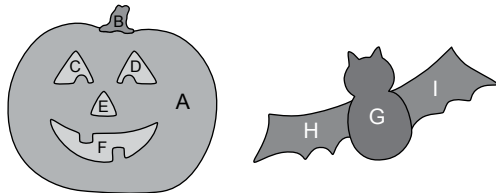

**FINISHED QUILT SIZE: 50½" x 50½"**

- Yardages are based on 40" fabric width.

### Materials

- 1½ yds. Orange/Black Dots (8JHG1) for center background and binding
- ¼ yd. Green/Yellow Stripe (7JHG3) for grass
- ⅛ yd. Purple Dots (8JHG4) for bats
- ⅛ yd. Purple/Green Stripe (7JHG2) for bats
- ¼ yd. Green Pumpkins (3JHG2) for jack-o-lanterns
- ¼ yd. Gray Cats (4JHG2) for jack-o-lanterns
- ¼ yd. Orange Silhouettes (5JHG3) for jack-o-lanterns
- ¼ yd. Orange Candy Corn (6JHG2) for jack-o-lanterns
- ⅓ yd. Orange/Purple Stripe (7JHG1) for jack-o-lanterns
- ⅜ yd. Purple Silhouettes (5JHG2) for jack-o-lanterns and border corners
- ⅛ yd. Green Dots (8JHG3) for jack-o-lanterns
- ⅓ yd. Yellow Dots (8JHG2) for jack-o-lanterns and lettering
- ⅜ yd. Multicolor Collage (2JHG1) for border corners
- 1⅛ yds. Multicolor Border Stripe (1JHG1) for border
- 3½ yds. for backing



**Important Note:** Appliqué templates do not include seam allowance. If using a fusible appliqué technique, follow the cutting and fusing instructions given on your fusible product. If using a traditional appliqué technique, you will need to add seam allowance to each template.

### Cutting

Cut strips across width of fabric, unless otherwise instructed.

From Orange/Black Dots, cut:

- 1 rectangle, 28½" x 32½", for center background
- 6 strips, 2½" x 40", for double-fold binding

From Green/Yellow Stripe, cut:

- 1 strip, 4½" x 32½", for grass

From Purple Dots, cut:

- 2 bat bodies, using Template G

From Purple/Green Stripe, cut:

- 2 bat wings, using Template H
- 2 bat wings, using Template I

From each of Green Pumpkins, Gray Cats, Orange Silhouettes, Orange Candy Corn, and Orange/Purple Stripe, cut:

- 1 jack-o-lantern, using Template A

From Purple Silhouettes, cut:

- 2 squares, 9⅞" x 9⅞"; cut each square once diagonally to make 4 triangles for border corners
- 1 jack-o-lantern, using Template A

From Green Dots, cut:

- 6 jack-o-lantern stems, using Template B

From Yellow Dots, cut:

- 6 jack-o-lantern faces, using Templates C, D, E, and F
- H-A-P-P-Y H-A-L-L-O-W-E-E-N, using the lettering templates

From Multicolor Collage, cut:

- 2 squares, 9⅞" x 9⅞"; cut each square once diagonally to make 4 triangles for border corners

From Multicolor Border Stripe, cut:

- 4 lengthwise strips, 9½" x 32½", for border

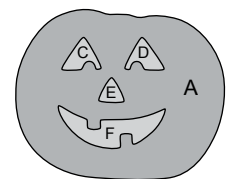
### Quilt Top Assembly

All seams ¼". Press seams in direction of arrows unless otherwise instructed. Refer to photograph for fabric placement.

1. Using Orange/Black Dots 28½" x 32½" rectangle, and Green/Yellow Stripe 4½" x 32½" strip, assemble the center background as shown.

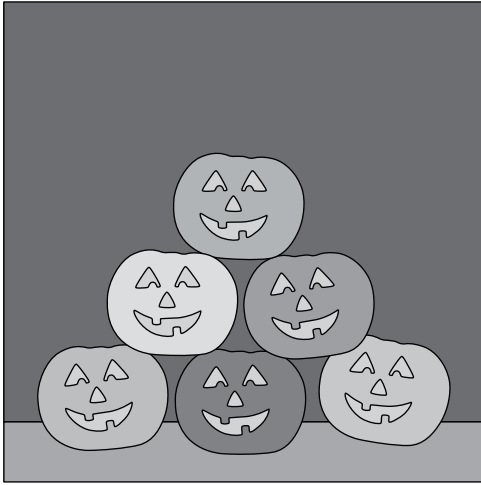


2. Using your favorite appliqué technique, appliqué Template C, D, E, and F pieces to a Template A jack-o-lantern. Repeat to make a total of 6 jack-o-lanterns (stems will be added in next step).

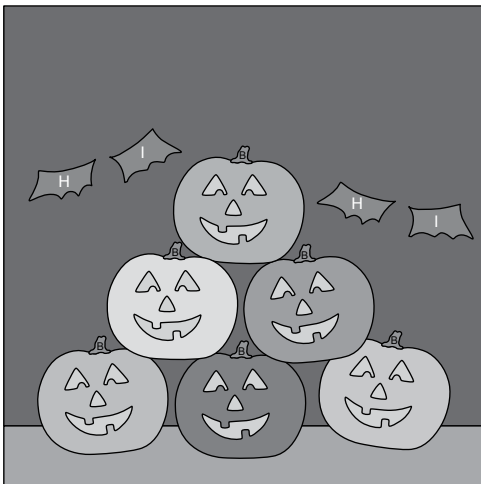


Make 6.

3. Arrange and appliqué jack-o-lanterns made in Step 2 to center background made in Step 1. Next, appliqué Template B stems in place. Appliqué bat wings (Templates H and I), followed by bat bodies (Template G). Then appliqué HAPPY HALLOWEEN lettering in place.



Appliqué jack-o-lanterns in place.

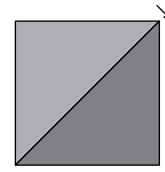


Appliqué jack-o-lantern stems (B), and bat wings (H and I) in place.

4. Using 1 Purple Silhouettes triangle, and 1 Multicolor Collage triangle, assemble a border corner unit as shown. Repeat to make 4 corner units.



Make 4.

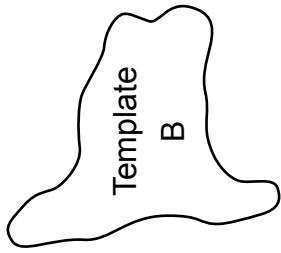
5. Referring to photo for orientation, sew a corner unit to each end of one Multicolor Border Stripe  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $32\frac{1}{2}$ " strip. Press seams toward strip. Repeat to make 2 of these pieced borders (see the top and bottom borders in the Quilt Assembly Diagram).
6. Sew the remaining 2 Multicolor Border Stripe  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $32\frac{1}{2}$ " strips to the sides of the quilt as shown in Quilt Assembly Diagram. Press seams toward borders.
7. Sew the pieced borders made in Step 5 to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press seams toward borders.

### Finishing

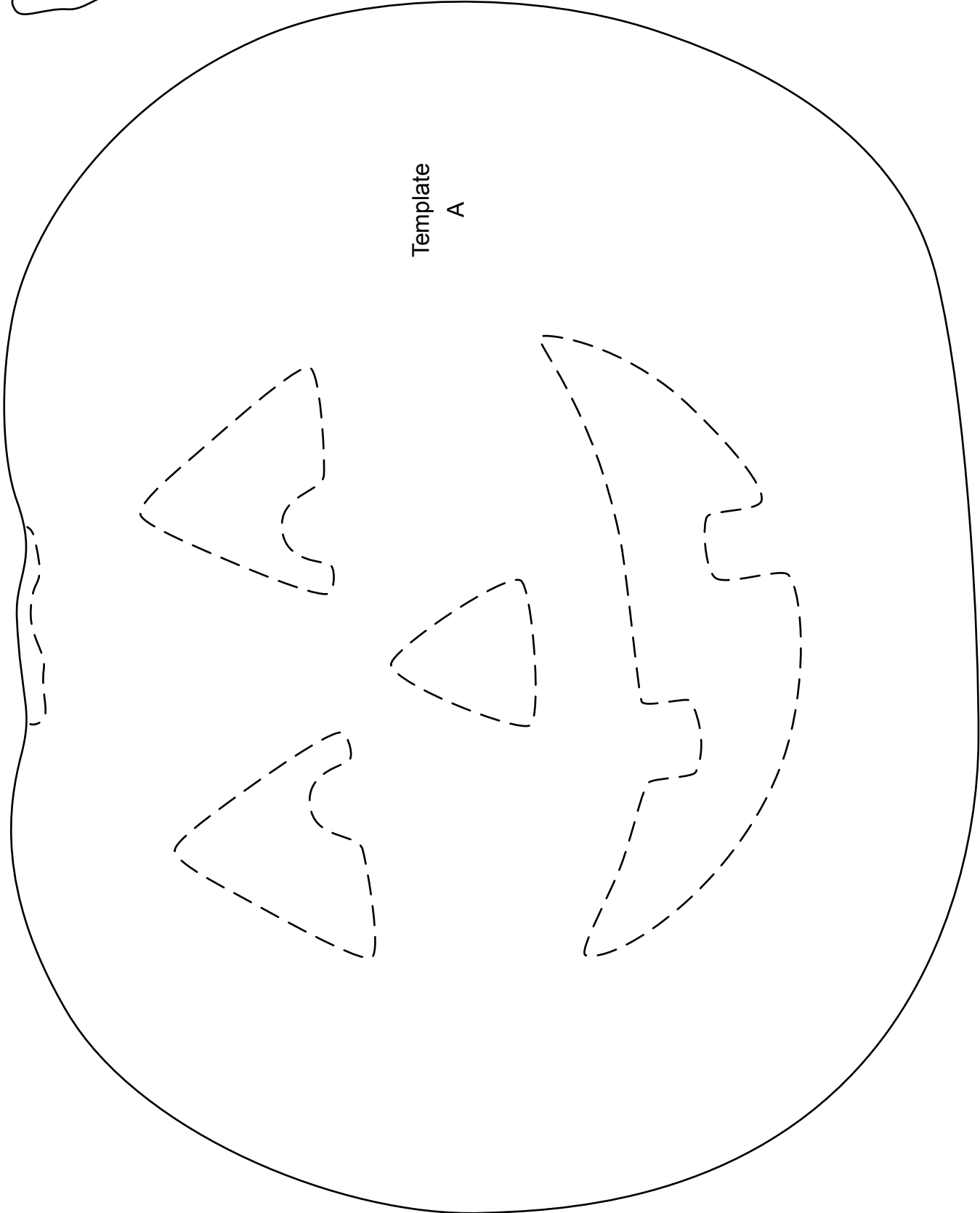
Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind. Don't forget to sign and date your finished quilt.



Quilt Assembly Diagram

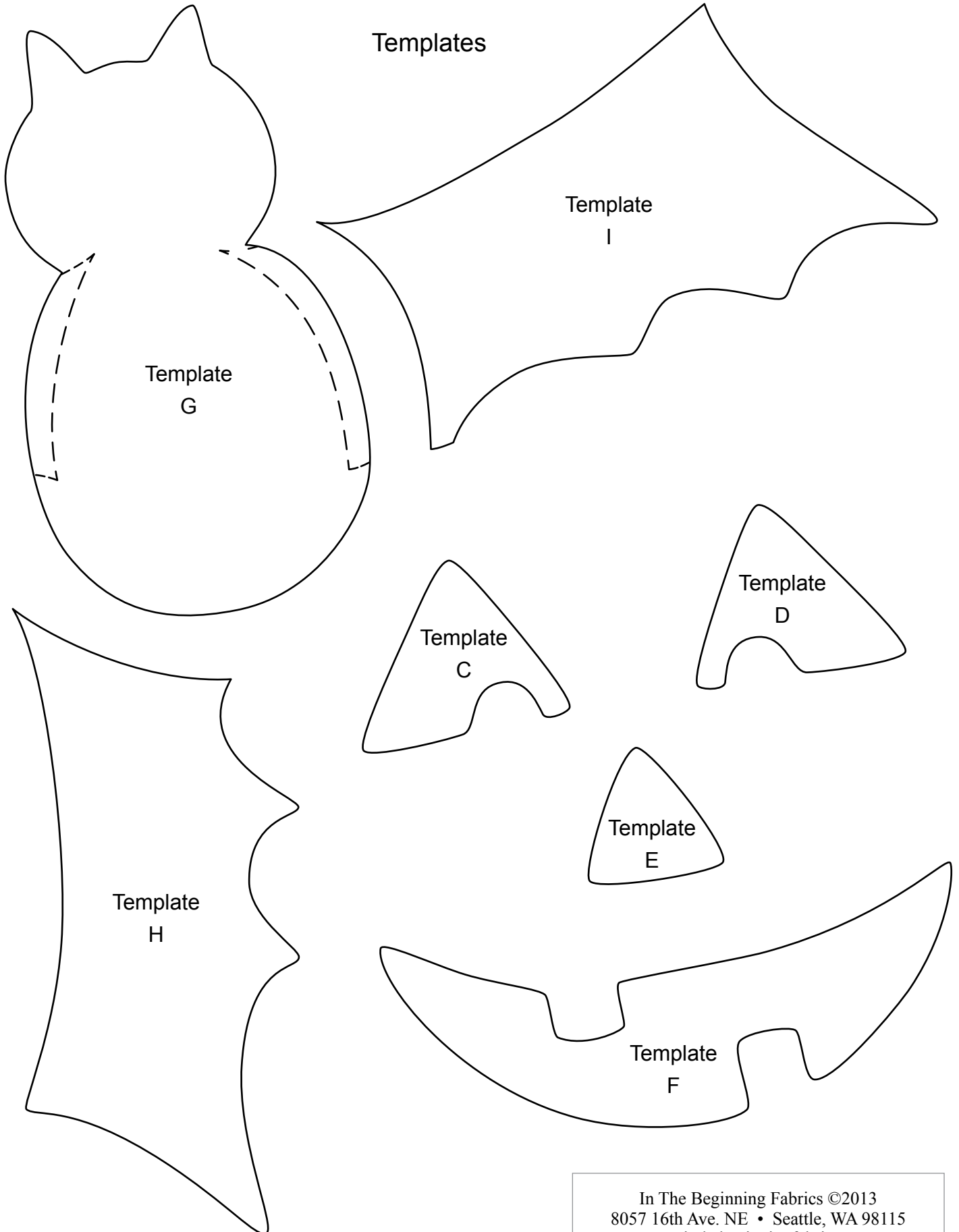
