# Hope's Promise

Please read all instructions carefully before starting. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut from selvage to selvage unless otherwise stated.

## 1. Cut the following:

**Fabric A** - \*\*cut 6 - 11 1/2" x 11 1/2" squares (center designs evenly)

**Fabric B** - cut 1 - 15 1/2" x 23 1/2"

**Fabric C** - cut lengthwise 4 - 8" x approximately 45" (to be mitered)

**Fabric D** - cut 1 - 3 1/2" strip, subcut 4 - 3 1/2" squares  
cut 4 - 2" strips, subcut 4 - 2" x 11", 4 - 2" x 12 1/2" and 20 - 2" squares

Then from remaining fabric, cut the following lengthwise: 2 - 6 1/2" x 72 1/2", 2 - 2" x 72 1/2", 2 - 6 1/2" x 64 1/2" and 2 - 2" x 64 1/2"

**Fabric E** - cut 2 - 3 1/2" strips, subcut 16 - 3 1/2" squares  
cut 2 - 2" strips

**Fabric F** - cut 2 - 3 1/2" strips, subcut 16 - 3 1/2" squares  
cut 2 - 2" strips

**Fabric G** - cut 2 - 3 1/2" strips, subcut 16 - 3 1/2" squares  
cut 2 - 2" strips

**Fabric H** - cut 2 - 3 1/2" strips, subcut 16 - 3 1/2" squares  
cut 2 - 2" strips

cut 8 - 2" strips, sew end to end then subcut 2 - 2" x 72 1/2" and 2 - 2" x 64 1/2"

cut 2 - 12 1/2" strips, subcut 8 - 2" x 12 1/2",

4 - 3 3/4" x 12 1/2", and 2 - 4" x 12 1/2"

cut 7 - 2" strips, then subcut the following:

8 - 2" squares, 12 - 2" x 3 1/2", 8 - 2" x 5", 4 - 2" x 8",

4 - 2" x 11"

**Fabric I** - \*\*cut 8 - 1" strips, subcut 12 - 1" x 11 1/2" and 12 - 1" x 12 1/2"

cut 4 - 2" strips

cut 8 - 2" strips, sew end to end then subcut

2 - 2" x 72 1/2" and 2 - 2" x 64 1/2"

cut 2 - 2" strips, subcut 8 - 2" squares, 4 - 2" x 3 1/2" and 4 - 2" x 5"

**Fabric J** - cut 9 - 1 1/2" strips, sew end to end then subcut 4 - 1 1/2" x approximately 45" and 4 - 1 1/2" x approximately 30" (to be mitered)

cut 7 - 1 1/2" strips, sew end to end then subcut

2 - 1 1/2" x 66 1/2" and 2 - 1 1/2" x 60 1/2"

cut 4 - 2" strips

**Fabric K** - cut the following lengthwise: 2 - 2 1/2" x 68 1/2", 2 - 2 1/2" x 64 1/2", 2 - 2 1/2" x 96 1/2" and 2 - 2 1/2" x 92 1/2";  
cut 2 - 2" x 72 1/2" and 2 - 2" x 64 1/2"

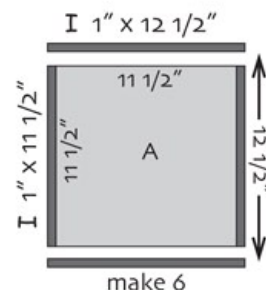
cut from remaining fabric: 4 - 2" x 2" squares and 12 - 2" x 3 1/2" rectangles.

**Fabric M** - BINDING - cut 11 - 2 1/4" strips, sew end to end and press in half.

## 2. Piecing Order:

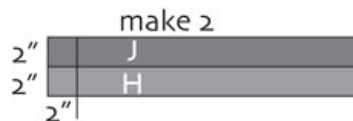
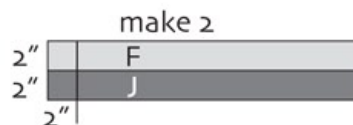
1. Sew **I** 1" borders around 6 **A** 11 1/2" squares, SIDES first, then TOP and BOTTOM borders.

\*\* (If **A** measurements are slightly different, cut **I** borders slightly larger, sew around **A** squares, then trim all blocks to measure 12 1/2" x 12 1/2".)

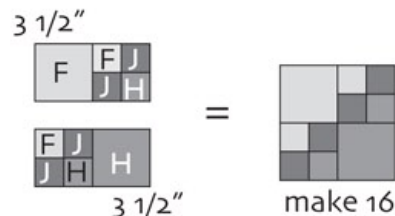


2. Make 32 - 3" finished (3 1/2" unf.) green 4-patches.

First, make 2 strip sets by sewing **F** and **J** 2" strips side by side. Press toward **J**. Subcut 32 - 2" segments. Next, make 2 strip sets by sewing **J** and **H** 2" strips side by side. Press toward **J**. Subcut 32 - 2" segments. Then sew segments together for 32 4-patches.

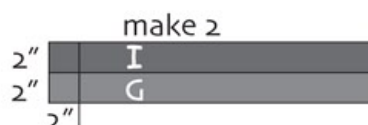
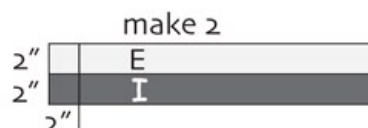


Next, make 16 - 6" finished (6 1/2" unf.) blocks by sewing 4-patches with **F** and **H** 3 1/2" squares according to the diagram.



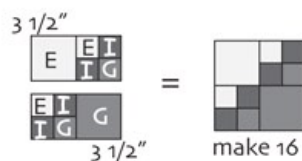
3. Make 32 - 3" finished (3 1/2" unf.) red/pink 4-patches. First, make 2 strip sets by sewing **E** and **I** 2" strips side by side. Press toward **I**. Subcut 32 - 2" segments. Next, make 2 strip sets by sewing **I** and **G** 2" strips side by side.

Press toward **I**. Subcut 32 - 2" segments. Then sew segments together for 32 4-patches.

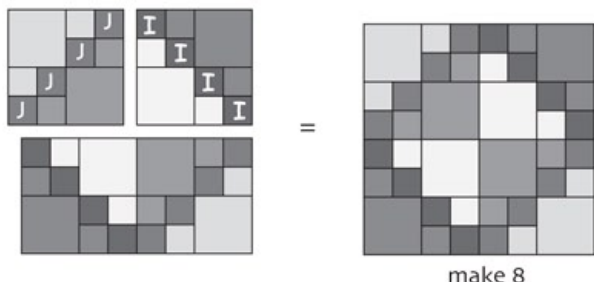


## Page Two

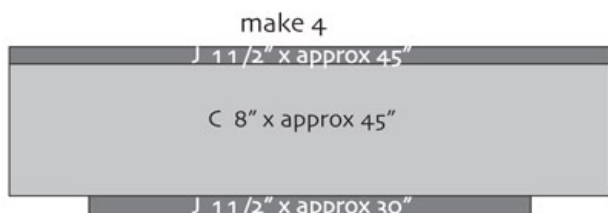
Next, make 16 - 6" finished (6 1/2" unf.) blocks by sewing 4-patches with **E** and **G** 3 1/2" squares according to the diagram.



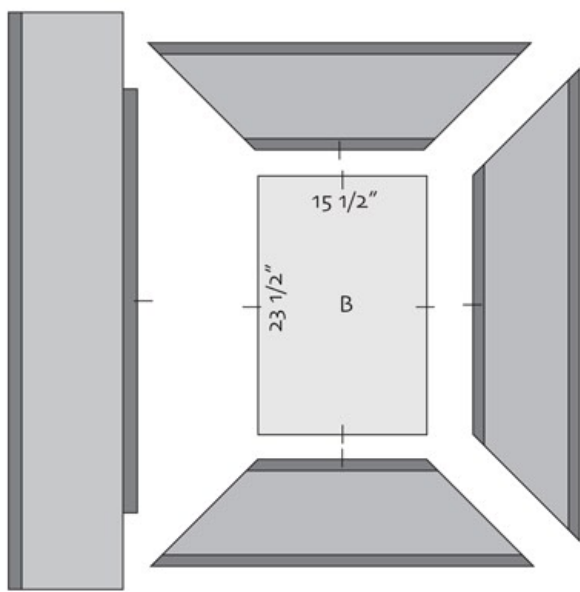
4. Then make 8 - 12" finished (12 1/2" unf.) blocks by sewing blocks from step 2 and step 3 together according to the diagram.



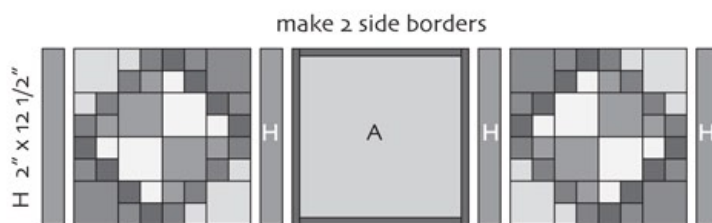
5. Make 4 border strip sets by sewing **J** 1 1/2", **C** 8" and **J** 1 1/2" strips side by side. Fold all borders in half then match centers when sewing strips side by side.



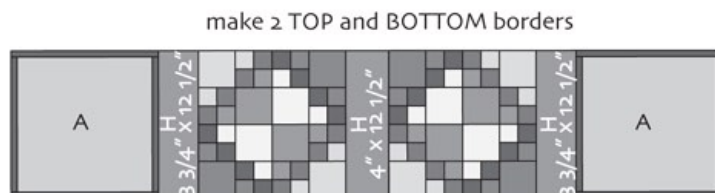
6. Next, fold **B** in half to find the centers of each side. Match centers of borders sets with **B** and sew **SIDE** border sets first, then sew **TOP** and **BOTTOM** borders. Last, sew mitered angles.



7. Make 2 rows of **SIDE** borders by sewing 2 pieced blocks, 1 **A** block and 4 **H** 2" x 12 1/2" strips together according to the diagram. Then sew to the **SIDES** of the quilt center.



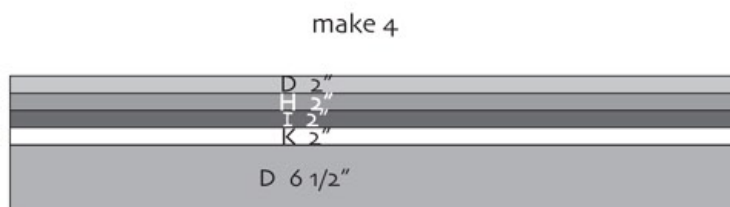
8. Make the **TOP** and **BOTTOM** borders by sewing 2 **A** blocks, 2 pieced blocks and 3 **H** rectangles together according to the diagram. Then sew borders to the **TOP** and **BOTTOM** of the quilt.



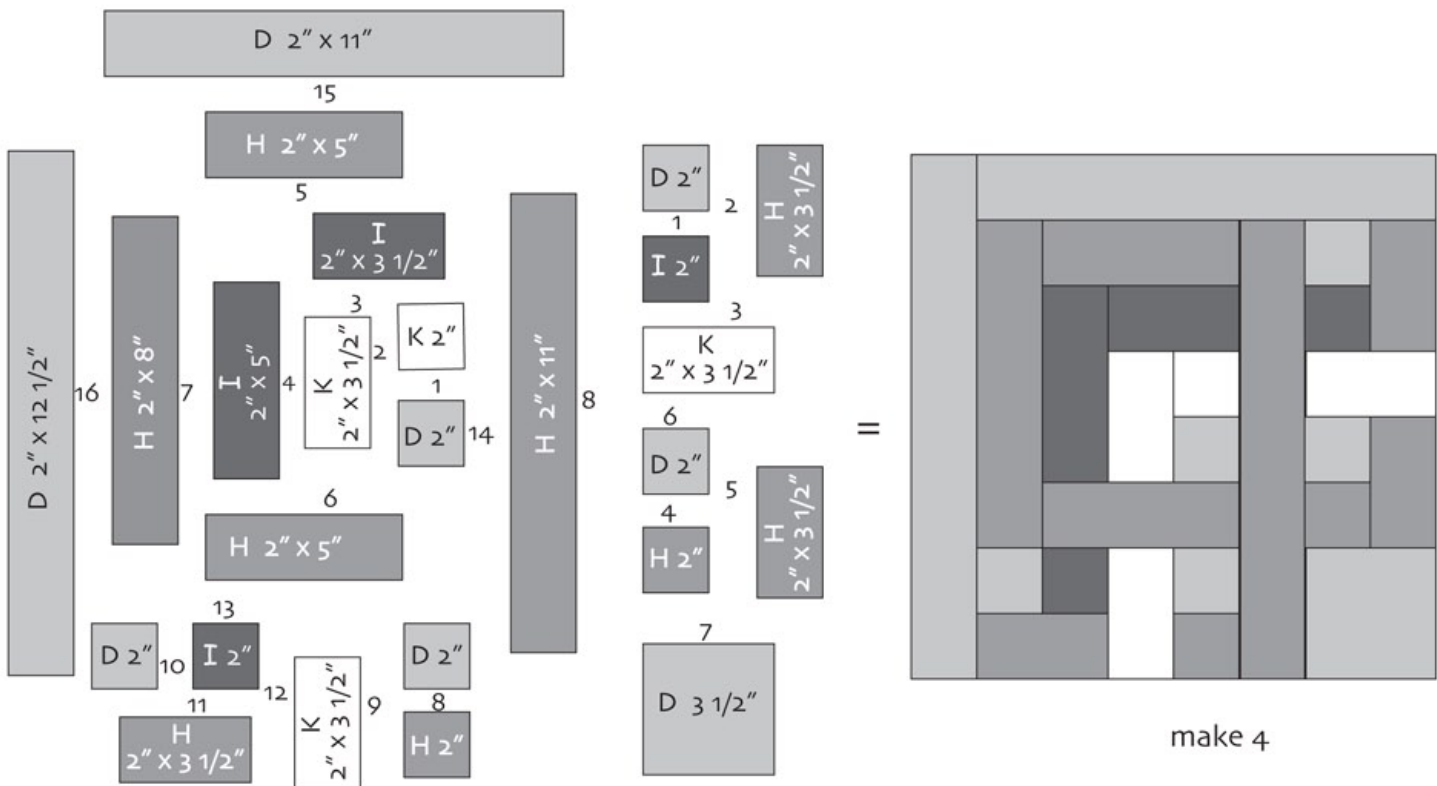
9. Sew **J** 1 1/2" borders around the quilt, **SIDES** first, then **TOP** and **BOTTOM** borders.

10. Sew **K** 2 1/2" borders around quilt, **SIDES** first, then **TOP** and **BOTTOM** borders.

11. Make 4 larger border strip sets by sewing **D** 6 1/2", **K** 2", **I** 2", **H** 2" and **D** 2" strips side by side. Make 2 - 72 1/2" long (**SIDES**) and 2 - 64 1/2" long for the **TOP** and **BOTTOM** borders.



12. Make 4 - 12" finished ( 12 1/2" unf.) corner blocks by following the numerical order according to the diagram. The block is divided into 2 sections so begin with the #1 on the right side.



13. Sew SIDE border sets to the quilt. Next, sew a pieced corner block to both ends of the TOP and BOTTOM border sets, then sew to the quilt's TOP and BOTTOM according to the diagram on the next page.
14. Last, sew K 2 1/2" borders around the quilt, SIDES first, then TOP and BOTTOM borders.
15. The quilt measures approximately 93" x 101". Make backing (**Fabric L**) at least 6" larger than the top. Layer and baste top, batting and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric M**) and enjoy!!
