Construction Method: Piecing



Background Fabric #1	1 FQ or 2 FE	Frost 17057-08	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 2 – 4½" x 4½" squares (<b>A patch</b>)</li> <li>• 5 – 4⅞" x 4⅞" squares; cut 1x diagonally to yield 10 triangles (<b>B patch</b>)</li> </ul>
Pineapple Fabrics	1 FE of each fabric	Pink 17057-02	From <b>EACH</b> of the fabrics listed in the yellow section of the chart, cut: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 1 – 4⅞" x 4⅞" squares; cut 1x diagonally to yield 2 triangles (<b>B patch</b>)</li> <li>• 1 – 5¼" x 5¼" square; cut 2x diagonally to yield 4 triangles (<b>C patch</b>)</li> </ul>


<b>Pineapple and Leaves Fabrics</b>	1 FQ of each fabric or 2 FE	Lime 17057-42	From <b>BOTH</b> fabrics listed in the green section of the chart, cut: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 4 – 4<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" x 4<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" squares; cut 1x diagonally to yield 8 triangles (<b>B patch</b>)</li> <li>• 1 – 5<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 5<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" square; cut 2x diagonally to yield 4 triangles (<b>C patch</b>)</li> </ul>
		Grass 17057-46	
<b>Binding</b>	¼ yard	Slate 17057-13	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 3 – 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" strips; piece together for binding</li> </ul>

### Construct the Half-square triangle units (HSTs):


- HST units are comprised of 2 – B patches. Make the number indicated in the chart below.
- HSTs should measure 4<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 4<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" unfinished. Trim dog ears and square-up units if necessary.






### Construct the Triple Triangle units (TTUs):




- Triple-triangle units are comprised of 2 – C patches and 1 – B patch.
- Sew two C patches together as indicated in the diagram and press the seams in the direction of the red arrows, as shown.
- Sew the C/C patch unit to the B patch and press the seam toward the B patch.
- Make ONE of each of the following TTUs as indicated in the chart below.
- TTUs should measure 4<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 4<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" unfinished. Trim dog ears and square-up units if necessary.

### Assemble the quilt top:

- Sew the units into eight rows.
- Press the seams in each row in one direction.
- For every other row, press the seams in the opposite direction.
- Sew the rows together.
- Layer with batting and backing and quilt as desired.
- Add a sleeve, label, and binding.
- Enjoy!
