


Designed and made by Sally Ablett - Quilt 1

Size of quilt 60" x 60" - unfinished block size $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ "



Main diagram

Requirements

Fabrics from the All we need is Love collection:

- 1. A797.3 All we need is love on charcoal grey 1/2yd 1/2m
- 2. A798.2 Tiny hearts on red fat $\frac{1}{4}$
- 3. A799.1 Cherubs on cream 1¼yd 1.20m
- 4. A800.1 Love flowers on cream ³/₄yd 70cm
- 5. A801.3 Love hearts on charcoal grey fat¹⁄₄
- 6. A797.1 All we need is love on linen 3/3 yd 40cm
- 7. A798.3 Tiny hearts on charcoal grey fat¹⁄₄
- 8. A799.2 Cherubs on pink 11/4yd 1.20m
- 9. A800.2 Love flowers on duck egg ⁵/₈yd 60cm
- 10. A801.2 Love hearts on red fat¹/₄
- 11. BB03 Light grey 21/4yd 2.10m
- 12. BB148 White peal 1⅓yd 1.10m

Wadding and backing 68" x 68"

All measurements include 1/4" seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

Cutting

For fabrics 1 and 6 you need to cut a 45° angle from one corner as in the diagram A & B. Mark $\frac{7}{8}$ " from the corner point left and right at the bottom on A and left and right at the top right corner.





From fabric 1 cut

20 x 25/8" x 4" (A) block 1 20 x 17/8" x 25/8" (B) block 1

From fabric 2 cut

20 x 2⁷/₈" x 2⁷/₈" cut in half diagonally once - block 1

From fabric 3 cut

16 x 5¹/₄" x 5¹/₄" cut in half diagonally twice - sashing 20 2¹/₂" x 2¹/₂" - block 1

From fabric 4 cut

 $8 \times 5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice - sashing & border 20 x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once - block 1

From fabric 5 cut

13 x 41/2" x 41/2" - block 1 & sashing

From fabric 6 cut

16 x 2⁵/₈" x 4" (A) block 2 16 x 1⁷/₈" x 2⁵/₈" (B) block 2

From fabric 7 cut

16 x 2⁷/₈" x 2⁷/₈" cut in half diagonally once - block 2

From fabric 8 cut

16 x 5¹/₄" x 5¹/₄" cut in half diagonally twice – sashing & border 16 2¹/₂" x 2¹/₂" - block 2

From fabric 9 cut

 $8 \times 5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice - sashing 16 x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once - block 2

From fabric 10 cut

12 x 41/2" x 41/2" - block 2 & sashing

From fabric 11 cut


12 x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " - outer border 4 x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice - outer border 4 x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " corners 36 x $2\frac{1}{8}$ " x $2\frac{1}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once - for both blocks 9 x $3\frac{1}{4}$ " x $3\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice - for both blocks 36 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " - for both blocks 36 x $1\frac{1}{8}$ " x $1\frac{1}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once - for both blocks

From fabric 12 cut

 $6 \ge 5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice - sashing 24 x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " - sashing

Making up the block.

Both blocks are made up in the same way.



Lay out all the fabric pieces for block 1. Stitch the corner pieces first by sewing the small triangles together to make a square. Sew two sets of squares together and then stitch the two sets together to make a square.



Next the heart block.

I have put number for the sewing order. Stitch number 1 and 2 together, press and then number 3 to 1 & 2. Now 4 and 5 together and then sew the two pieces together. Adding 6 and 7 to each corner to complete the block.

Lay out all the block pieces and sew in rows and then the rows together to complete the block. For block 1 you need to stitch 5 blocks in total.

For block 2 you need 4 blocks in total.

Making up the sashing blocks.



Both A and B blocks are made up in the same way. Sew the small triangles together press and then stitch the two larger triangles together to make a square. You need 32 blocks of each colour way.

Completing the quilt top.

Lay out all the sashing blocks, strips and blocks as in the main diagram. Sew in rows from the top to bottom. Pressing your seams in the opposite way each time as this will help when sewing the rows together. On row 3, 5 and 7 it will be outer strip, sashing and blocks. Quilt top complete.

Quilting

Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.

Quilt by hand or machine maybe a heart pattern. Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt top.

Binding

Use your favorite method from fabric 11 to bind the quilt.

Requirements

Fabrics from the All we need is Love collection:

- 1. A797.2 All we need is love on flirty red $\frac{1}{2}$ yd $\frac{1}{2}$ m
- 2. A798.1 Tiny hearts on cream fat $\frac{1}{4}$
- 3. A799.3 Cherubs on red 11/4yd 1.20m
- 4. A800.2 Love flowers on duck egg ³/₄yd
- 5. A801.1 Love hearts on cream fat $\frac{1}{4}$
- 6. A797.3 All we need is love on charcoal grey 3/yd 70cm
- 7. A798.2 Tiny hearts on red fat¹/₄
- 8. A799.1 Cherubs on cream 1¼yd 1.20m
- 9. A800.3 Love flowers on red 5/8yd 60cm
- 10. A801.3 Love hearts on charcoal grey fat $\frac{1}{4}$
- 11. BB30 Black 2¼yd 2.10m
- 12. BB03 Light grey 11/8yd 1.10m

Wadding and backing 68" x 68"

All measurements include 1/4" seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

Cutting

For fabrics 1 and 6 you need to cut a 45° angle from one corner as in the diagram A & B. Mark $\frac{7}{8}$ " from the corner point left and right at the bottom on A and left and right at the top right corner.





From fabric 1 cut

20 x 2⁵/₈" x 4" (A) block 1 20 x 1⁷/₈" x 2⁵/₈" (B) block 1

From fabric 2 cut

20 x 2⁷/₈" x 2⁷/₈" cut in half diagonally once - block 1

From fabric 3 cut

16 x 5¹/₄" x 5¹/₄" cut in half diagonally twice - sashing 20 2¹/₂" x 2¹/₂" - block 1

From fabric 4 cut

 $8 \times 5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice - sashing & border 20 x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once - block 1

From fabric 5 cut

13 x 41/2" x 41/2" - block 1 & sashing

From fabric 6 cut

16 x 2⁵/₈" x 4" (A) block 2 16 x 1⁷/₈" x 2⁵/₈" (B) block 2

From fabric 7 cut

16 x 2⁷/₈" x 2⁷/₈" cut in half diagonally once - block 2

From fabric 8 cut

16 x 5¹/₄" x 5¹/₄" cut in half diagonally twice – sashing & border 16 2¹/₂" x 2¹/₂" - block 2

From fabric 9 cut

 $8 \times 5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice - sashing 16 x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once - block 2

From fabric 10 cut

12 x 41/2" x 41/2" - block 2 & sashing

From fabric 11 cut

12 x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " - outer border 4 x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice - outer border 4 x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " corners 36 x $2\frac{1}{8}$ " x $2\frac{1}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once - for both blocks 9 x $3\frac{1}{4}$ " x $3\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice - for both blocks 36 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " - for both blocks 36 x $1\frac{1}{8}$ " x $1\frac{1}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once - for both blocks

From fabric 12 cut

 $6 \ge 5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice - sashing 24 x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " - sashing

Making up the block.

Both blocks are made up in the same way.



Lay out all the fabric pieces for block 1. Stitch the corner pieces first by sewing the small triangles together to make a square. Sew two sets of squares together and then stitch the two sets together to make a square.




Next the heart block.

I have put number for the sewing order. Stitch number 1 and 2 together, press and then number 3 to 1 & 2. Now 4 and 5 together and then sew the two pieces together. Adding 6 and 7 to each corner to complete the block.

Lay out all the block pieces and sew in rows and then the rows together to complete the block. For block 1 you need to stitch 5 blocks in total.

For block 2 you need 4 blocks in total.

Making up the sashing blocks.



Both A and B blocks are made up in the same way. Sew the small triangles together press and then stitch the two larger triangles together to make a square. You need 32 blocks of each colour way.

Completing the quilt top.

Lay out all the sashing blocks, strips and blocks as in the main diagram. Sew in rows from the top to bottom. Pressing your seams in the opposite way each time as this will help when sewing the rows together. On row 3, 5 and 7 it will be outer strip, sashing and blocks. Quilt top complete.

Quilting

Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.

Quilt by hand or machine maybe a heart pattern. Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt top.

Binding

Use your favorite method from fabric 11 to bind the quilt.
