*This pattern uses the Full Spectrum Collection by Hoffman California Fabrics. It is also ideal for use with **Bali Pops**. It is very important to have accurate $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances in this project. Check your seam allowance before starting. Fabric requirements are based on 40" wide fabrics. WOF = width of fabric. Sew all seams right sides together.*
Quilt measures 64" x 76"

Rust Swirl, G9002 #39

Label each size on the brown fabrics pieces.

This color will be referred to as brown in the instructions.


Cut (11) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips on the width of the fabric


Cut (7) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips on the width of fabric. Sew all the strips together. (Do not sew on the diagonal) From this long strip cut:

- (1) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 46 $\frac{1}{2}$ "
 - (1) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 56 $\frac{1}{2}$ "
 - (1) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 72 $\frac{1}{2}$ "
 - (1) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 64 $\frac{1}{2}$ "
 - (8) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips cut on WOF (rain patches)
- Cut (8) strips on the WOF 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide. Binding



Flame Swirl G9002 #67

Cut (6) strips 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide on WOF. From 2 strips cut (10) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles.



Multi G9004 #130

Cut (6) strips 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide on WOF. From 2 strips cut (8) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles.



Emerald Dot G9003 #31

Cut (7) strips 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide on WOF. From 2 strips cut (12) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles.



Sapphire G9004 #230


Cut (7) strips 2 ½" wide on WOF. From 2 strips cut (10) 6 ½" x 2 ½" rectangles.



Fuchsia Dot G9003 #23

This color will be referred to and shown as 'purple' in the instructions.

Cut (7) strips 2 ½" wide on WOF. From 2 strips cut (8) 6 ½" x 2 ½" rectangles.



Fuchsia Stripe G9001 #23

This color will be referred to and shown as fuchsia in the instructions.

Cut (8) strips 2 ½" wide on WOF.

From 3 strips cut (12) 6 ½" x 2 ½" rectangles, (2) 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles and (2) 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares.


Instructions - all seams must be an accurate ¼"

1. Spectrum: Sew (4) strip sets together as shown using 2 ½" strips. Follow the color arrangement given.


(flame, multi, emerald, sapphire, purple, fuchsia)

Press in the direction shown. There will be some 2 ½" colored strips remaining that will be used in step 3.


2. Sub cut each of the strip sets from above into 6 sections that are 6 ½" wide. These are the color bars. (24 sections)


3. Rain Patches: You will have one 2 ½" fabric strip remaining in the following colors: emerald, sapphire, fuchsia and purple.

Sew a 1 ½" wide brown strip to either side of these colored strips. See the diagram showing the purple strip. Press towards the brown.



4. Sub cut the colored strip sets into 2 ½" widths so that you have:


- (5) Fuchsia sets
- (9) Emerald sets
- (4) Purple sets &
- (7) Sapphire sets




2 ½" wide

The 4 purple sets are shown.
Press as shown.


5. Sew a 1 ½" x 4 ½" brown rectangle to each side of **one** purple set. from step 4. Press towards the brown.
Make **one** block like this with a Sapphire set and **two** with an emerald set from step 4.




6. **Alternate Block:** Sew a 2 ½" x 2 ½" brown square to a 2 ½" x 2 ½" fuchsia square. Press towards the brown. Make 2.







7. Sew a 2 ½" x 4 ½" fuchsia rectangle to the 2 units from step 6. Press as shown.




8. **Color Bars:** Sew together the 11 color bars as shown below and on the following page. To do this use the pre-sewn color bar sections from Step 2 as well as the remaining 2 ½" x 6 ½" colored rectangles. Press the seams of the bars following the directional arrows in the diagrams. Each color bar set has been given a unit number. Write this number on masking tape and affix it to the color bar. Place the labels on the lower edge of units 1,3,5,7,9 and 11 and on the lower left hand side of units 2, 4, 6 ,8 and 10.




Unit 1 includes one color bar shown between the lines.
A fuchsia 2 ½" x 6 ½" rectangle is sewn to the bottom of the color bar and a flame and a multi color rectangle are sewn to the top.









9. Rows A, B, C, D, E and F: Piece together these rows using the colored sets from step 4, the blocks from steps 5 and 7 and the brown rectangles as shown. Press all seams should be pressed downwards.





10. Assembly: Assemble the quilt as shown below starting at the bottom right hand corner with Unit 1. Sew the $4\frac{1}{2}" \times 6\frac{1}{2}"$ brown rectangle to the top. Press outwards. Sew Row A to the left hand side and press outwards. Sew Unit 2 to the top. Watch the color bar placement. Press outwards. Carry on sewing the units together and pressing outwards until you have the quilt center complete.

11. The Final 2 Borders: Sew the $4\frac{1}{2}" \times 72\frac{1}{2}"$ border to the right hand side of the quilt. Press outwards. Sew the lower $4\frac{1}{2}" \times 64\frac{1}{2}"$ border to the quilt and press outwards.



12. Backing: Cut the brown backing fabric in half into (2) 70" lengths. Sew together along the length and press.

13. Quilt as desired. Sew the (8) $2\frac{1}{2}"$ binding strips together on the diagonal, right sides together. Trim these seams to $\frac{1}{4}"$. Fold the binding in half on the length and press. Bind your quilt using your favorite method.
