

Cutting

From Fabric A (DSSH 600 P), cut:

- (2) 5 ¹/₂" x 42 ¹/₂" outer-border strips
- (2) 5 ¹/₂" x 33 ¹/₂" outer-border strips

From Fabric B (SUEM 300 L), cut:

- (2) 2" x 39 1/2" inner-border strips
- (2) 2" x 33 1/2" inner-border strips
- (6) 2 ¹/4" x 42" binding strips

From Fabric C (RAM7 727 W), cut:

• (3) 10 ¹/₂" x 30 ¹/₂" strips

From Fabric D (DSSH 606 P), cut:

- (2) 4 ¹/₄" x 42" strips; cut into (10) 4 ¹/₄" squares
- (1) 5 ¹/₂" x 42" strips; cut into (4) 5 ¹/₂" squares

From Fabric E (DSSH 606 Z), cut:

• (2) 4 ¹/4" x 42" strips; cut into (10) 4 ¹/4" squares

From Fabric F (DSSH 603 T), cut:

• (1) 3 ¹/₂" x 30 ¹/₂" strip

From Fabric G (DSSH 601 Y), cut:

• See instructions to cut 2 assorted dishes

From Fabric H (DSSH 601 O), cut:

• See instructions to cut 2 assorted dishes

From Fabric I (DSSH 605 P), cut:

• See instructions to cut 2 assorted dishes

From Fabric J (DSSH 605 G), cut:

• See instructions to cut 2 assorted dishes

From Fabric K (DSSH 604 P), cut:

• See instructions to cut 3 assorted dishes

From Fabric L (DSSH 604 C), cut:

• See instructions to cut 4 assorted dishes

From Fabric M (DSSH 606 S), cut:

• See instructions to cut 15 Candy Jar lids and stands

Candy Dish Rows

1. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each shape onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about ¹/4" outside the drawn lines.

2. Referring to the cutting list and the templates, fuse each shape to the wrong side of the fabrics as indicated. Cut out each shape on the drawn lines.


3. Referring to the photo for placement guidance, arrange and fuse five assorted dishes, lids, and stands onto a Fabric C strip, making sure to place the shapes at least ¹/4["] from the bottom edge of the strip. Finish the raw edges of each appliqué shape with a decorative stitch such as a satin or buttonhole stitch to complete the candy dish row. Repeat to make a total of three appliquéd rows.

Sashing Strips

4. Draw a line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each Fabric D 4 ¹/4" square. Layer a marked square with a Fabric E square, right sides together. Sew ¹/4" on each side of the drawn diagonal line. Cut the squares apart on the drawn diagonal line to make two half-square-triangle units. The units should measure 3 ⁷/8" square. Repeat to make a total of 20 half-square-triangle units.

5. Layer two half-square-triangle units, right sides together, making sure the center seam is going in the same direction on both units and the Fabric D triangles are on top of the Fabric E triangles.

6. On the wrong side of the top unit, draw a diagonal line across the unit so that the line crosses the sewn seam as shown. Sew $1/4^{"}$ on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line to make two hourglass units. The units should measure $3 1/2^{"}$ square. Repeat to make a total of 20 units.



7. Join ten hourglass units to make a 30 1/2"-long sashing strip. Repeat to make a second sashing strip.




Quilt Assembly

8. Sew together the candy dish rows, the two sashing strips, and the Fabric F strip, as shown in the photo to complete the quilt center. The quilt center should measure $30 \frac{1}{2^{"}} \times 39 \frac{1}{2^{"}}$.

9. Sew 39 ¹/₂["]-long Fabric B strips to the opposite sides of the quilt top. Sew the 33 ¹/₂["]-long Fabric B strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top to complete the inner border.

10. Sew 42 $1/2^{"}$ -long Fabric A strips to opposite sides of the quilt top. Sew Fabric D 5 $1/2^{"}$ squares to both ends of the 33 $1/2^{"}$ -long Fabric A strips. Sew these strips to the top and bottom of the quilt to complete the outer border.

11. Layer the quilt top with batting and backing; baste. Quilt as desired. Using the Fabric B 2 ¹/4"-wide strips, bind the edges to finish.
