## SNOWBALL BLOCKS

1. Four-Patch Unit: Sew together (1) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square of each $\mathbf{B}, \mathbf{I}, \mathbf{O}$ and $\mathbf{P}$, as shown.
2. Corner Triangles: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) $\mathbf{S} 2$ " square. Place square, right sides together (RST), at a corner of the Four-Patch Unit made in step 1. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal $\mathbf{S}$ corner triangle. Repeat with (3) additional $\mathbf{S}$ squares for the remaining corners of the same Four-Patch Unit to complete (1) Snowball Block. Make (4). Block measures 6-1/2" square unfinished.



Draw diagonal line on wrong side of $\mathbf{S}$ square.


Sew on drawn line.


Trim 1/4" and open to reveal $\mathbf{S}$ corner triangle. corners.
3. Repeat to make a total number of Snowball Blocks in the following colorways:


Snowball Blocks measure
6-1/2" square unfinished.

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## SMALL TREE BLOCKS

## Flying Geese Units

4. Unit 1: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) $\mathbf{S} 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Place square, RST, at a corner of (1) $\mathbf{Q} 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal $\mathbf{S}$ corner triangle. Repeat with another $\mathbf{S}$ square at the opposite corner of the same $\mathbf{Q}$ rectangle to complete Flying Geese piece.
5. Sew (2) S 1-1/2" $\times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles to the short sides of Flying Geese piece to make Unit 1.


Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" and open to reveal S corner triangle. Repeat on opposite corner.

6. Unit 2: Repeat step 4 (Flying Geese) using (2) $\boldsymbol{S} 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares and (1) $\mathbf{Q} 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. For step 5 use (2) S $1^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ to complete Unit 2.
7. Unit 3: Sew (2) S 1-1/2" $\times 3^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles to the opposite sides of (1) $\mathbf{Q} 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square.

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9. Using S fabric, repeat Steps 4-8 to make a total number of Small Tree Blocks in the following colorways:


## BIG TREE BLOCKS

10. Repeat Steps 4-7 to assemble the Big Tree Blocks.

Unit 1: Use (2) S 2-1/2" squares and (1) H 2-1/2" $\times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle (flying geese piece). Then add (2) S 1-1/2" $\times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles to the short sides to complete Unit 1.

Unit 2: Use (2) S 2-1/2" squares and (1) H 2-1/2" $\times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ " rectangle (flying geese piece). Then add (2) S $1^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2 "$ rectangles to the short sides to complete Unit 2. Make (2).

Unit 3: Use (2) S 2-1/2" $\times 3$ " rectangles and (1) $\mathbf{Q}$ 1-1/2" $\times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle.

11. Sew Units 1-3 together, as shown to complete (1) Big Tree Block, measuring 6-1/2" $\times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished. Make (8).
12. Repeat Steps 10 and 11 to make (6) of $\mathbf{K}$.

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## QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to ouilt image for block placement guide on page 7.
13. Pieced Rows: Arrange and sew (5) Snowball Blocks into a row. Make (6) rows.

Row 1 is shown below.

14. Arrange and sew together Pieced Rows to complete quilt center.
15. Inner Border 1: Sew (2) S 2 " $\times 36-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew (2) $\mathbf{S} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 33-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.
16. Inner Border 2: Sew (2) J 2 " $\times 39-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew (2) J 2" $\times 36-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.
17. Inner Border 3:
a. Columns: Arrange and sew together (7) Tree Blocks into columns. Make (2). Add columns to the left and right sides of quilt center, respectively.
b. Rows: Arrange and sew (6) Tree Blocks and (2) S 8-1/2" squares into rows. Make (2). Add rows to the top and bottom of quilt center, respectively.
18. Inner Border 4: Sew (2) $\mathbf{S} 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 58-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew (2) $\mathbf{S} 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 54-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.
19. Inner Border 5: Sew (2) J $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 60-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew (2) J 1-1/2" $\times 56-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.
20. Outer Border: Sew (2) A $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 62-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew (2) A 5-1/2" $\times 66-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.

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QUILT ASSEMBLY


FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using J 2-1/4" strips.
