






























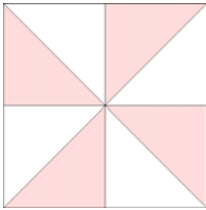

Constructing pinwheel blocks

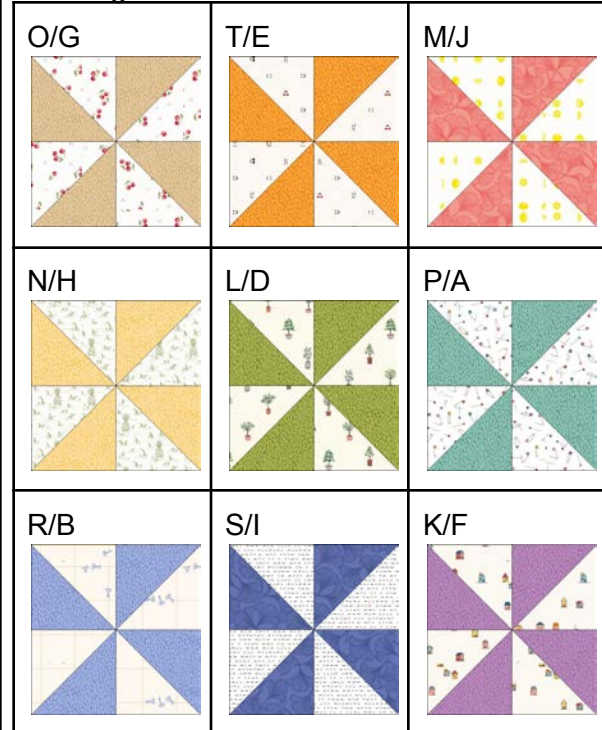
1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric 1 square. Place square, right sides together, on (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric 2 square. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from both sides of drawn line. Cut along drawn line to yield (2) HST units. Open and press. Align diagonal seam against 45 degree line on quilting ruler, trim units to measure 3" x 3" unfinished.



Make a total of (4) units and sew units to make a pinwheel unit. Unit measures $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.



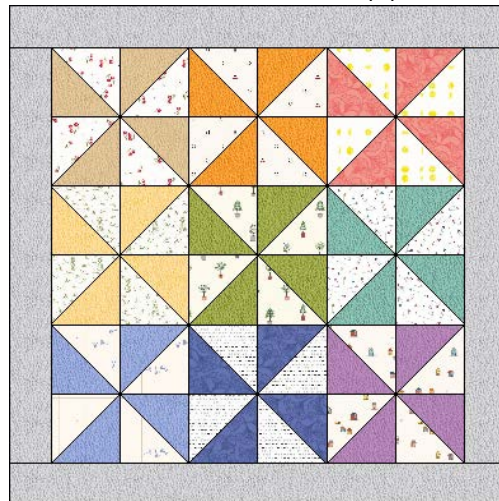
2. Make (8) pinwheel unit for each of the following Fabric 1 / Fabric 2 combinations.



3. Arrange and sew (3) pinwheel units to make a row unit. Make a total of (3) row units. Sew together row units.

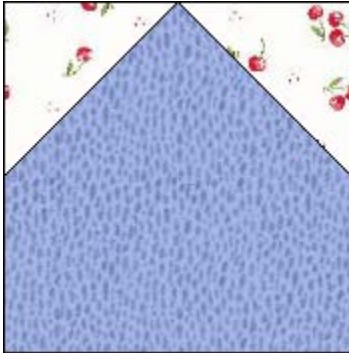


4. Sew (2) 2 " x $15\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C rectangles to the opposite sides of step 3 unit, followed by (2) 2 " x $18\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C rectangles to the remaining opposite sides to complete (1) block. Block measures $18\frac{1}{2}$ " x $18\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished. Make a total of (8) blocks.



Constructing star block

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 2" x 2" Fabric O square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" Fabric B square. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with another 2" x 2" Fabric O square at the adjacent opposite corner of the same Fabric B square.

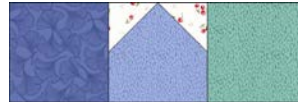


Repeat to make one unit each for Fabric D, F, J.

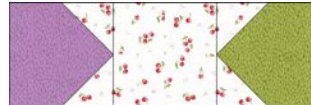
2. Sew (1) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" Fabric G square, and (1) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" Fabric H square to the opposite sides of (1) Fabric J step 1 unit to make a row unit.



Repeat to make another row unit using 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" Fabric A and Fabric I squares; and (1) Fabric B step 1 unit.



Sew Fabric D and Fabric J step 1 units to the opposite sides of (1) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" Fabric O square to make a row unit.



Sew together row units together, as shown.

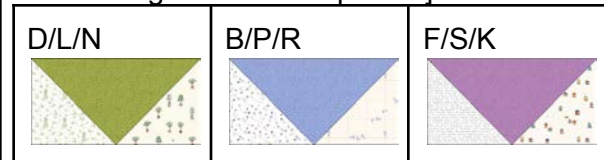


3. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 5" x 5" Fabric T square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) 5" x 9 1/2" Fabric J rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with another 5" x 5" Fabric M square at the opposite corner of the same rectangle to make (1) flying geese unit.



3 continued. Repeat to make 1 unit each for the following Fabrics:

[Note: The fabrics for 5" x 9 1/2" rectangles are listed first, with the second and third fabric being the 5" x 5" squares.]



4. Sew (1) 5" x 5" Fabric G square and (1) 5" x 5" Fabric H square to the opposite sides of (1) Fabric J step 3 unit to make a row unit.



Sew (1) 5" x 5" Fabric I square and (1) 5" x 5" Fabric A square to the opposite sides of (1) Fabric B step 3 unit to make a row unit.



Sew (1) Fabric F step 3 unit, and (1) Fabric D step 3 unit to the opposite sides of step 2 unit to make a row unit.

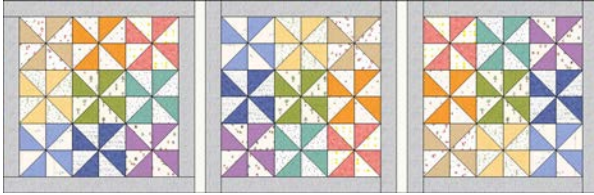


4 continued. Sew together row units to complete star block. Block measures 18 1/2" x 18 1/2" unfinished.



Quilt Top Assembly

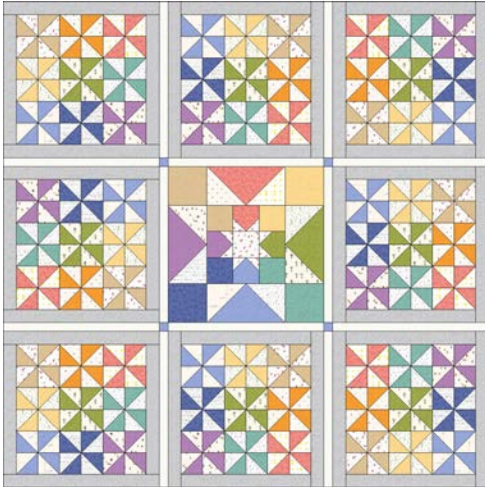
1. Pieced rows. Refer to quilt image for block placement and orientation guide, arrange and sew (3) pieced blocks and (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $18\frac{1}{2}$ " background rectangles to make a pieced row. Make a total of (3) pieced row. Row 1 is shown below.



2. Pieced sashing rows. Sew together (3) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $18\frac{1}{2}$ " background rectangles and (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B squares to make a pieced sashing row. Make a total of (2) rows.



3. Sew together pieced rows and pieced sashing rows to complete quilt center.

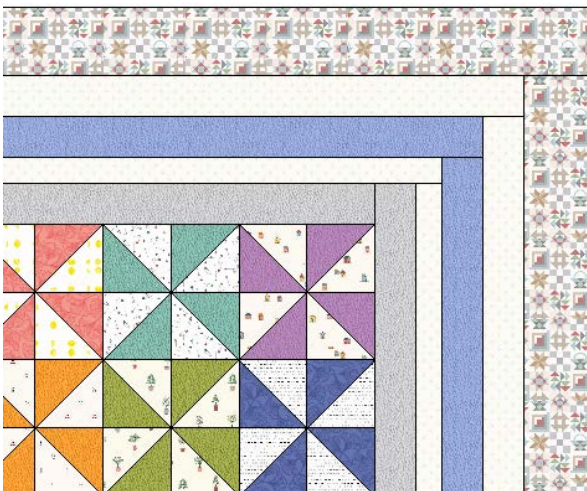


4. Inner border #1. Sew (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $56\frac{1}{2}$ " background strips to the opposite sides of quilt center, followed by (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $58\frac{1}{2}$ " background strips to the remaining opposite sides of quilt center.

5. Inner border #2. Sew (2) 2" x $58\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strips to the opposite sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 2" x $61\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strips to the remaining opposite sides of quilt center.

6. Inner border #3. Sew (2) 2" x $61\frac{1}{2}$ " background strips to the opposite sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 2" x $64\frac{1}{2}$ " background strips to the remaining opposite sides of quilt center.

7. Outer border. Sew (2) 3" x $64\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric Q strips to the opposite sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 3" x $69\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric Q strips to the remaining opposite sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.



Finishing

1. Layer backing, batting and quilt top.
2. Baste the layers together. Quilt as desired.
3. Bind to complete the quilt.
