

FINISHED QUILT SIZE 57" x 57"

Finished Block Size 9" x 9"

Measurements include 1/4" seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1/4 yard main (C2560 Blue)
2 yard main (C2560 Yellow)
3/4 yard trees (C2561 Pink)
1/4 yard trees (C2561 White)
1/4 yard fruit (C2562 Pink)
1/4 yard fruit (C2562 White)
1/4 yard fruit (C2562 Yellow)
1/4 yard floral (C2563 Blue)
1/4 yard floral (C2563 Pink)
1/4 yard floral (C2563 White)
1/4 yard flower jacks (C2564 Blue)
1/4 yard flower jacks (C2564 Pink)
1/4 yard flower jacks (C2564 Yellow)
1/4 yard plaid (C2565 Blue)
1/4 yard plaid (C2565 Yellow)
1/4 yard mini dots (C2566 Green)
3/8 yard mini dots (C2566 Yellow)
3/4 yard clean white solid (C100-01 Clean White)
1/4 yard rosette solid (C100-81 Rosette)
Binding 5/8 yard
Backing 3 3/4 yards

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

Hoo's Block

Cut 32 squares 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" from yellow mini dots (C2566 Yellow).

Cut each square once diagonally to make 64 triangles.

Note: All triangle templates are best cut from a 5 3/8" strip.

Cut 64 triangle templates from clean white (C100-01 Clean White)

Cut triangle templates from the following printed fabrics:

4—C2560 Blue, 4—C2561 White, 4—C2562 Pink
4—C2562 White, 4—C2562 Yellow, 4—C2563 Blue
4—C2563 Pink, 8—C2563 White, 4—C2564 Blue
4—C2564 Pink, 4—C2564 Yellow, 4—C2565 Blue
4—C2565 Yellow, 4—C2566 Green, 4—C100-81 Rosette

Border 1

Cut 5 strips 4 1/2" x WOF from pink trees (C2561 Pink)

Border 2 (Cut directionally as shown in quilt photo.)

Cut 3 strips 7" x WOF from yellow main (C2560 Yellow) for the top and bottom borders.


Cut 2 strips 7" x 44 1/2" from yellow main (C2560 Yellow). Cut these borders lengthwise (parallel to selvage) for the side borders.

QUILT ASSEMBLY


Refer to quilt photo for placement of blocks.

Hoo's Block

These instructions are to make 1 block. Refer to the quilt photo for piece placement. Sew a clean white triangle to a printed fabric triangle. Repeat to make 4 sections. Sew the 4 sections together to make the center of the block. Sew the yellow mini dots triangles to each corner to finish the block. Refer to quilt photo to know whether to place the yellow mini dots on the clean white or printed fabric corners. See diagrams below. Repeat to make a total of 16 Hoo's Blocks.

Quilt Center Assembly

Refer to photo for block placement. Lay out blocks in 4 rows of 4. Sew blocks together to make rows. Sew rows together to complete the center of the quilt.

Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew side borders first.

Border 1

Side borders should be 36 1/2". Sew three 4 1/2" strips together end to end. Top and bottom borders should be 44 1/2".

Border 2

Sew 7" strips together end to end. Side borders should be 44 1/2". Top and bottom borders should be 57 1/2".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Riley Blake fabric from the Hoo's in the Forest Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
