Note: All seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise specified. Press seam allowances open unless otherwise indicated.

Make the Tree Units

Note: Each Tree Unit uses two fabrics. Use matching **B1** squares, and **B2** and **B3** rectangles. The **C2** squares, and **C3**, **C4**, and **C5** rectangles should match each other, but not the **B1**, **B2**, and **B3** patches.

1 Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of six matching **B1** squares. Noting the orientation of the marked line, place one marked square right sides together on one end of a **C3** rectangle, as shown. Sew on the marked line. Trim the excess corner fabric, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Press the triangle open. Repeat to add a second triangle on the opposite end of the rectangle, to make a Flying Geese unit.



Sew one matching unmarked **B1** square to each end of the Flying Geese unit.



2 Noting the orientation of the marked line, place one marked **B1** square right sides together on one end of a **C4** rectangle, as shown. Sew on the marked line. Trim the excess corner fabric, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Press the triangle open. Repeat to add a second triangle on the opposite end of the rectangle.



Sew one matching unmarked **B2** rectangle to each end of the unit.



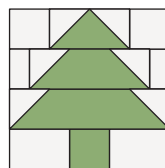
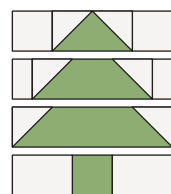
3 Noting the orientation of the marked line, place one marked **B1** square right sides together on one end of a **C5** rectangle, as shown. Sew on the marked line. Trim the excess corner fabric, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Press the triangle open. Repeat to add a second triangle on the opposite end of the rectangle.



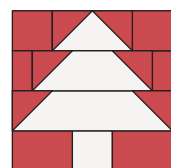
4 Sew matching **B3** rectangles to either side of a **C2** square. Press.



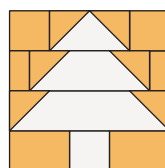
5 Arrange the step 1-4 units in a single column as shown. Sew the rows together along adjacent edges. Press. The Tree Unit should measure 4 1/2" x 4 1/2". Referring to the quilt photos for fabric combinations, make 12 Tree Units for the Tree Blocks and 4 additional Tree Units for the Tree Mitten Blocks.



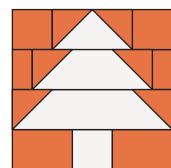

Make the Tree Blocks

Note: Use the twelve matching Tree Units to make the Tree Blocks. The four remaining Tree Units will be used in the Tree Mitten Blocks.

1 Sew one **B4** rectangle to either side of one of the twelve matching Tree Units. Press the seam allowances toward the rectangles. Sew a **C1** square to each short end of two **B4** rectangles. Press. Sew one **C1/B4** unit to the top, and the other to the bottom edge of the Tree Unit. Press the seam allowances toward the rectangles.

2 Sew one **B5** rectangle to either side of the step 1 unit. Press the seam allowances toward the rectangles. Sew a **C2** square to each short end of two **B5** rectangles. Press. Sew one **C2/B5** unit to the top, and the other to the

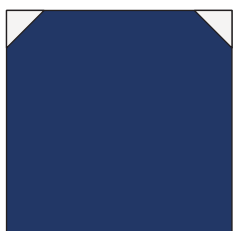
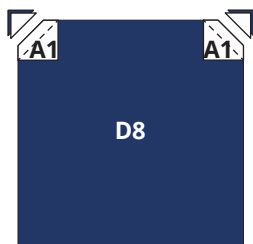
bottom edge of the step 1 unit. Press the seam allowances toward the rectangles.

③ Sew one **B6** rectangle to either side of the step 2 unit. Press the seam allowances toward the rectangles. Sew a **C1** square to each short end of two **B6** rectangles. Press. Sew one **C1/B6** unit to the top, and the other to the bottom edge of the step 2 unit. Press the seam allowances toward the rectangles. The block should measure $10\frac{1}{2}" \times 10\frac{1}{2}"$. Make a total of twelve Tree Blocks.

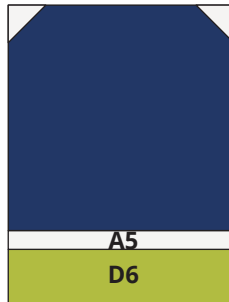
Make the Mitten Blocks

*Note: Match the **D7** and **D8** patches in these Mitten Blocks. Refer to the quilt photo to determine which **D6** rectangles to use.*

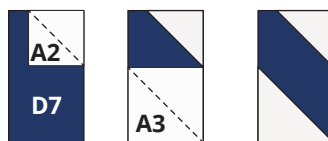
① Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of two **A1** squares. Noting the orientation of the marked lines, place one marked square right sides together on each upper corner of a **D8** square, as shown. Sew on the marked lines. Trim the excess corner fabric, leaving a $\frac{1}{4}"$ seam allowances. Press the triangles open.



② Referring to the quilt photo for fabric combinations, sew one long edge of an **A5** rectangle to the long edge of one **D6** rectangle. Press. Sew the **A5** side of the pieced unit to the lower edge of the step 1 **D8** square. Press.



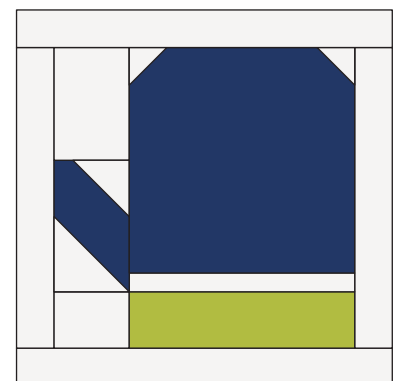
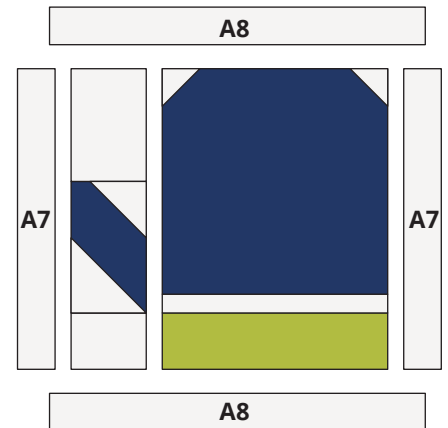
③ Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of one **A2** square. Noting the orientation of the marked line, place the marked square right sides together on the upper right corner of a **D7** rectangle, as shown. Sew on the marked line. Trim the excess corner fabric, leaving a $\frac{1}{4}"$ seam allowance. Press the triangle open. Repeat to sew an **A3** square to the bottom left corner of the same **D7** rectangle.



④ Sew an **A4** rectangle to the top, and an **A6** rectangle to the bottom short edge of the step 3 unit, as shown. Press.



⑤ Sew the step 4 unit to the left side of the step 2 unit. Press. Sew one **A7** rectangle to either side of the joined units. Press. Sew one **A8** rectangle to the top, and another to the bottom edge of the pieced unit to complete the block. The block should measure $10\frac{1}{2}" \times 10\frac{1}{2}"$. Make a total of 9 assorted Mitten Blocks.

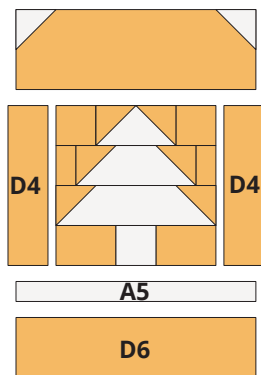
Make the Tree Mitten Blocks

*Note: Match the **D4**, **D5**, and **D6** rectangles to the backgrounds of the Tree units in these Mitten Blocks.*

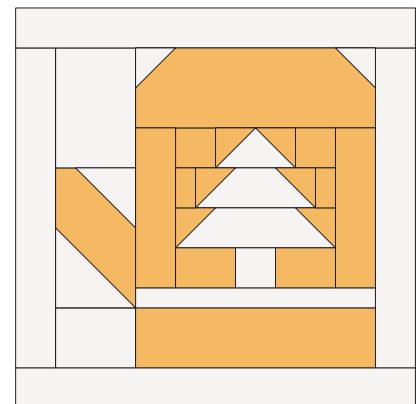
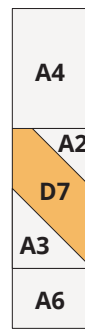
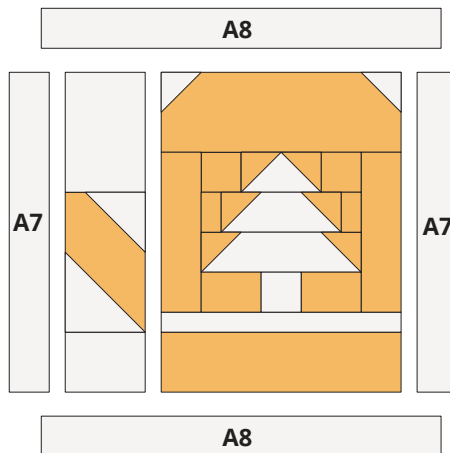
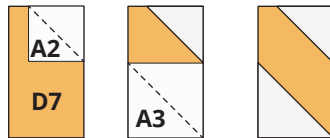
1 Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of two **A1** squares. Noting the orientation of the marked lines, place one marked square right sides together on each upper corner of a **D5** rectangle, as shown. Sew on the marked lines. Trim the excess corner fabric, leaving a 1/4" seam allowances. Press the triangles open.



2 Sew a matching **D4** rectangle to either side of a Tree unit. Press. Sew one long edge of an **A5** rectangle to the long edge of one matching **D6** rectangle. Press. Sew the **A5** side of the pieced unit to the lower edge of the bordered Tree unit. Press. Sew the **D5** unit from step 1 to the upper edge of the Tree unit. Press.



3 Repeat steps 3-5 under Make the Mitten Blocks to complete the block. Make a total of 4 Tree Mitten Blocks.

Assemble the Quilt

1 Referring to the quilt photo for block placement, arrange the blocks in five rows of five blocks each. Sew the blocks in each row together along adjacent edges. Press. Sew the rows together along adjacent edges. Press.

2 Join six Border 1 strips end to end. Press. Cut two Border 1 side borders, 1 1/2" x 50 1/2", and two Border 1 top/bottom borders, 1 1/2" x 52 1/2". Sew one side border to either side of the quilt center. Press. Sew one top/bottom border to the top, and the other to the bottom edge or the quilt center. Press.

3 Repeat step 2 with the Border 2 strips, cutting two side borders, 2" x 52 1/2", and two top/bottom borders, 2" x 55 1/2".

4 Repeat step 3 with the Border 3 strips, cutting two side borders, 1 1/2" x 55 1/2", and two top/bottom borders, 1 1/2" x 57 1/2".

5 Repeat step 4 with the Border 4 strips, cutting two side borders, 2 1/2" x 57 1/2", and two top/bottom borders, 2 1/2" x 61 1/2".

Finishing

1 Using a 1/2" seam allowance, join the two large backing rectangles along one long edge to complete the quilt backing. Press.

2 Layer the quilt backing, batting, and quilt top. Quilt as desired. Stitch a scant 1/4" from the edge around the perimeter of the quilt. Trim the excess backing and batting. Use your favorite method to bind the quilt.



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
