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





PINWHEEL POSIES QUILT

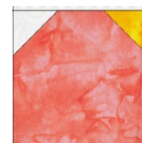
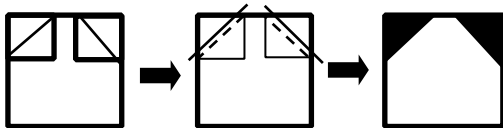
WOF = width of fabric; RST = right sides together; HST = half square triangle

All seams sewn using a 1/4" seam allowance

Fabric SKU #'s	Yardage	Cutting Instructions
Flower Petals 80606-35 -37 -56 -65  -66 -70 -81 -83	1/3 yd each	From each fabric, Cut 2 – 4 1/2" x WOF strips ○ Sub-cut 12 – 4 1/2" squares
Corner Triangles, Outer Border & Binding 80606-56 	1 5/8 yds	Cut 7 – 4 1/2" x WOF strips (set aside for outer borders) Cut 2 – 2" x WOF strips ○ Sub-cut 24 – 2" squares Cut 8 – 2 1/4" x WOF strips (set aside for binding)
Flower Centers 80606-54 	1/6 yd	Cut 3 – 1 1/2" x WOF strips ○ Sub-cut 80 – 1 1/2" squares
Leaves & Stems 86606-72 	2/3 yd	Cut 2 – 7" x WOF strips ○ sub-cut 12 – 7" squares Cut 1 – 8" x WOF strip ○ Sub-cut 24 – 7/8" x 8" strips
Background & Sashing 81203-10 	2 3/4 yds	Cut 6 – 4 1/2" x WOF strips ○ Sub-cut 48 – 4 1/2" squares Cut 4 – 5 1/2" x WOF strips ○ Sub-cut 24 – 5 1/2" squares Cut 2 – 7" x WOF strip ○ Sub-cut 12 – 7" squares Cut 22 – 1 1/2" x WOF strips ○ Sub-cut 80 – 1 1/2" squares ○ For sub-cutting of sashing strips, see instructions below.
Lengthwise Backing 80606-66 	5 1/2 yds	Cut length of fabric in half to get 2 – 98" x WOF pieces. Sew pieces together along the selvage edges for a backing piece measuring approximately 85" x 98".

Block Assembly:

1. Take 1 – 4 ½” flower petal square, 1 – 1 ½” background square and 1 – 1 ½” yellow square. Place the background square onto the top left corner of the large square RST. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner as shown below. Sew along drawn line. Cut off excess fabric ¼” above the seam line (towards the outside corner). Repeat this process with the small yellow square in the top right corner. Press seams open to complete Unit 1 as shown. Repeat with all flower petal squares to make 96 Unit 1’s.

2. Take 1 – 4 ½” background square and 1 – 2” corner triangle square. Follow the same process as in Step 1 above to make Unit 2 as shown. Repeat to make 24 Unit 2’s.

3. Take 1 – 7” background square and 1 – 7” green square. With RST, sew around the perimeter of the square ¼” from the edge. Cut on both diagonals. Press seams open to complete four HST Units. Trim each HST to 3 ½” square. Repeat with remaining 5 ½” squares to make 24 HST Units.



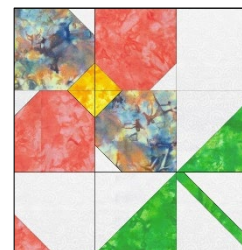
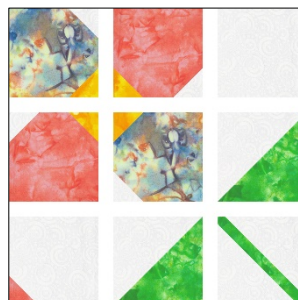

4. Take 1 – 5 ½” background square and 1 – 7/8” x 8” green strip. Cut the square in half on the diagonal, making two triangles. Sew the green strip between the two triangles to make a Stem Unit. Trim the unit to 4 ½” square, making sure the diagonal line of your ruler is centered along the green strip. Repeat to make 24 Stem Units.

5. Arrange four Unit 1’s (2 pairs of coordinating blocks), one Unit 2, one 4 ½” background square, two HST Units and one Stem Unit as shown.
6. Sew units together to complete each row. Then sew rows together to complete the Pinwheel Posie Block.



7. Repeat Steps 1 – 6 to complete 24 Pinwheel Posie Blocks.

8. From the 1 ½" x WOF sashing strips, cut 18 – 1 ½" x 12 ½" strips.
9. Arrange blocks in 6 rows of 4, rotating the blocks as shown. Sew blocks together in each row with a sashing strip between each block to complete rows.



10. Join the remaining sashing strips together end to end. Cut 5 – 1 ½" x 51 ½" strips, 2 – 1 ½" x 77 ½" strips, and 2 – 1 ½" x 53 ½" strips. Sew rows together with a 51 ½" sashing strip between each row. Then sew a 77 ½" strip to each side and a 53 ½" strip to the top and bottom.
11. Join the 7 – 4 ½" x WOF outer border strips together end to end. Cut 2 – 4 ½" x 79 ½" strips and 2 – 4 ½" x 61 ½" strips. Sew a 79 ½" strip to each side. Then sew the 61 ½" strips to the top and bottom.
12. Join the 8 – 2 ¼" x WOF binding strips using diagonal seams. Fold in half wrong sides together along the length of the strip and press.
13. Layer quilt top with batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind using your favorite method.
