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## Fabric requirements

### Notes

- 1/4" seams are used throughout
- Read pattern through in full before starting
- WOF width of fabric, a strip of fabric cut from selvedge to selvedge
- BKG background fabric
- HST half square triangle

## Cutting

- 1. From the following fabrics, cut the listed number of 5  $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 10  $\frac{1}{4}$ " rectangles:
  - 120-21843 ten 5  $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 10  $\frac{1}{4}$ " rectangles (cut from three 5  $\frac{1}{4}$ " WOF strips)
  - 120-21844 eight 5 1/4" x 10 1/4" rectangles (cut from two 5 1/4" WOF strips)
  - 049 Coral eight 5 1/4" x 10 1/4" rectangles (cut from two 5 1/4" WOF strips)
- 2. From the following fabrics, cut the listed number of  $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares:
  - 120-21839 twenty 3 1/2" squares
  - 120-21840 sixteen 3 ½" squares
  - 120-21842 sixteen 3 ½" squares
- 3. From the following prints cut the listed number of  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " and  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles:
  - 095 Beryl eight 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" and four 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles
  - 113 Dark Sea Green eight 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" and four 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles
  - 166 Fireworks ten 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " and five 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8  $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles
- 4. From 120-21841 cut three 8  $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips and cut those into twelve 8  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
- 5. From the background (BKG) fabric 000 White cut:
  - seven 5  $\frac{1}{4}$ " WOF strips and cut those into twenty-six 5  $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 10  $\frac{1}{4}$ " rectangles
  - six 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips. Cut two of those strips into nine 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares each. Sew the remainder end to end and cut into two 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares and eight 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 16  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips

# Making the blocks

1. To make the cross blocks, sew two print  $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares either side of a solid  $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " strip. Make two of these and sew to the top and bottom of a print  $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8 \frac{1}{2}$ " strip (see diagrams on the right).

2. For each of the thirteen parcel star blocks, you will make eight print/BKG half square triangle (HST) units. These will be made in sets of four using the 5  $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 10  $\frac{1}{4}$ " print and BKG rectangles and the HST templates.

NB: The fabric rectangles are  $\frac{1}{2}$ " bigger than the templates so that they overhang the paper by  $\frac{1}{2}$ " all around the dashed line – this is to make it easier to line up the fabrics to the paper template.

3. To make each set of HSTs, pin one print fabric and one BKG fabric rectangle to the back of one of the HST templates with the fabrics right sides together and the BKG fabric next to the paper. Shorten your machine stitch to 1.5 and sew along all of the red lines.

4. Cut the template and fabric along all the blue lines using a rotary cutter. Trim off the corners on each triangle along the green lines. Press each HST unit open. Remove paper from the back of each HST unit. Sew these HSTs into pairs as shown in the diagram on the right.



1. Follow the Assembly Diagram overleaf and steps 1 to 6 to assemble the quilt top. First sew the nine rows of the center of the quilt top. Press seams away from the HST units. Those nine rows contain the following elements:

• Rows 1, 5 and 9

Rows 3 and 7

- Three cross blocks, four pairs of HSTs and two bicycle 8 ½" squares
- Rows 2, 4, 6, and 8
- nd 8 Five pairs of HSTs ad four BKG 4 ½" squares Two cross blocks, four pairs of HSTs and three bicycle 8 ½" squares

2. Sew those nine rows together, pressing seams towards the cross blocks.

3. Sew the four outer strips. The two side strips each contain three HST units and two BKG 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 16  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and the top and bottom contain the same plus two BKG 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Press seams away from the HST units. Sew the side strips to the sides of the quilt top then the top and bottom strips to top and bottom.





4. Sew the two pieces of backing fabric together along the long sides using a  $\frac{1}{2}$ "seam. Press seam open. Trim to 72" square. Make a quilt sandwich basting together the backing, batting and quilt top and quilt as desired.

5. Sew the binding strips end to end using diagonal or straight seams as preferred. Fold and press in half wrong sides together along the length. Bind the quilt taking care to mitre corners.
