## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

WOF = Width of fabric | *Sew strips via short ends, then subcut as indicated in pattern
$\left.\begin{array}{lll}\text { FRESH BREWED WORDS } & & \text { Fussy Cut: } \\ \text { (2) } 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \text { squares }\end{array}\right]$

RUNNER ASSEMBLY: Refer to DIAGRAM for proper placement and rotation.

1. Sew pieces together as indicated in diagram into rows, then sew rows together.


BORDER ASSEMBLY: Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements.
2. Sew (1) G 1-1/2" X (13-1/2") strip to top and bottom, then sew (1) G 1-1/2" X (57-1/2") strip to each side.
3. Sew (1) $\mathbf{M} 3^{\prime \prime} \mathbf{X}\left(15-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to top and bottom, then sew (1) $\mathbf{M} 3^{\prime \prime} X\left(62-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to each side.

FINISHING:
Cut batting and backing 3 " larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with $\mathbf{H}$ fabric.
