Fabrics from the All we need is Love collection:

3. A799.1-Cherubs on cream $-11 / 4 \mathrm{yd}-1.20 \mathrm{~m}$
4. A800.1 - Love flowers on cream $-3 / 4 y d-70 \mathrm{~cm}$
5. A801.3-Love hearts on charcoal grey - fat $1 / 4$
6. A797.1 - All we need is love on linen $-3 / 8 \mathrm{syd}-40 \mathrm{~cm}$
7. A798.3-Tiny hearts on charcoal grey - fat $1 / 4$
8. A799.2-Cherubs on pink $-11 / 4 y d-1.20 \mathrm{~m}$
9. A800.2 - Love flowers on duck egg $-5 / 8 y d-60 \mathrm{~cm}$

Wadding and backing 68" x 68"
All measurements include $1 / 4$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

## Cutting

For fabrics 1 and 6 you need to cut a $45^{\circ}$ angle from one corner as in the diagram A \& B. Mark $7 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ from the corner point left and right at the bottom on A and left and right at the top right corner.


## From fabric 1 cut

$20 \times 25 /$ " $^{\prime \prime} \times 4$ (A) block 1
$20 \times 17 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 25 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ (B) block 1

## From fabric 2 cut

$20 \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{7 / 8 "}$ cut in half diagonally once - block 1

## From fabric 3 cut

$16 \times 51 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 5 \frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice - sashing $2021 / 2{ }^{1} \times 21 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ - block 1

## From fabric 4 cut

$8 \times 51 / 4 " \times 51 / 4 "$ cut in half diagonally twice - sashing \& border $20 \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{7 / 8 "}$ cut in half diagonally once - block 1

From fabric 5 cut
$13 \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2 "$ - block 1 \& sashing

## From fabric 6 cut

$16 \times 25 /{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 4$ " (A) block 2
$16 \times 17 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 25 / 8^{\prime \prime}(B)$ block 2

## From fabric 7 cut

$16 \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ cut in half diagonally once - block 2
From fabric 8 cut
$16 \times 51 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ cut in half diagonally twice - sashing \& border $1621 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ - block 2

## From fabric 9 cut

$8 \times 51 / 4 " \times 51 / 4$ " cut in half diagonally twice - sashing
$16 \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{7 / 8 "}$ cut in half diagonally once - block 2

## From fabric 10 cut

$12 \times 41 / 2$ " x 41⁄2" - block 2 \& sashing

## From fabric 11 cut

$12 \times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 12 \frac{1}{2}$ " - outer border
$4 \times 5 \frac{1}{4} / \mathrm{x} \times 51 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ cut in half diagonally twice - outer border $4 \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ corners
$36 \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ cut in half diagonally once - for both blocks
$9 \times 31 / 4 " \times 31 / 4 "$ cut in half diagonally twice - for both blocks
$36 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ - for both blocks
$36 \times 1 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 1 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ cut in half diagonally once - for both blocks

## From fabric 12 cut

$6 \times 51 / 4 " \times 51 / 4$ " cut in half diagonally twice - sashing
$24 \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2 "$ - sashing

## Making up the block.

Both blocks are made up in the same way.


B1


Lay out all the fabric pieces for block 1 . Stitch the corner pieces first by sewing the small triangles together to make a square. Sew two sets of squares together and then stitch the two sets together to make a square.


## Next the heart block.

I have put number for the sewing order. Stitch number 1 and 2 together, press and then number 3 to $1 \& 2$. Now 4 and 5 together and then sew the two pieces together. Adding 6 and 7 to each corner to complete the block.

Lay out all the block pieces and sew in rows and then the rows together to complete the block. For block 1 you need to stitch 5 blocks in total.

For block 2 you need 4 blocks in total.

## Making up the sashing blocks.



Both $A$ and $B$ blocks are made up in the same way. Sew the small triangles together press and then stitch the two larger triangles together to make a square. You need 32 blocks of each colour way.

## Completing the quilt top.

Lay out all the sashing blocks, strips and blocks as in the main diagram. Sew in rows from the top to bottom. Pressing your seams in the opposite way each time as this will help when sewing the rows together. On row 3,5 and 7 it will be outer strip, sashing and blocks. Quilt top complete.

## Quilting

Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.
Quilt by hand or machine maybe a heart pattern. Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt top.

## Binding

Use your favorite method from fabric 11 to bind the quilt.

## Wadding and backing 68" x 68"

All measurements include $1 / 4$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

## Cutting

For fabrics 1 and 6 you need to cut a $45^{\circ}$ angle from one corner as in the diagram A \& B. Mark $7 / \mathrm{s}^{\prime \prime}$ from the corner point left and right at the bottom on A and left and right at the top right corner.


From fabric 1 cut
$20 \times 25 / 8$ x 4" (A) block 1
$20 \times 17 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 25 / 8^{\prime \prime}(B)$ block 1

## From fabric 2 cut

$20 \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{7 / 8 "}$ cut in half diagonally once - block 1

## From fabric 3 cut

$16 \times 51 / 4$ " $\times 1 \frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice - sashing 20 2½" x $2^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ - block 1

## From fabric 4 cut

$8 \times 51 / 4 " \times 51 / 4 "$ cut in half diagonally twice - sashing \& border $20 \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{7 / 8 "}$ cut in half diagonally once - block 1

From fabric 5 cut
$13 \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2 "$ - block 1 \& sashing

## From fabric 6 cut

$16 \times 25 /{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 4$ " (A) block 2
$16 \times 17 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 25 / 8^{\prime \prime}(B)$ block 2

## From fabric 7 cut

$16 \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ cut in half diagonally once - block 2
From fabric 8 cut
$16 \times 51 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ cut in half diagonally twice - sashing \& border $1621 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ - block 2

## From fabric 9 cut

$8 \times 51 / 4 " \times 51 / 4$ " cut in half diagonally twice - sashing
$16 \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{7 / 8 "}$ cut in half diagonally once - block 2

## From fabric 10 cut

$12 \times 41 / 2$ " x 41⁄2" - block 2 \& sashing

## From fabric 11 cut

$12 \times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 12 \frac{1}{2}$ " - outer border
$4 \times 5 \frac{1}{4} / \mathrm{x} \times 51 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ cut in half diagonally twice - outer border $4 \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ corners
$36 \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ cut in half diagonally once - for both blocks
$9 \times 31 / 4 " \times 31 / 4 "$ cut in half diagonally twice - for both blocks
$36 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ - for both blocks
$36 \times 1 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 1 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ cut in half diagonally once - for both blocks

## From fabric 12 cut

$6 \times 51 / 4 " \times 51 / 4$ " cut in half diagonally twice - sashing
$24 \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2 "$ - sashing

## Making up the block.

Both blocks are made up in the same way.


Lay out all the fabric pieces for block 1 . Stitch the corner pieces first by sewing the small triangles together to make a square. Sew two sets of squares together and then stitch the two sets together to make a square.


## Next the heart block.

I have put number for the sewing order. Stitch number 1 and 2 together, press and then number 3 to $1 \& 2$. Now 4 and 5 together and then sew the two pieces together. Adding 6 and 7 to each corner to complete the block.

Lay out all the block pieces and sew in rows and then the rows together to complete the block. For block 1 you need to stitch 5 blocks in total.

For block 2 you need 4 blocks in total.

## Making up the sashing blocks.



Both $A$ and $B$ blocks are made up in the same way. Sew the small triangles together press and then stitch the two larger triangles together to make a square. You need 32 blocks of each colour way.

## Completing the quilt top.

Lay out all the sashing blocks, strips and blocks as in the main diagram. Sew in rows from the top to bottom. Pressing your seams in the opposite way each time as this will help when sewing the rows together. On row 3,5 and 7 it will be outer strip, sashing and blocks. Quilt top complete.

## Quilting

Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.
Quilt by hand or machine maybe a heart pattern. Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt top.

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
