GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

It is not recommended to prewash fabric

before cutting and assembling.

Please check www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates or scan the QR Code for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

Always verify your panel size before beginning. If your panel measurements differ from those given in the pattern, trim to the desired size or use coping strips to alter the size of your panel. If coping strips are needed, add oversized, coordinating strips of fabric to the necessary edges of the panel, then trim to the size specified in the pattern.

WOF = Width of Fabric RST = Right Sides Together

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

When cutting fabrics, use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter. Measurements include $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam allowance. Label, allocate, and organize all cuts as noted.



Pickleball Panel

Fussy cut (1) 11 %" × 11 %" Panel square, centered over the "Sorry Can't" motif.* Label as A.

Fussy cut (1) $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " × $9 \frac{1}{2}$ " Panel rectangle, centered over the "Whose Serve" motif.* Label as B.

Fussy cut (1) 11 %" × 7 %" Panel rectangle, centered over the "Great Minds" motif.* Label as C.

Fussy cut (1) 17" × 22" Panel rectangle, centered over the "Pickleball Addict" motif.* Label as D.

*Note: Cutting for this print is listed width × height. If the panel motifs do not reach the edges of the required cuts, add coping strips first and then trim to the required sizes.



Green Main

Cut (2) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. Label as E. Cut (2) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. Label as F.



Pink Main

Cut (1) 5 %" × 11 %" rectangle. Label as G.



Blush Paddles*

Cut (1) 14 %" × 6 %" rectangle. Label as H.

Green Paddles*

Cut (1) 14 %" × 4 %" rectangle. Label as I.

*Please note this is a directional print. Cutting for this print is listed width × height.



White Paddles*

Cut (1) 11 %" × 5 %" rectangle. Label as J.

*Please note this is a directional print. Cutting for this print is listed width × height.



Pink Text*

Cut (1) 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle. Label as K.

*Please note this is a directional print. Cutting for this print is listed width × height.



White Text*

Cut (1) 14 %" × 5 %" rectangle. Label as L.

*Please note this is a directional print. Cutting for this print is listed width × height.



Lime Stripes*

Cut (2) $14 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 2" rectangles. Label as M. Cut (2) $7 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 2" rectangles. Label as N.

*Please note this is a directional print. Cutting for this print is listed width × height.



Green Text*

Cut (3) 2 ¼" × WOF strips. Subcut:

- (2) $22" \times 2 \%"$ rectangles. Label as O.
- (2) 20 %" × 2 %" rectangles. Label as P.

*Please note this is a directional print. Cutting for this print is listed width × height.



Blush Stripes*

Cut (2) 2 ½" × WOF strips. Subcut:

- (2) 21 ½" × 2 ½" rectangles. Label as Q.
- (2) 8 %" × 2 %" rectangles. Label as R.

*Please note this is a directional print. Cutting for this print is listed width × height.



White Pickleballs

Cut (1) 4 ½" × WOF strip. Subcut:

(1) 4 %" × 21 %" rectangle. Label as S.



Frosting Micro Gingham

Cut (2) 2 ½" × WOF strips. Subcut:

- (2) 2 %" × 21 %" rectangles. Label as T.
- (2) 2 %" × 11 %" rectangles. Label as U.



Frosting Confetti Cotton™

Cut (6) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end; subcut:

- (2) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 56 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Label as V.
- (2) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 51 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Label as W.



Lime Swiss Dot on White

Cut (12) 2 %" × WOF strips. Piece (4) together end-to-end; subcut:

(3) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × 47 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Label as X.

From remaining strips, cut:

- (8) 2 ½" × 25 ½" rectangles. Label as Y.
- (4) 2 %" × 14 %" rectangles. Label as Z.
- (2) 2 %" × 11 %" rectangles. Label as AA.



White Main

Cut (1) 7 %" × WOF strip. Subcut:

(1) 7 ½" × 21 ½" rectangle. Label as BB.

Cut (6) 6" × WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end; subcut:

- (2) $6" \times 62 \%"$ strips. Label as CC.
- (2) $6" \times 60 \%$ " strips. Label as DD.



Green Stripes

Cut (7) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × WOF strips. Set aside for binding.

SEWING TECHNIQUES

Sew all seams RST and with a ¼" seam allowance unless stated otherwise. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes.

BLOCK ASSEMBLY

 Sew (1) O-rectangle to each side of (1) D-rectangle.
 Next, sew (1) P-rectangle to the top and bottom to make (1) Block 1.

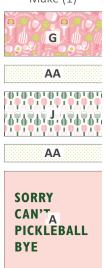
Block 1 Make (1)

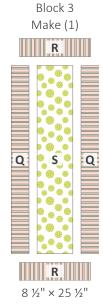
2. Sew (1) **G**-rectangle, (2) **AA**-rectangles, (1) **J**-rectangle, and (1) **A**-square together as shown below to make (1) Block 2.

Block 2 Make (1)



11 ½" × 25 ½"

Sew (1) Q-rectangle to each side of (1) S-rectangle.
 Next, sew (1) R-rectangle to the top and bottom to make (1) Block 3.

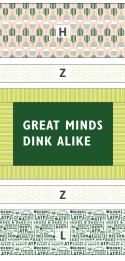


4. Sew (1) **N**-rectangle to each side of (1) **C**-rectangle. Next, sew (1) **M**-rectangle to the top and bottom.



5. Sew (1) **H**-rectangle, (2) **Z**-rectangles, the Step 4 unit, and (1) **L**-rectangle together as shown below to make (1) Block 4.

Block 4 Make (1)



14 ½" × 25 ½"

Sew (1) **T**-rectangle to each side of (1) **BB**-rectangle. Next, sew (1) U-rectangle to the top and bottom to make (1) Block 5.



11 ½" × 25 ½"

7. Sew (1) **F**-rectangle to each side of (1) **B**-rectangle. Next, sew (1) **E**-rectangle to the top and bottom.



13 ½" × 14 ½"

8. Sew (1) I-rectangle, (2) Z-rectangles, (1) K-rectangle, and the Step 7 unit together as shown, top right, to make (1) Block 6.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

9. Arrange (3) X-strips, (8) Y-rectangles, and Blocks 1-6 as shown below. Sew the rectangles and blocks together into rows. Next, sew the strips and block rows together to make the quilt center.



10. Sew (1) V-strip to each side of the quilt center. Next, sew (1) W-strip to the top and bottom as shown below. In the same manner, sew **DD**-strips to the sides and **CC**-strips to the top and bottom to complete the quilt top.

FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

11. Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste the quilt layers together and quilt as desired. Sew the Green Stripes binding strips together end-to-end. Then bind the trimmed, finished quilt using your favorite binding method.
