
FINISHED BLOCK SIZE: 8" x 8"

FINISHED QUILT SIZE: 47½" x 47½"

• Yardages are based on 40" fabric width.

Materials

- 1/4 yd. Blue/Green Orbs (1JHQ2) for blocks
- 1/4 yd. Multicolor Orb Grid (2JHQ1) for blocks
- 1/4 yd. Multicolor Stripes (3JHQ1) for blocks
- 1/4 yd. Green Amoeboid (4JHQ2) for blocks
- 1/4 yd. Blue Dots (5JHQ4) for blocks
- 1/4 yd. Blue/Orange Plaid (6JHQ1) for blocks
- 1/4 yd. Red/Black/White Swirl (7JHQ1) for blocks
- 1/4 yd. Yellow/Black/White Swirl (7JHQ2) for blocks
- 34 yd. Cream Dots (5JHQ8) for blocks
- 34 yd. Black Plaid (6JHQ5) for blocks
- % yd. Multicolor Orbs (1JHQ1) for sashing, inner border, and binding
- 1½ yds. White-on-Black Dots (5JHQ7) for outer border
- ¼ yd. Blue Sew Fun (10JHQ1) for outer border corners
- ⅓ yd. Alphabet Panel (9JHQ1) for border appliqué3¼ yds. for backing



Cutting

Cut strips across width of fabric, unless otherwise instructed.

From <u>each</u> of Blue/Green Orbs, Multicolor Orb Grid, Multicolor Stripes, Green Amoeboid, Blue Dots, Blue/ Orange Plaid, Red/Black/White Swirl, and Yellow/ Black/White Swirl, cut:

• 2 squares, 4½" x 4½", for A squares

From Cream Dots, cut:

■ 8 strips, 2½" x 40"; crosscut 32 rectangles, 2½" x 8½", for D rectangles (A stitch-and-flip technique will be used.)

From Black Plaid, cut:

- 4 strips, 2½" x 40"; crosscut 32 rectangles, 2½" x 4½", for B rectangles
- 4 strips, 2½" x 40"; crosscut 64 squares, 2½" x 2½", for C squares (A stitch-and-flip technique will be used.)

From Multicolor Orbs, cut:

- 6 strips, 2½" x 40", for double-fold binding
- 2 strips, 1½" x 35½", for inner border (top and bottom)
- 3 strips, 1½" x 33½", for inner border (sides) and long sashing strip (middle)
- 1 strip, 1½" x 40"; crosscut 2 rectangles, 1½" x 16½", for short sashing strips

From White-on-Black Dots, cut:

• 4 lengthwise strips, 6½" x 35½", for outer border

From Blue Sew Fun, cut:

• 4 squares, 6½" x 6½", for border corners


From Alphabet Panel:

Decide which letters and/or numbers you want to appliqué on your outer border. If you plan to use a fusible appliqué technique, follow the cutting and fusing instructions given on your fusible product. If using a traditional appliqué technique, make sure to add seam allowance as you cut out your chosen letters and/or numbers.

Block Assembly

All seams ¼". Press seams in direction of arrows unless otherwise instructed. Refer to photograph for fabric placement.


1. Using 1 assorted-print $4\frac{1}{2}$ " A square, and 2 Black Plaid $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " B rectangles, assemble a center-spool unit as shown. Repeat to make a total of 16 units.




2. Using a pencil and ruler, draw a diagonal line, from corner to corner, on the wrong side of the 64 Black Plaid 2½" C squares.




3. With right sides together, place one of the marked 2½" C squares on one end of a Cream Dots 2½" x 8½" D rectangle, being careful to orient it as shown. Sew on the drawn line. Trim as shown, leaving a ¼" seam allowance. Press seam toward triangle. Repeat technique on other end of rectangle to complete a side-spool unit. Then repeat entire step to make a total of 32 units.



4. Using 1 center-spool unit from Step 1, and 2 side-spool units from Step 3, assemble a spool block as shown. Repeat to make a total of 16 blocks.




5. Using 4 spool blocks, assemble a large section, being sure to orient the blocks as shown. Repeat to make a total of 4 sections.




Quilt Top Assembly and Borders


1. Using 2 sections from Step 5 above, and 1 Multicolor Orbs $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $16\frac{1}{2}$ " short sashing strip, assemble a block row as shown. Repeat to make two rows.



2. Sew together the 2 blocks rows, and the 3 Multicolor Orbs 1½" x 33½" long sashing and inner border strips as shown.



3. Sew the 2 Multicolor Orbs $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $35\frac{1}{2}$ " inner border strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top.




4. Sew a Blue Sew Fun 6½" corner square to each side of a White-on-Black Dots 6½" x 35½" outer border strip. Repeat to make a total of 2 pieced borders.



- 5. Sew the remaining 2 White-on-Black Dots 6½" x 35½" outer border strips to the sides of the quilt top as shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Press seams toward outer borders.
- 6. Sew the 2 pieced borders made in Step 4 to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Press seams toward pieced outer borders.
- 7. Using your preferred technique, appliqué chosen letters and numbers in place on outer borders.

Finishing

Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind. Don't forget to sign and date your finished quilt.
