




STAR BLOCKS (FINISHED SIZE: 12" SQUARE)


To simplify **Star Block** construction, organize the fabrics into the following colorway groups. Each colorway uses **U** (white) and 3 colored fabrics.

1. Flying Geese Unit: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) R 2" square. Place the marked R square, right sides together (RST), at a corner of (1) U 2" x 3-1/2" rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal U corner triangle. Repeat with another R 2" square at the opposite corner of the U rectangle to complete (1) Flying Geese Unit. Make (4).



- 2. Sew (2) Flying Geese Units to the opposite sides of (1) R 3-1/2" square to make (1) row unit.
- **3.** Sew (2) **U** 2" squares to the opposite short sides of (1) **Flying Geese Unit** to make a row unit. Make (2).







Make (2) row units.



4. Noting placement of units, sew together sewn pieces from **Step 2-3**, as shown. **Block Center** measures 6-1/2" square unfinished.



- 5. Repeat Step 1 to make (4) Flying Geese Units of each O/U and T/U colorways. Use (8) of each O and T 2" squares and (8) U 2" x 3-1/2" rectangles.
- 6. Sew (1) T/U unit on top of (1) O/U unit. Make (4) stacked Flying Geese Units.



- 7. Middle Unit: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) O 2" square. Place O square, RST, at a corner of (1) U 2" x 3-1/2" rectangle. Noting orientation, sew on drawn line and trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal O corner triangle. Repeat to make a mirror-imaged unit. Make (4) of each.
- **8.** Sew both units to the left and right sides of (1) **Step 6** unit to make (1) **Middle Unit**. Make (4). Unit measures 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" unfinished.





Draw diagonal line on wrong side of print square.



Sew on drawn line and trim 1/4" away from sewn line.




Open and press to reveal **O** corner triangle. Make (4).



Repeat with another **O** square to make a mirror-imaged unit. Make (4).






- 9. Half-Square Triangle (HST): Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) U 2-1/2" square. Place U square, RST, on (1) T 2-1/2" square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of drawn line. Cut along drawn line to yield (2) HST units. Open and press. HST units measure 2" square. Make (8) HST units.
- **10.** Four-Patch Unit: Sew together (2) HST units and (2) **U** 2" squares, as shown. Unit measures 3-1/2" square unfinished. Make (4).



- **11.** Sew (2) Four-Patch Units to the opposite short sides of (1) Middle Unit to make a row unit. Make (2) row units.
- 12. Sew (2) Middle Units to the left and right side of Block Center to make (1) row unit.



13. Sew together row units to complete (1) **Star Block**. Block measures 12-1/2" square. Make (2).



Star Block (**T/O/R**) Measures 12-1/2" square Make (2)


14. Referring to the Fabric Designation Chart on page 4, repeat Steps 1-13 to make a total of (17) Star Blocks.




CHAIN BLOCKS

Corner Units


- **15.** Sew (1) **U** and **W** 2" x WOF strips along the long sides. Make (8) strip sets. Cut pieced strip sets at 2" intervals to yield (144) sewn units, as shown below.
- **16. 4-Patch Unit:** Noting rotation, sew together (2) of the previously sewn units, measuring 3-1/2" square unfinished. Make (72).



- 17. Sew together (1) \mathbf{U} 2" x 3-1/2" rectangle and (1) \mathbf{W} 2" square to make (1) \mathbf{U}/\mathbf{W} unit, set aside. Make (4).
- **18.** Sew (1) **U** 2" x 3-1/2" rectangle to the right of (1) **4-Patch Unit**. Add (1) **U/W** unit to the bottom to complete (1) **Corner Unit**, measuring 5" square unfinished. Make (4).
- **19.** Noting rotation of pieces, sew (2) **Corner Units** to the opposite long sides of (1) **V** 3-1/2" x 5" rectangle to make a row unit. Make (2).
- **20.** Sew (2) **V** 3-1/2" x 5" rectangles to the left and right sides of (1) **W** 3-1/2 square to make a row unit.



- **21.** Sew together **Step 19** and **20** row units to complete (1) **Chain Bloc**k, measuring 12-1/2" square unfinished.
- 22. Repeat Steps 17-21 to make (18) blocks.






QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY

- 23. Pieced Rows: Referring to quilt image for block placement, arrange and sew together Chain and Star Blocks to make (7) pieced rows.
 - Row 1, 3, 5, 7: (3) Chain Blocks, (2) Star Blocks
 - Row 2, 4, 6: (3) Star Blocks, (2) Chain Blocks
- **24.** Sew together pieced rows to complete quilt center.
- **25.** Border: Sew (2) **U** 3-1/2" x 84-1/2" strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 3-1/2 x 66-1/2" strips to the top and bottom of quilt center to complete quilt top.



QUILT DIAGRAM



FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **W** 2-1/2" strips.
