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Materials

Yardages based on 42" wide fabric

Version A / Version B:

½ yd Lt Navy Wildflowers Panel (Y1891-93)
1 ½ yds Lt Navy Tossed Flowers (Y2515-93)*
1 ½ yds Lt Navy Pictorial Stripe (Y1892-93)

²/₃ yd Dk Denim Misty (Y2539-89) -or-

Royal Blue Impr. Moiré (Y1031-31)

% yd Black Forget Me Not Flowers (Y1895-3) ⅓ yd Dk Pool Solid AMB (AMB001-125) -or-

Dk Aqua LB Basics Glitter Y0808-34M

¾ yd Black Solid AMB (AMB001-3)

3 ¾ yds backing Black Fireweed (Y1894-3)

Cut the Fabrics

WOF = Width of Fabric LOF = Length of Fabric Version A / Version B:

From the Lt Navy Wildflowers Panel cut:

(6) 10%" squares, centered on block motifs

From the Black Solid AMB cut:

(7) 11/2" x WOF strips for borders

(7) 11/2" x WOF strips, subcut into:

(12) 1½" x 10½" strips (label as 'Sides')

(12) 1½" x 12½" strips (label as 'Tops & Bottoms')

From the Dk Denim Misty / Royal Blue

Impr. Moiré cut:

(3) 6 ½" x WOF strips, subcut into: (9) 6½" x 12½" rectangles

From the Black Forget Me Not Flowers cut:

(5) 21/2" x WOF strips

From Dk Pool Solid AMB / Dk Aqua LB Basics Glitter

cut: (4) 2½" x WOF strips

From the Lt Navy Tossed Flowers cut:

(3) 6½" x WOF strips, sub-cut into

(8) 6½" x 12½" rectangles

(7) 2½" x WOF strips for binding

From the Lt Navy Pictorial Stripe cut:

(4) 6½" x LOF strips

Directions

Prior to starting this project, please check our web site for any updates: www.clothworks.com. Use 1/4" seam allowance throughout.

Step 1, Constructing The Panel Rows:

- 1. Using the Black Solid 1½" x 10½" strips, sew a strip to the sides of all six Panel blocks. Press seams toward the black. Now sew the 1½" x 12½" strips to the tops & bottoms of the panel blocks; again press toward the black.
- 2. Using the Dk Denim Misty fabric, sew a 6½" x 12½" rectangle to the left side of all six Panel blocks. Sew the left side of the Dk Denim Misty/ Columbine block to the right side of the Dk Denim Misty/ Iris block. Attach an additional 6½" x 12½" Dk Denim Misty fabric rectangle to the right side of the Columbine block. (Fig. 1) Repeat for the Rose block & Poppy block row and the Fireweed block and Forget Me Not block row. Press seams toward the Dk Denim Misty.




Step 2, Constructing The Floral 9-Patch Rows:

- Sew a Dk Pool Solid strip to the long side of the Forget Me Not floral strip, press to the Dk Pool Solid. Sew a floral strip to the opposite side of the same Dk Pool Solid strip; press to the Dk Pool Solid. Sub-cut all three strip sets into (16) 2½" x 6½" 3-patch blocks. (Fig. 2)
- 2. To each long side of a Dk Pool/Floral/Dk Pool block (Fig. 3) sew a Floral/Dk Pool/Floral block to create a 9-patch with flowers in the corners and in the middle. (Fig. 4) Press well & trim, if necessary, to a 6½" square. Repeat until you have 12 completed blocks.
- 3. Sew a 9-Patch Floral to the left side of each floral 6½" x 12½" rectangle. Sew 2 of these sets together. Now add an additional 9-Patch Floral to the right side of the row. Press all seams toward the floral rectangles. Repeat 3 times to make 4 complete rows. (Fig. 5)



Step 3, Constructing The Body of the Quilt:

- 1. Make sure all seven rows are the same length. Correct seams where necessary.
- Sew a Floral 9-patch Row to the top of each Panel Row (Fig. 6)
 Press seam towards the Panel Row.
- 3. Sew an additional Floral 9-patch row to the bottom of the final row.
- Sew the 1st set of rows to the 2nd set (keeping flowers upright), then attach the final row.



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Step 4, Constructing The Borders:

- 1. Measure each side & the middle of your quilt (should be approximately 60½"). If the measurements are the same or close, use the average number for the length of your inner side border. If the measurements are significantly different, check your seam allowances, find the problem & fix it before attaching your borders. When you are satisfied, write the length down & label it 'Sides'.
- 2. Sew (2) Black Solid 1½" strips end to end & then cut to the side measurement. Pin or clip the strip to the side of the quilt to keep it from stretching. Sew down the length, press to the Black Solid. Repeat for the opposite side.
- 3. Using the technique from above, measure the top, bottom, and middle of your quilt. Again, use the average measurement, correct seams if necessary. Write the width down & label as 'Top & Bottom'.
- 4. Sew 3 strips end to end, sub-cut 2 pieces to the width calculated for "Top & Bottom." Pin or clip the strip to the top of the quilt to keep it from stretching. Sew down the length, press to the black. Repeat for the bottom.
- 5. Add 2" to the original 'Side' measurement, and cut Wildflowers Pictorial Stripe to length. Pin or clip the strip to the side of the quilt. Sew down the length, press to the floral print. Repeat for the Opposite side.
- 6. Add 2" to the original 'Top & Bottom' measurement & cut two pieces to length. Pin or clip strip to the tob of the quilt. Sew down the length, press to the floral print, Repeat for the bottom.
- 7. Layer, baste, and quilt as desired. Make the binding from Lt Navy Tossed Flowers & apply to the quilt.
