## Construction of Quilt Top

1. Sew a 2½" strip of fabric 10 to each 6½" strip of fabrics 1-9. Press towards fabric 10.




2. Cut each strip into (5) 6-1/2" segments for a total of 45. Note you will only use 42 segments.



3. Sew 7 segments from step 1 together in a row, watching fabric placement, per quilt diagram. Press seams in one direction. Repeat to make a total of 5 rows.



4. Sew the  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $42\frac{1}{2}$ " sashing strips between the rows from step 2. Press towards the sashing strips.



- 5. Sew the inner border on, mitering the corners, pressing towards the inner border.
- 6. Sew the 7 outer border strips short end to short end. Press. Trim to match your quilt. Sew long strips to left and right sides of quilt. Press. Sew short strips to top & bottom. Press. Quilt & bind using favorite method.
