


## BLOCK ASSEMBLY

### Block A Assembly

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) A 3 7/8" square. Place square, right sides together, on (1) B 3 7/8" square. Sew 1/4" away from and right and left sides of drawn line. Cut along drawn line. Open and press to yield 2 HST units. Square to 3 1/2". Repeat steps to make the following HST units:




2. Arrange and sew together 2 HST units and (2) A 3 1/2" squares to make the top section of the block. Repeat steps to make the following HST units:




3. Sew (2) A 3" x 6 1/2" rectangles to the opposite short sides of (1) I 6 1/2" x 7 1/2" rectangle to make the bottom section of the block.




4. Sew top and bottom sections together to complete 1 block. Square to  $9\frac{1}{2}'' \times 12\frac{1}{2}''$ . Repeat steps to make the following **BLOCK A**.





### Block B Assembly


5. Sew (2) J  $4'' \times 9\frac{1}{2}''$  rectangles to each side of (1) C  $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 9\frac{1}{2}''$  rectangle. Add (2) A  $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 9\frac{1}{2}''$  rectangles to each side to complete 1 block. Square to  $9\frac{1}{2}'' \times 12\frac{1}{2}''$ . Repeat steps to make the following **BLOCK B**:





### Block C Assembly


6. Sew (1) K  $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 9\frac{1}{2}''$  rectangle to each side of (1) C  $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 9\frac{1}{2}''$  rectangle. Add (1) A  $2'' \times 9\frac{1}{2}''$  rectangle to each side to complete 1 block. Square to  $9\frac{1}{2}'' \times 12\frac{1}{2}''$ . Repeat steps to make the following **BLOCK C**:





### Block D Assembly

7. Sew (1) D  $5'' \times 9\frac{1}{2}''$  rectangle to each side of (1) A  $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 9\frac{1}{2}''$  rectangle. Add (1) A  $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 9\frac{1}{2}''$  rectangle to each side to complete 1 block. Square to  $9\frac{1}{2}'' \times 12\frac{1}{2}''$ . Repeat steps to make the following:







### Block E Assembly


8. Sew (1) L  $5\frac{1}{2}'' \times 9\frac{1}{2}''$  rectangle to each side of (1) B  $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 9\frac{1}{2}''$  rectangle to complete 1 block. Square to  $9\frac{1}{2}'' \times 12\frac{1}{2}''$ . Repeat steps to make the following **BLOCK E**:

### Quilt Center Assembly:

9. Arrange and sew blocks into columns.

10. Sew together columns and (2) E  $2'' \times 45\frac{1}{2}''$  strips to complete quilt center.

**BORDER ASSEMBLY** *MEASURE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF THE QUILT TOP TO ENSURE BORDER SIZES, BELOW ARE OUR CUTTING SIZES.*

11. **Inner border #1.** Sew (1) E  $2'' \times (45\frac{1}{2}'')$  border strip to each side of quilt center. Sew (1) E  $2'' \times (42\frac{1}{2}'')$  border strip to the top and bottom of quilt center.

12. **Pieced inner border #2.** Arrange and sew (16)  $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$  rectangles into a column, using fabrics as shown in Quilt Diagram. Make 2 columns. Sew 1 column to each side of quilt center. (Note rotation of columns.)


Arrange and sew together (14) 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles into a row. Add (1) **B** and (1) **I** 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" square to each end of the row as shown. Make 2 rows and sew to the top and bottom of quilt center. (Note rotation of rows.)

**13. Inner border #3.** Sew (1) **E** 2" x (60 1/2") border strip to each side of quilt center. Sew (1) **E** 2" x (57 1/2") border strip to the top and bottom of quilt center.

**14. Inner border #4.** Sew (1) **H** 1" x (63 1/2") border strip to each side of quilt center. Sew (1) **H** 1" x (58 1/2") border strip to the top and bottom of quilt center.

**15. Outer border.** Sew (1) **D** 3 1/2" x (64 1/2") border strip to each side of quilt center. Sew (1) **D** 3 1/2" x (64 1/2") border strip to the top and bottom of quilt center to complete quilt top.

QUILT DIAGRAM



**FINISHING :** Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.
