


HEXAGON TRIVET OR TABLE TOPPER 16" x 14"




Note: When cutting through the black background, cut right in the middle, some widths vary in measurement. Numbers in diagram refer to instruction numbers. PANEL ONE:

- 1. Cut off each selvage on black line. Cut off two Stained Glass Borders at outermost gold line. Set aside for Trivet (along with border from #5 below).
- 2. Cut two sections with Leaf Rectangle next to border, on each selvage side. Cut each in two for 4 Napkins.
- 3. Cut one section of Leaf Rectangles with three across. Crosscut for 2 Placemats.
- 4. Cut remaining two into two for 2 Hot Pads.



- 5. Cut off each selvage on black line. Cut off one Stained Glass Border on gold line.
- 6. Cut one section with Leaf Rectangle next to border. Cut in half for 2 Napkins.
- 7. Cut right in the middle of black background between the Border & Leaf Rectangle, cutting off other Border. Set aside for Trivet.
- 8. Cut one section of Leaf Rectangles with three across. Crosscut for 2 Placemats.
- 9. Cut remaining piece into two sets, set aside for **Basket Liner**.



PANEL THREE:

- 10. Cut off each selvage on black line. Cut right in the middle of black background between Border & Leaf Rectangle for two full Borders. Set aside for Trivet.
- 11. Cut out a set of two, set aside for Basket Liner.
- 12. Set aside remaining Leaf Rectangles. They will be fussy-cut later for Runner.

WOF = Width of Fabric

RST = Right Sides Together

WST = Wrong Sides Together



FABRIC A - Autumn Breeze Panel - Cut according to details at left. Some will be fussy-cut further later. Label pieces for each project.

Four Placemats - 16 ½" x 13"



Fabric A: Four 15 1/4" x 11 1/4" with three Leaf Rectangles centered in each. Fabric C: Stained Glass Leaf - 3/4 vard

Backing, cut to match later.

Fabric D: Leaf Swirl, 3/4 yard - Border Cut eight 1 34" x WOF strips.

Batting: - 3/4 yard

Placemat Assembly:

1. Pin Fabric D Strips to sides of Fabric A RST. On Fabric A side sew on line of color & black

background. Trim ends after sewing. Press seams toward Border.

- 2. Pin RST & sew Fabric D Strips to top & bottom, same as above. Press seams toward Border.
- 3. Pin to Batting. Quilt as desired. Press. Trim excess Batting.
- 4. Pin RST to Fabric C & cut to match. Sew around leaving a 3" opening to turn on side. Clip corners & turn RSO. Press in opening to match, hand sew closed.
- 5. Stitch in the ditch to attach to back.

Six Napkins - 8 34" x 1034"

Fabric A: Six 11 1/4" x 9 1/2" with one Leaf Rectangle & Border.

Fabric C: Stained Glass Leaf - 2/3 vard

Backing - Cut to match. Napkin Assembly:

1. Pin Fabric A & Fabric C sets RST.

- 2. Sew around each leaving a 2" opening to turn on side. Clip corners & turn RSO.
- 3. Press in opening to match. Topstitch around and catch in opening to close.

Two Hot Pads - 4 1/2"

Fabric A: Two Leaf Rectangles Fabric B: Stained Glass -Cut two, to match

Batting & ThermoFoam -Cut two each 4 1/4" x 11"

Fabric A WSU = Fabric B RSU. Batting, ThermoFoam, foil side up

NAPKIN

#90 needle recommended for ThermoFoam

- 1. Layer & pin: ThermoFoam, foil side up; Batting; Fabric B RSU, Fabric A WSU on top.
- 2. Sew around each leaving a 3" opening to turn on side. Clip corners & turn RSO.
- 3. Hand sew closed. Press. Topstitch around inner border.

Trivet or Table Topper - 14" x 16"

Fabric A: Three 23 ½" x 6 ½" **Borders** & Three **Stained Glass Borders Fabric B:** Stained Glass - Fat Quarter or 18" x 16" or cut to match after piecing. **ThermoFoam** - 18" x 16" or cut to match after piecing.

Trivet Assembly: #90 needle recommended for ThermoFoam

 Pin wider black edge of Stained Glass Borders RST to Border Stripe next to bittersweet. Sew each. Press seams open. Repeat for other 2 sets.



- Using a 60° triangle template, cut two 60° triangles from each Border set with the bittersweet closer to top.
- Pin RST matching stripes on edges & not stretching bias edges. Starting at wider end, sew two sets of three triangles. Press each seam open after sewing.
- 4. Pin RST & sew hexagon halves on long side. Press seam open.

 Layer & pin: ThermoFoam foil side down, Fabric B RSU, and Pieced Hexagon WSU on top.

- 6. Sew around leaving a 4" opening to turn in center of a straight edge.
- 7. Clip corners & turn RSO. Hand sew closed. Press.

Pieced Hexagon WSU on top, Fabric B RSU, ThermoFoam,




8. Topstitch around inner borders. Quilt as desired.

Basket Liner - 18 1/2" x 10 3/4"

Fabric A: Three sets of two Leaf Rectangles
Fabric D: Leaf Swirl - Cut one 10" x 11 ½"

- Pin RST & sew Leaf Rectangles together on long sides, aligning rectangles.
 Sew just inside colored background on WS, so black doesn't show on RS.
 Pin RST & sew Fabric D to one end. Press seams open. Bring ends together RST and sew to form a tube. Fold end rectangles in half, line up seams & press.
- 2. Sew top & sew bottom leaving a 2" opening to turn. Clip corners & turn RSO.
- Press in opening to match. Topstitch around and catch in opening to close. Stitch in the ditch to secure.








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Table Runner - 40" x 12"


Fabric A - Autumn Breeze Panel - 1 panel Fabric C: Stained Glass - 3/8 yard for backing Batting - 3/8 yard





Fussy-cut ten 4¾" x 11¼"
Rectangles centered on background, by cutting <1/4" into black on each side of background. Black edges will be hidden in seams.

Assembly:


- 1. With RST, pin two sets of three **Leaf Rectangles** end to end. Sew & press seams open. *Diagram 1*
- 2. With RST, pin one set of four **Leaf Rectangles** end to end. Sew & press seams open.
- Finger press rows of three to find center point of middle rectangle. Pin RST to match up with center seam of row of four on each side. *Diagram 2*
- 4. Sew & press seams to outside.
- 5. Pin to Batting. Stitch in the ditch on two long seams to attach to front.
- 6. Trim excess Batting. Pin RST & cut Backing to match.
- Sew around leaving a 3" opening to turn on side. Pivot on seam at the inside corners. *Diagram 3*
- 8. Clip corners & inner corners. Turn RSO. Press in opening to match.
- Quilt around rectangle, stopping at leaf edges. *Diagram 3* Backstitch and start again on other side of leaf. Stitch in ditch on short horizontal seams or quilt as desired. Sew opening closed.







With Batting side up, sew around leaving 3" opening to turn. Pivot on seam at inside corners.



Clip inner & outer corners, turn & press. Quilt around rectangles, start & stop at leaves. Stitch in the ditch on short horizontal seams or quilt as desired. Sew opening closed.

Autumn Breeze Panel 6037-12 Black/Multi Fabric A: Three Panels with 12 rectangles each panel Approx. 2 yards

Batting: 1 1/8 yard 60° Triangle Ruler for Trivet

For heat resistant batting we like using InnControl Thermo-Foam: 1/2 yard
