#### QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY

**1.** Inner Border 1: Sew (2) **B** 1" x 42-1/2" strips to the sides of (1) **E** panel rectangle, as shown.



Inner Border 2

Half-Square Triangle (HST): Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) A 4" square. Place marked A, right sides together, onto (1) B 4" square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of drawn line. Cut along drawn line to yield (2) HSTs. Open and press. Square HSTs to 3-1/2". Make (13). (Note: one HST will not be used.)



3. Repeat Step 2 to make the following combined HST units. Make (13) of each.





- **4.** Noting direction and placement of HSTs, arrange and sew together (14) HST units to make a column. Make (2). Sew to the sides of Quilt Center from **Step 1**.
- **5.** Repeat **Step 4**, using (12) HST units to make a row. Make (2). Sew to the top and bottom of **Quilt Center**.
- 6. Inner Border 3: Sew (2) D 1-1/2" x 48 1/2" strips to the sides of Quilt Center, followed by (2) D 1-1/2" x 38-1/2" strips to the top and bottom of Quilt Center.
- 7. Inner Border 4: Sew (2) B 1-1/2" x 50-1/2" strips to the sides of Quilt Center, followed by (2) B 1-1/2" x 40-1/2" strips to the top and bottom of Quilt Center.
- 8. Inner Border 5: Sew (2) A 1-1/2" x 52-1/2" strips to the sides of Quilt Center, followed by (2) A 1-1/2" x 42-1/2" strips to the top and bottom of Quilt Center.





#### **STAR BLOCK**

9. Flying Geese Unit: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) B 2" square. Align marked B, on a corner of (1) A 2" x 3-1/2" rectangle. Sew along the marked line, as shown. Trim to 1/4" seam allowance and open to reveal corner triangle. Repeat on opposite corner of A rectangle to complete. Unit measures 2" x 3-1/2". Make (4).

- **10.** Sew (2) **A/B** Flying Geese Units to the sides of (1) **B** 3-1/2" square to make a row unit, as shown.
- **11.** Sew (2) **A** 2" squares to the opposite short ends of (1) **A/B** Flying Geese Unit to make a row unit. Make (2) rows.



**12.** Sew together row units to complete (1) **Star Block**.





**13.** Repeat Steps 9-12 to make a total number of Star Blocks for the following fabric combinations:

#### LETTER BLOCKS

#### **M BLOCK**

- 14. Flying Geese Unit: Repeat Step 9 using (2) B 2" squares and (1) A 2" x 3-1/2" rectangle.
- **15.** Make another flying geese unit using (2) **A** 2" squares and (1) **B** 2" x 3-1/2" rectangle.

- **16.** Sew the flying geese units (**Steps 14-15**) together and add (1) **A** 3-1/2" square at the bottom, as shown.
- 17. Add (2) B 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles to the sides of the previously sewn unit, followed by (2) A 1" x 6-1/2" rectangles to complete (1) M Block. Make (2).



#### E BLOCK

- **18.** Sew (2) **A** 2" x 2-1/4" rectangles to the opposite long sides of (1) **I** 1-1/2" x 2-1/4" rectangle, as shown.
- **19.** Add (1) **A** 1-3/4" x 4-1/2" rectangle to the right of sewn unit, then add (2) **I** 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles to the top and bottom.
- **20.** Add (1) I 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle to the left of sewn unit, followed by (2) A 1-1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles to the left and right sides to complete (1) E Block.





#### **R BLOCK**

- 21. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) B 1" square. Place square, right sides together at the top right corner of (1) A 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal B corner triangle. Repeat for the opposite, bottom right corner of the same A rectangle.
- **22.** Add (2) **B** 1-1/2" squares to the opposite short ends of sewn unit to make **R1**.



- 23. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) A 1-1/2" square. Place square, right sides together at the top right corner of (1) B 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal A corner triangle to make R2.
- 24. Repeat Step 23 to make a mirror-imaged R2 unit.





- 25. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) A 2-3/4" square. Place square, right sides together, at the top left corner of (1) B 3-1/2" square. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal A corner triangle. Repeat with another A 2-3/4" square at the bottom right corner of the same B square. Add (1) B 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" to the left of pieced square unit to make R3.
- **26.** Noting rotation of pieced units, sew together units R1-R3, and add (2) **A** 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles to the left and right to complete (1) **R** Block.



27. Repeat Steps 21-26 to make (1) R Block each for fabrics C and D.







#### **Y BLOCK**

- 28. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) C 1" square. Place square, right sides together, at the bottom left and along the short side of (1) A 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal C corner triangle. Repeat with another C square on the bottom right sides of the same A rectangle.
- **29.** Add (1) **C** 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangle to the bottom of previously sewn unit.
- 30. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) A 1-1/2" square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) C 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal C corner triangle. Add to the previously sewn unit to make unit Y1, as shown.





- 31. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) A 1" square. Place square, right sides together, at the bottom right corner of (1) C 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal A corner triangle. This is unit Y2.
- **32.** Sew Y1 to the top, and Y2 to the bottom of (1) A 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle, as shown.
- 33. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) A 1" square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) C 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal A corner triangle. Add to the right side of previously sewn unit.
- **34.** Add (2) A 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles to the left and right sides to complete (1) Y Block.





#### C BLOCK

- 35. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) C 1" square. Place square, right sides together and along the short side, at the top left corner of (1) A 3-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal C corner triangle. Repeat with another C square at the bottom left corner of the same A rectangle.
- **36.** Add (1) C 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle to the left of previously sewn unit to make unit C1.
- 37. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) A 1-1/2" square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) C 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal A corner triangle. Repeat to make a mirror-imaged unit.
- **38.** Noting placement of units (Step 37), sew both to the top and bottom of C1, as shown. Then sew (2) **A** 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles to the left and right sides to complete **C Block**.





#### H BLOCK

- **39.** Sew (2) A 2-1/2" x 3" rectangles to the opposite long sides of (1) H 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangle.
- **40.** Sew (2) **H** 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles to the left and right sides of previously sewn unit, followed by (2) **A** 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles to the left and right sides to complete (1) **H** Block.



#### I BLOCK

- **41.** Sew (2) **A** 2" x 4-1/2" rectangles to the opposite long sides of (1) **C** 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle.
- 42. Add (2) C 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles to the top and bottom sides of previous unit, followed by (2) A 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles to the left and right sides to complete (1) I Block.





#### S BLOCK

43. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) A 1-1/2" square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) C 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal A corner triangle. Repeat with another A square at the opposite side of the same C rectangle to make unit S1. Make (2).



Make (2)

44. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) A 1-1/2" square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) C 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal A corner triangle. Repeat with another A square at the opposite side of the same C rectangle to make unit S2.



- **45.** Sew together (1) **C** 1-1/2" x 2" and (1) **A** 2" x 3-1/2" rectangle to make (1) **S3** unit. Make (2).
- 46. Sew together S1, S2 and S3, as shown. Then add (2) A 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles to the left and right sides to complete (1) S Block.
- 47. Repeat Steps 43-46 to make (1) S Block using I.





#### T BLOCK

- **48.** Sew (2) **A** 2" x 5-1/2" rectangles to the opposite long sides of (1) **G** 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangle.
- **49.** Add (1) **G** 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle to the top of previous sewn unit. Sew (2) **A** 1-1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles to the left and right sides to complete (1) **T** Block.



#### A BLOCK

- 50. Repeat Step 43 using (2) A 1-1/2" squares and (1) D 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle. Make (1) unit A1.
- **51.** Sew (2) **D** 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles to the sides of (1) **A** 2-1/2" square to make (2) unit A2.
- 52. Sew (2) A2 units to the opposite long sides of (1) D 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle. Add A1 unit to the top of sewn unit.
- **53.** Sew (2) A  $1-1/2'' \times 6-1/2''$  rectangles to the sides to complete (1) A Block.





#### QUILT ASSEMBLY

- **54.** Referencing the quilt image below, arrange and sew together (9) **Star Blocks** to make a pieced column. Make (2) columns and sew to the left and right sides of Quilt Center.
- **55.** Arrange and sew together (4) **Star Blocks** and (5) "**M-E-R-R-Y**" letter blocks to make a pieced row. Sew row to the top of Quilt Center.
- **56.** Arrange and sew together (9) "C-H-R-I-S-T-M-A-S" letter blocks to make a pieced row. Sew row to the bottom of Quilt Center.





#### BORDERS

- 57. Inner Border 7: Sew (2) A 2" x 66-1/2" strips to the long sides of Quilt Center, followed by (2) A 2" x 57-1/2" strips to the remaining opposite short sides of Quilt Center.
- 58. Inner Border 8: Sew (2) B 1-1/2" x 69-1/2" strips to the long sides of Quilt Center, followed by (2) B 1-1/2" x 59-1/2" strips to the remaining opposite short sides of Quilt Center.
- 59. Outer Border: Sew (2) C 4-1/2" x 71-1/2" strips to the long sides of Quilt Center, followed by (2) C 4-1/2" x 67-1/2" strips to the remaining opposite short sides of Quilt Center to complete quilt top.



**FINISHING:** Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **B** 2-1/4" strips.
