| M |  | 37098-100 Stone | 1-1/8 | FOR BINDING: <br> (7) 2-1/4" $x^{\prime \prime}$ WOF strips, sew short ends together. <br> (6) 1-1/2" $\times$ WOF, sew short ends together. Subcut (2) 1-1/2" $\times 45-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders and <br> (2) $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 60-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders. <br> (7) 1-1/8" $\times$ WOF; subcut <br> (18) Frame 1 and (18) Frame 2. |
| N |  | 51583-6 Blush | 3/8 | (6) $1-1 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF; subcut (12) Frame 1, <br> (12) Frame 2, (4) Frame 3 and (4) Frame 4. <br> (4) 1-1/2" squares. |

## ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Thread to match fabrics
Template plastic
Basic sewing supplies

## DIAMOND UNITS

1. Sew (1) J Frame 1 to opposite sides of $\mathbf{A}$ Diamond.
2. Sew (1) J Frame 2 to remaining sides of $\mathbf{A}$ diamond to complete diamond unit.

3. Following steps 1-2, make diamond units using the following frame/diamond fabric combinations: M/E, N/B, and L/D. Make the number of each unit shown below.

## Half Diamond Units

4. Sew (1) $\mathbf{N}$ Frame 3 to side of $\mathbf{B}$ Half Diamond.
5. Sew (1) $\mathbf{N}$ frame 4 to side of $\mathbf{B}$ Half Diamond to complete half diamond unit.
6. Following steps 4-5, make (1) half-diamond unit each using A and D Half Diamonds and L Frames 3 and 4.

## BLOCKS

7. Sew triangles to the sides of each diamond and half diamond units as shown below. Each diamond block should measure $8^{\prime \prime} \times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Each half diamond block should measure 8 " $\times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

QUILT ASSEMBLY
8. Following the Quilt Layout on page 6, sew blocks in each vertical row together. Then, sew rows together matching seams to side points of diamonds.
9. Sew (1) M 1-1/2" $\times 60-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ border to opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew
(1) $\mathbf{N} 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square to each end of (2) $\mathbf{M} 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 45-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders. Sew to top and to bottom of quilt center.
10. Sew (1) D 4-1/4" $\times 62-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ border to opposite long sides of quilt. Sew (1) C 4-1/4" $\times 55^{\prime \prime}$ border to top and bottom of quilt.

## QUILT LAYOUT
