Please read all instructions before beginning the project.  
Yardage calculated using a 42" usable width of fabric.

## GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Please check our website [www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates](http://www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates) for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

WOF = Width of Fabric

RST = Right Sides Together

HST = Half Square Triangle

SNF = Stitch and Flip

All fabrics are from the Wide Rose collection unless otherwise indicated.



## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Please read all pattern instructions before cutting fabrics.  
Use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter to cut your fabrics and label all cuts as noted. Note: *For directional fabric ensure proper alignment of fabric as show in the diagrams.*



Brown Main, Red Horses, Sienna Horses, Teal Boots,  
Cayenne Bandanas, Cream Bandanas, and  
Cinnamon Tiny Flowers

From each 10" Square cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x 5 ½" rectangle, label A. (7 total)
- (1) 1" x 6 ½" rectangle, label B. (7 total)
- (2) 1 ½" x 1 ½" squares, label C. (14 total)



Sienna Horseshoes

From the 10" Square cut:

- (2) 2 ½" x 5 ½" rectangle, label A.
- (2) 1" x 6 ½" rectangle, label B.
- (4) 1 ½" x 1 ½" squares, label C.



Blue Main, Blue Floral, Cream Floral, Red Floral, Sienna  
Boots, Multi Tiles, and Blue Horseshoes

From each 10" square cut:

- (2) 2" x 6 ½", label D. (14 total)



Navy Horses

From the 10" Square cut:

- (9) 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares, label E.
- (2) 2" x 6 ½" rectangles, label D.

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## Denim Horseshoes

- Cut (1) 3" x WOF strip; subcut:  
(8) 3" x 3" squares, label F.
- Cut (2) 2" x WOF strips; subcut:  
(32) 2" x 2" squares, label G.



## Denim Bandanas

- Cut (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips, put aside for binding.



## Teal Tiny Flowers

- Cut (1) 3" x WOF" strips; subcut:  
(8) 3" x 3" squares, label H.
- Cut (7) 2" x WOF" strips; subcut:  
(12) 2" x 10 1/2" rectangles, label I.  
(12) 2" x 9 1/2" rectangles, label J.  
(16) 2" x 2" squares, label K.



## Cream Main

- Cut (4) 6 1/2" x WOF strips; subcut:  
(2) 6 1/2" x 35 1/2" strips for the outer top/bottom borders.  
(2) 6 1/2" x 38 1/2" strips for the outer side borders.
- Cut (1) 2" x WOF strip; subcut:  
(2) 2" x 6 1/2" rectangles, label D.



## Cream POParazzi

- Cut (2) 4" x WOF" strips; subcut:  
(9) 4" x 6 1/2" rectangles, label L.
- Cut (3) 2" x WOF strip; subcut:  
(16) 2" x 2" squares, label M.  
(16) 2" x 3 1/2" rectangles, label N.
- Cut (11) 1 1/2" x WOF strips; subcut:  
(18) 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" rectangles, label O.  
(18) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles, label P.  
(45) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" squares, label Q.
- Cut (4) 1 1/2" x WOF strips; subcut:  
(2) 1 1/2" x 35 1/2" strips, set aside for inner top/bottom borders.  
(2) 1 1/2" x 36 1/2" strips, set aside for the inner side borders.


## SEWING TECHNIQUES

Measurements include 1/4" seam allowance. Sew with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise stated. Refer to the quilt photo for placement of the prints. Press seams as noted in each step for best results. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes unless stated otherwise.

Some angled pieces are constructed using the Stitch and Flip, Stitch and Flip Flying Geese, and 2-At-A-Time Half-Square Triangle methods. These methods are described below and referenced throughout the pattern.


### STITCH AND FLIP METHOD (SNF)

Place (2) pieces RST, matching raw edges in the corner to be replaced. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the smaller piece across the corner. Stitch on the drawn line. Trim the seam allowance above the sewn line to 1/4". Flip the small piece away from the bottom piece and press, replacing the corner. The size of the larger, original piece does not change.



### STITCH AND FLIP FLYING GEESE

Draw a diagonal line, corner to corner, on the wrong side of (2) squares. Place (1) square in the right corner of (1) rectangle, RST, matching raw edges in the corner to be replaced. Stitch on the drawn line. Trim the seam allowance above the sewn line to 1/4". Flip the small piece away from the bottom piece and press, replacing the corner. Repeat with the second square. The size of the original rectangle does not change.



### 2-AT-A-TIME HALF-SQUARE TRIANGLE METHOD (HST)


Place (2) squares RST. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Stitch 1/4" on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line to create (2) HSTs. Press toward the darker fabric. Trim HSTs to desired size.

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## BLOCK ASSEMBLY

### Boot Blocks

1. Gather a matching set of (1) A rectangle, (1) B rectangle, and (2) C squares, a matching pair of (2) D rectangles, (1) E square, (5) Q squares, (2) P rectangles, (2) N rectangles, and (1) O rectangle.



2. Sew together the (2) D rectangles and (1) B rectangle as shown to make the Boot Shaft. Press seams toward the D rectangles. Boot Shaft should measure 4" x 6 1/2", unfinished.



3. Using the SNF method, replace the top (2) corners of the Boot Shaft with Q squares and the bottom right corner with a C square. Press seams toward the C and Q squares.



4. Using the SNF method, replace the bottom left corner of an L rectangle with a coordinating C square to make a Boot Ankle. Press seam toward the C square.



5. Using the SNF method, replace the bottom left corner of an E square with a Q square to make a Heel Unit. Press seam toward the Q square.




6. Using the SNF method, replace the bottom (2) corners of an A rectangle with Q squares to make a Sole Unit.




7. Lay out the Boot Shaft, Boot Ankle, Heel, and Sole Units as shown.



8. Sew together the Boot Shaft and Boot Ankle units to form the Boot Top. Press seam open. Boot Top unit should measure 7 1/2" x 6 1/2".



9. Sew together the Heel and Sole units to form the Boot Bottom. Press seam open. Boot Bottom unit should measure 7 1/2" x 2 1/2", unfinished.




10. Sew together the Boot Top and Boot Bottom to form the Boot Block. Press seam open.




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11. Sew a P rectangle to the left and right sides of the Boot Block. Press seams toward the P rectangles.



12. Sew an O rectangle to the top and bottom of the Boot Block. Press seams toward the O rectangles. Boot Block should measure  $9\frac{1}{2}" \times 10\frac{1}{2}"$ , unfinished.



13. Repeat Steps 1- 12 to make (9) Boot Blocks.

## Star Blocks

14. Using the HST method, pair (1) F square with (1) H square. Repeat to make (16) HST Units. Trim HST Units to  $2" \times 2"$ .




HST Unit

15. Using the SNF Flying Geese method, replace the top left corner of an N rectangle with a K square and the top right corner with a G square. Press seams toward the G and K squares. Repeat to make (16) Flying Geese Units. Flying Geese Units should measure  $3\frac{1}{2}" \times 2"$  unfinished.




Flying Geese Unit

16. Lay out (4) HST Units, (4) Flying Geese Units, and (4) M squares as shown.




17. Sew together the (4) HSTs to form a Pinwheel Unit as shown. Press seams open. Pinwheel Unit should measure  $3\frac{1}{2}" \times 3\frac{1}{2}"$ , unfinished.




Pinwheel Unit

18. Sew a Flying Geese Unit to the left and right sides of the Pinwheel Unit as shown. Press seams open. Star Center should measure  $6\frac{1}{2}" \times 3\frac{1}{2}"$ , unfinished.




Star Center

19. Sew an M square to the left and right sides of a Flying Geese unit as shown. Press seams open. Repeat to make (2) Star Top/Bottom Units. Star Top/Bottom Unit should measure  $6\frac{1}{2}" \times 2"$ , unfinished.



20. Sew together a Star Top, Star Center, and Star Bottom, to form a Star Block. Press seams open. Star Block should measure  $6\frac{1}{2}" \times 6\frac{1}{2}"$ , unfinished.

21. Repeat Steps 16 - 20 to make (4) Star Blocks.

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
## QUILT ASSEMBLY

22. Lay out (4) G squares and (3) J rectangles as shown. Sew together to form a Sashing Row. Press seams toward the J rectangles. Sashing Row should measure  $33\frac{1}{2}" \times 2"$ , unfinished.



23. Repeat to make (4) Sashing Rows.

24. Lay out (3) Boot Blocks and (4) I rectangles as shown. Sew together to form a Boot Row. Press seams toward the I rectangles. Boot Row should measure  $33\frac{1}{2}" \times 10\frac{1}{2}"$ , unfinished.



25. Repeat to make (3) Boot Rows.

*Note: Refer to the Quilt Layout Diagram on page 7 for the remaining steps.*

26. Lay out (4) Sashing Rows and (3) Boot Rows as shown.
27. Sew the Sashing Rows and the Boot Rows together to form the Quilt Center. Quilt Center should measure  $33\frac{1}{2}" \times 36\frac{1}{2}"$ , unfinished.
28. Sew an inner side border strip to the left and right sides of the Quilt Center. Press seams toward the border.
29. Sew an inner top/bottom border strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center. Press seams toward the border. Quilt Center should measure  $35\frac{1}{2}" \times 38\frac{1}{2}"$ , unfinished.
30. Lay out (2) Star Blocks and (1)  $6\frac{1}{2}" \times 35\frac{1}{2}"$  top/bottom border strip as shown. Sew the Star Blocks to the left and right sides of the outer top/bottom border strip. Press seams toward the outer top/bottom border strips. Pieced Border Strip should measure  $47\frac{1}{2}" \times 6\frac{1}{2}"$ , unfinished.

31. Repeat to make (2) Pieced Border Strips.

32. Sew a  $6\frac{1}{2}" \times 38\frac{1}{2}"$  outer side border strip to the left and right sides of the Quilt Center. Press seams toward the outer border strips.

33. Sew a Pieced Border Strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center. Press seams toward the Pieced Border Strips.

Your quilt top should measure  $47\frac{1}{2}" \times 50\frac{1}{2}"$  unfinished.

## FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste quilt layers together and quilt as desired. Bind with the Denim Bandanas binding strips.
