, subcut 4 - 3 3/8" squares, cut squares in half diagonally from both directions for 14 triangles ☒

Fabric I - Sashing - cut 16 - 2" strips, subcut 48 - 2" x 12 1/2"

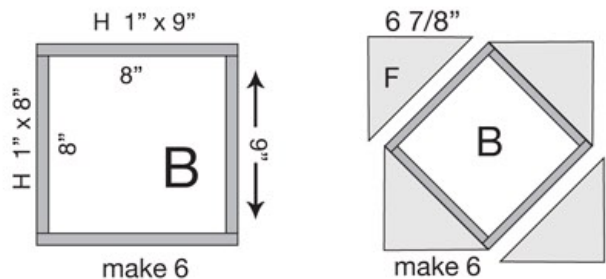
BINDING - cut 11 - 2 1/4" strips, sew end to end and press in half

2. Piecing Order:

1. Sew **F** 1" borders around 6 **A** 11 1/2" squares, SIDES first, then TOP and BOTTOM borders according to the diagram. *(If **A** measurements are slightly different, cut **F** borders slightly larger, sew around **A** blocks, then trim all **A** blocks to measure 12 1/2" x 12 1/2".)



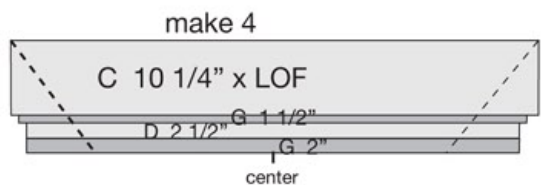
2. Sew **H** 1" borders around 6 **B** 8" squares, SIDES first, then TOP and BOTTOM borders. Next, sew **F** 6 7/8" triangles to all sides of **B** blocks, opposite sides first according to the diagram. Make 6 - 2" finished blocks (12 1/2" unf.)



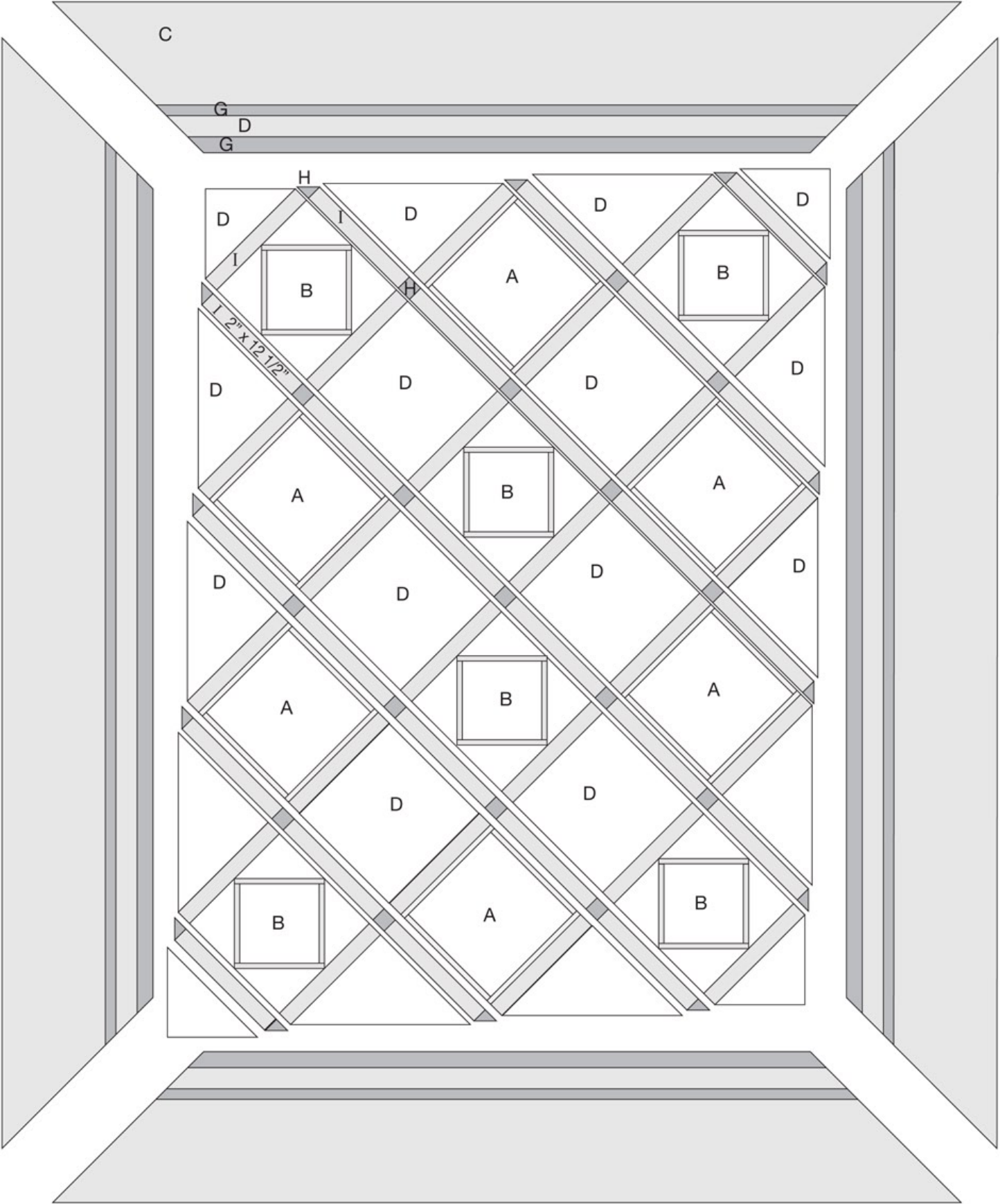
3. Sew quilt together by rows of blocks, sashing and cornerstones according to the diagram on the next page.

4. Borders: Make one border set of strips for each side of the quilt by sewing strips side by side. First, sew all **G** 2" strips end to end for one long strip, then subcut 2 strips approximately 100" long for both side borders and 2 strips approximately 80" long for the top and bottom borders. Repeat for all **D** 2 1/2" strips. Repeat for all **G** 1 1/2" strips.

Sew strips side by side according to the diagram. Center strips evenly by folding all strips in half and matching middle marks. Make 2 SIDE border sets and 2 TOP and BOTTOM border sets.



Sew borders to the quilt by centering evenly (fold borders and quilt in half then match middle marks). Sew SIDE borders first, then TOP and BOTTOM borders. Last, sew mitered angles.



5. The quilt measures approximately 87" x 106". Make backing (**Fabric E**) at least 6" larger than the top. Baste together top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric I**) and enjoy!!
