#### **SNOWBALL BLOCKS**

- 1. Four-Patch Unit: Sew together (1) 3-1/2" square of each **B**, **I**, **O** and **P**, as shown.
- 2. Corner Triangles: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) \$ 2" square. Place square, right sides together (RST), at a corner of the Four-Patch Unit made in step 1. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal \$ corner triangle. Repeat with (3) additional \$ squares for the remaining corners of the same Four-Patch Unit to complete (1) \$ square Unit to Co


- **4. Unit 1:** Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) **S** 2-1/2" square. Place square, RST, at a corner of (1) **Q** 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal **S** corner triangle. Repeat with another **S** square at the opposite corner of the same **Q** rectangle to complete **Flying Geese** piece.
- 5. Sew (2) \$ 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles to the short sides of Flying Geese piece to make Unit 1.



- **6.** Unit 2: Repeat step 4 (Flying Geese) using (2) **S** 2-1/2" squares and (1) **Q** 2-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangle. For step 5 use (2) **S** 1" x 2-1/2" to complete Unit 2.
- 7. Unit 3: Sew (2)  $\mathbf{S}$  1-1/2"  $\times$  3" rectangles to the opposite sides of (1)  $\mathbf{Q}$  1-1/2" square.




Sew Units 1-3 together, as shown, then add (1) \$ 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle to the top of sewn unit to complete (1) Small Tree Block, measuring 6-1/2" x 8-1/2" unfinished. Make (3).





Small Tree Block Make (3) of **Q** Measures: 6-1/2" x 8-1/2"



**9.** Using **S** fabric, repeat **Steps 4-8** to make a total number of **Small Tree Blocks** in the following colorways:







#### **BIG TREE BLOCKS**

**10.** Repeat **Steps 4-7** to assemble the **Big Tree Blocks**.

Unit 1: Use (2) **S** 2-1/2" squares and (1) **H** 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle (flying geese piece). Then add (2) **S** 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles to the short sides to complete Unit 1.


Unit 2: Use (2) \$ 2-1/2" squares and (1) **H** 2-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangle (flying geese piece).

Then add (2) \$ 1" x 2-1/2" rectangles to the short sides to complete Unit 2. Make (2).

Unit 3: Use (2) **S** 2-1/2"  $\times$  3" rectangles and (1) **Q** 1-1/2"  $\times$  2-1/2" rectangle.








**11.** Sew Units 1-3 together, as shown to complete (1) Big Tree Block, measuring 6-1/2" x 8-1/2" unfinished. Make (8).

**12.** Repeat **Steps 10** and **11** to make (6) of **K**.





Big Tree Block




**13.** Pieced Rows: Arrange and sew (5) Snowball Blocks into a row. Make (6) rows. Row 1 is shown below.



- 14. Arrange and sew together Pieced Rows to complete quilt center.
- **15.** Inner Border 1: Sew (2) **\$** 2" x 36-1/2" strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew (2) **\$** 2" x 33-1/2" strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.
- **16.** Inner Border 2: Sew (2) J 2" x 39-1/2" strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew (2) J 2" x 36-1/2" strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.
- 17. Inner Border 3:
  - a. Columns: Arrange and sew together (7) Tree Blocks into columns. Make (2). Add columns to the left and right sides of quilt center, respectively.
  - b. Rows: Arrange and sew (6) Tree Blocks and (2) \$ 8-1/2" squares into rows. Make (2). Add rows to the top and bottom of quilt center, respectively.
- **18.** Inner Border 4: Sew (2) **\$** 1-1/2" x 58-1/2" strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew (2) **\$** 1-1/2" x 54-1/2" strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.
- **19.** Inner Border 5: Sew (2) J 1-1/2" x 60-1/2" strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew (2) J 1-1/2" x 56-1/2" strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.
- **20.** Outer Border: Sew (2) A 5-1/2" x 62-1/2" strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew (2) A 5-1/2" x 66-1/2" strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.



#### **QUILT ASSEMBLY**



**FINISHING:** Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **J** 2-1/4" strips.
