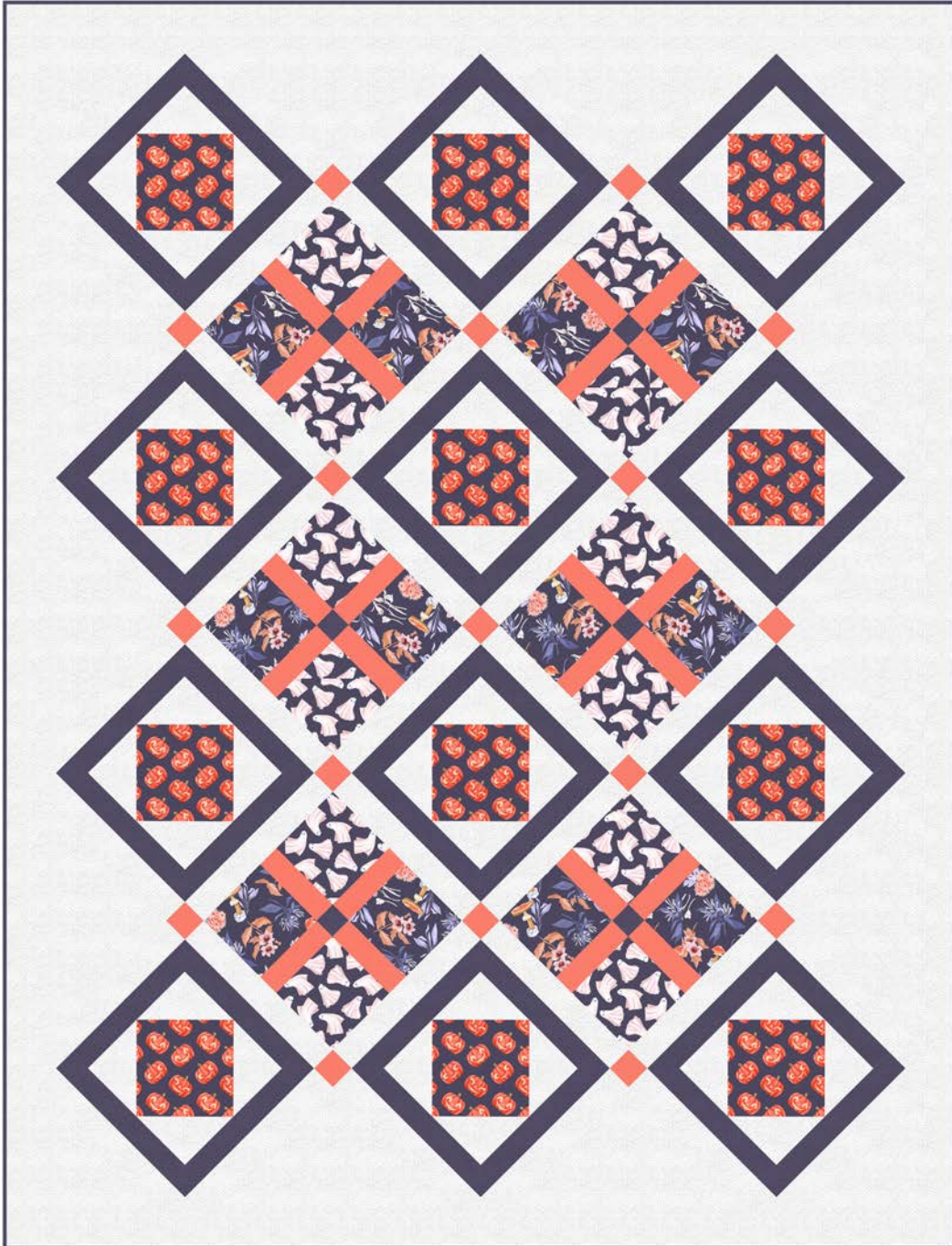








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QUIET PRECISION QUILT PATTERN

Note: Label cut pieces with fabric letter for easier assembly.

Materials and Cutting		
Fabric	Yardage	Cutting
 Crimp Stella-DRR2293 White	37/8 yards	<p>Cut:</p> <p>2 strips, 18 1/4" x WOF. Sub-cut 3 squares, 18 1/4" x 18 1/4". Cut each square twice diagonally from corner to corner, making 12 side triangles. Two side triangles will be extra.</p> <p><i>From the remaining strip, cut:</i></p> <p>2 squares, 9 3/8" x 9 3/8". Cut each square once diagonally from corner to corner to make 4 corner triangles.</p> <p>3 strips, 12 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut 48 J sashing strips, 2 1/4" x 12 1/2".</p> <p>6 strips, 5" x WOF. Sub-cut 48 D squares, 5" x 5".</p> <p>1 strip, 3 5/8" x WOF. Sub-cut 4 squares, 3 5/8" x 3 5/8". Cut each square twice diagonally, from corner to corner, to make 16 I triangles. Two triangles will not be used.</p> <p>8 strips, 2 1/2" x WOF, for the outer border.</p>
 Crimp Stella-DRR2293 Indigo	12/3 yards	<p>Cut:</p> <p>2 strips, 12 1/2" x width of fabric (WOF). Sub-cut 24 A rectangles, 2" x 12 1/2".</p> <p><i>From the remaining strip, cut:</i></p> <p>6 B rectangles, 2" x 9 1/2", and 6 C squares, 2" x 2".</p> <p>1 strip, 9 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut 18 B rectangles, 2" x 9 1/2".</p> <p>8 strips, 2 1/2" x WOF for binding.</p>
 Pumpkins Stella-DDR2524 Astral	1 yard	<p>Cut:</p> <p>3 strips, 9 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut 12 E squares, 9 1/2" x 9 1/2".</p>
 Exotic Garden Stella-DRR2526 Astral	1/2 yard	<p>Cut:</p> <p>2 strips, 5 3/4" x WOF. Sub-cut 12 F squares, 5 3/4" x 5 3/4".</p>
 Ghosts Stella-DRR2525 Astral	1/2 yard	<p>Cut:</p> <p>2 strips, 5 3/4" x WOF. Sub-cut 12 G squares, 5 3/4" x 5 3/4".</p>
 Crimp Stella-DRR2293 Orange	1/2 yard	<p>Cut:</p> <p>2 strips, 5 3/4" x WOF. Sub-cut 24 H rectangles, 2" x 5 3/4".</p> <p>1 strip, 2 1/4" x WOF. Sub-cut 17 K cornerstones, 2 1/4" x 2 1/4".</p>
 Haunted Garden Stella-DRR2523 Multi	5 1/8 yards	Remove selvages and cut yardage into two equal lengths for backing.

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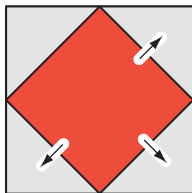
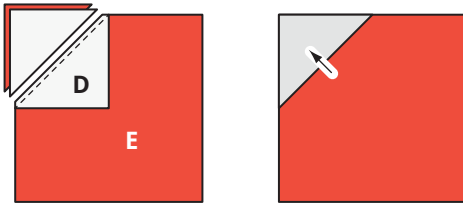
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QUIET PRECISION QUILT PATTERN

Note: All seam allowances are $\frac{1}{4}$ " unless otherwise specified. Press seam allowances open unless otherwise indicated.

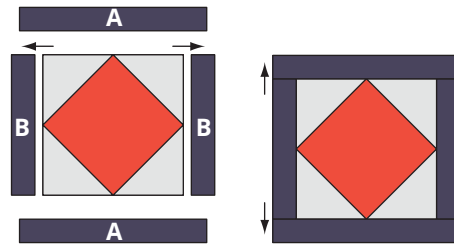
Make Block One

1 Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each **D** square. Noting the orientation of the marked line, place a marked square right sides together on one corner of an **E** square. Sew along the marked line. Trim the excess corner fabric, leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Open the triangle and press the seam allowances toward the corner. Repeat to add **D** triangles to each remaining corner of the **E** square. The unit should measure $9\frac{1}{2}" \times 9\frac{1}{2}"$. Make a total of 12 **D/E** units.

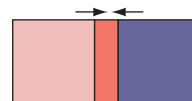
2 Sew a **B** rectangle to opposite sides of each **D/E** unit. Press the seam allowances toward the **B** rectangles. Sew one **A** rectangle to the top, and another to the bottom of the unit to complete Block One. Press the seam allowances toward the **A** rectangles. The block should measure $12\frac{1}{2}" \times 12\frac{1}{2}"$. Make a total of 12 of Block One.

Make Block Two

1 Arrange one **F** square, one **G** square, and one **H** rectangle in a single row, as shown. Sew the squares to the rectangle along adjacent edges. Press the seam allowances toward the rectangle. Make a total of 12 **F/H/G** units.



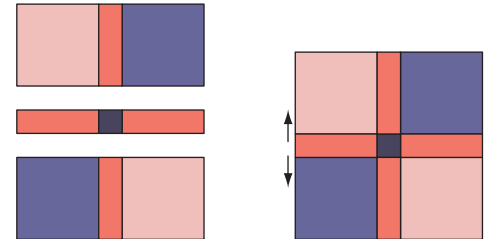
F/H/G unit

2 Sew two **H** rectangles to opposite sides of a **C** square. Press the seam allowances toward the rectangles. Make 6 **H/C/H** units.

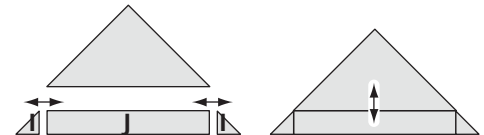
3 Referring to the quilt photo for fabric placement, sew one **F/H/G** unit to the upper edge, and another **F/H/G** unit to the lower edge of a single **H/C/H** unit. Press the seam allowances toward the **F/H/G** units. The block should measure $12\frac{1}{2}" \times 12\frac{1}{2}"$. Make a total of 6 of Block Two.

Make the Corner Blocks

1 Sew an **I** triangle to each short end of a **J** rectangle. Press the seam allowances toward the **J** rectangle. Center and sew the long edge of a corner triangle to the upper edge of the **I/J/I** unit, as shown. Press. Make a total of four Corner Blocks.

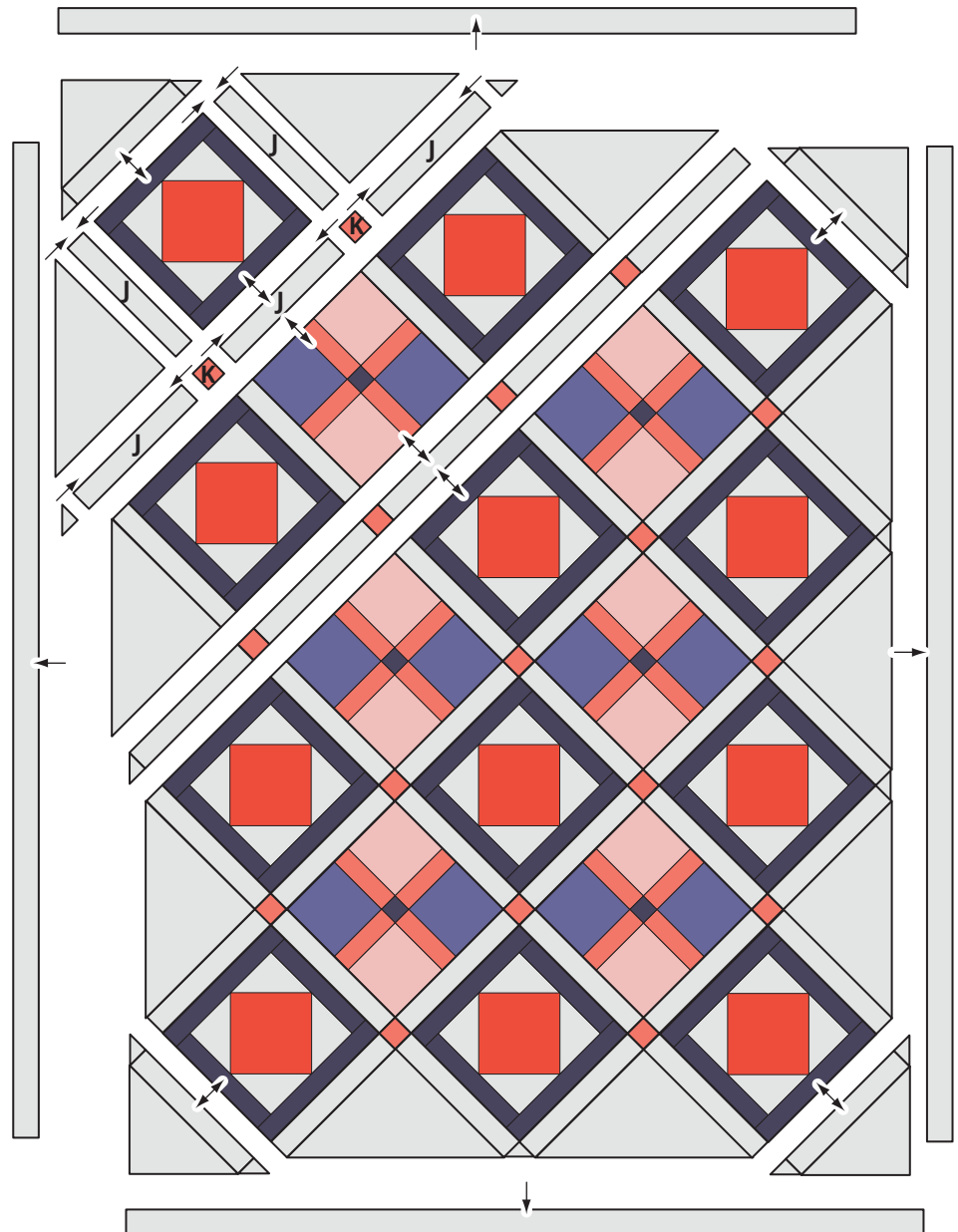
QUIET PRECISION QUILT PATTERN

Assemble the Quilt

- 1 Referring to the Quilt Assembly Diagram, arrange Blocks One and Two, **J** rectangles and side triangles in six diagonal rows. Sew the blocks, rectangles, and triangles together along adjacent edges. Press the seam allowances toward the **J** rectangles.
- 2 Referring to the Quilt Assembly Diagram, arrange the remaining **I** triangles, **J** rectangles and **K** squares into five diagonal sashing rows. Sew the triangles, rectangles, and squares together along adjacent edges. Press the seam allowances toward the **J** rectangles.
- 3 Matching seam lines, sew the block rows and sashing rows together along adjacent edges. Sew the rows together in order along adjacent edges. Press.
- 4 Sew one Corner Block to each corner of the quilt top. Press.
- 5 Sew the outer border strips together end to end. Press. Cut two $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 78\frac{1}{2}''$ side borders and two $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 63''$ top/bottom borders. Sew one side border to each long edge of the quilt top. Press the seam allowances toward the borders. Sew one top/bottom border to the top, and the other to the bottom edge of the quilt top. Press the seam allowances toward the borders.

Finishing

- 1 Using a $\frac{1}{2}''$ seam allowance, join the two large backing rectangles along one short edge. Press. Join the rectangles to the remaining backing yardage along one long edge to complete the quilt backing. Press.
- 2 Layer the quilt backing, batting, and quilt top. Quilt as desired. Stitch a scant $\frac{1}{4}''$ from the edge around the perimeter of the quilt. Trim the excess backing and batting. Use your favorite method to bind the quilt.
