## Fabric Requirements:

- (3) Focal fabrics— $\frac{5}{8}$  yard each
- (1) Focal fabric— $\frac{3}{4}$  yard
- 2 yards background

## Cutting Instructions:

From the (3)  $\frac{5}{8}$  yards cut each into:

- (2)  $8\frac{3}{4}$  inch strips then sub cut each strip into
- (2)  $8\frac{3}{4} \times 21$  inch units for a total of 12 units.

From the (1)  $\frac{3}{4}$  yard cut into:

- (2)  $8\frac{3}{4}$  inch strips then sub cut each strip into
- (2)  $8\frac{3}{4} \times 21$  inch units for a total of 4 units.
- (2)  $2\frac{1}{2}$  inch strips sub cut each into
- $2\frac{1}{2}$  inch squares for a total of (24) squares.

From the  $1\frac{3}{4}$  background fabric cut into

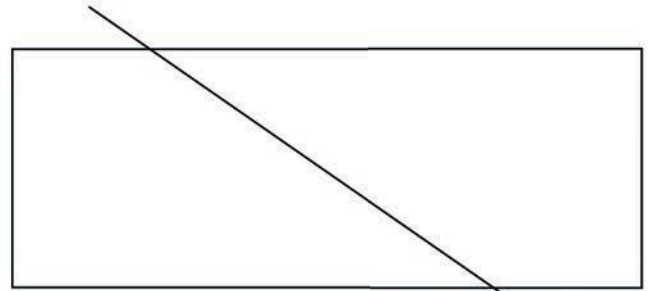
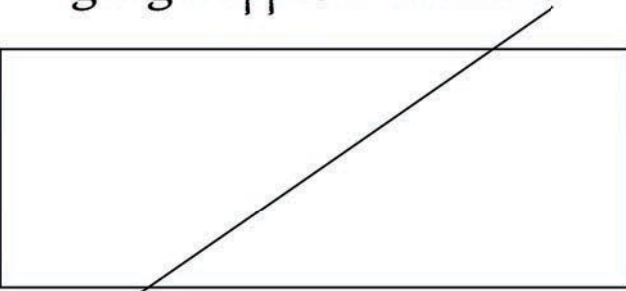
- (8)  $8\frac{3}{4}$  inch strips then sub cut each strip into
- (2)  $8\frac{3}{4} \times 21$  inch units for a total of 16 units.
- (2)  $2\frac{1}{2}$  inch strips sub cut each into
- $2\frac{1}{2}$  inch squares for a total of (24) squares.

## Block Constructions:

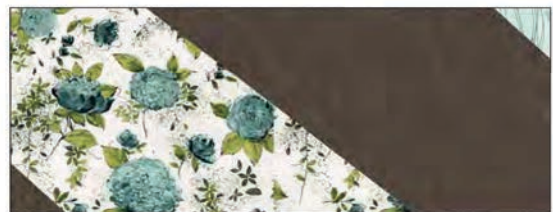
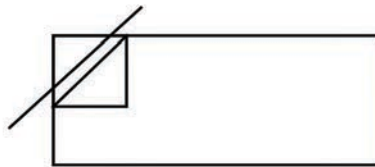
1. Take (4)  $8\frac{3}{4}$  inch units from one focal fabric and (4)  $8\frac{3}{4}$  inch units from the background fabric.
2. Make (2) stacks of (4) units in each Right Sides Up - 2 background units and 2 focal units in each stack.
3. Take one of the stacks of four. Measure from the top left corner and mark at  $15\frac{1}{2}$  inches. Measure from the lower left corner and mark at  $5\frac{1}{2}$  inches.



4. Cut this stack (only this stack) diagonally from mark to mark as shown below.
5. Take the other stack of four and measure from the top left corner and mark at  $5\frac{1}{2}$  inches. Measure from the lower left corner and mark at  $15\frac{1}{2}$  inches.
6. Cut this stack diagonally from mark to mark as shown below. **They are going in opposite directions.**



7. Swap fabrics and sew cut units back together to create a diagonal rectangle. Note: when aligning your cut units, make sure that your “dog ears” are even on both sides before pinning.
8. Square up all 8 sewn units to  $8\frac{1}{2} \times 19\frac{1}{2}$  units.—square up evenly from both sides as opposed to all off one side..
9. Repeat this with the remaining 3 focus fabrics and the background units.
10. Take one  $2\frac{1}{2}$  inch squares from the focus fabric and one  $2\frac{1}{2}$  inch square from the background fabric and snowball in the corners as indicated on each sewn block.





## Quilt Assembly:

1. Arrange blocks as shown in a 4 blocks across—8 blocks down formation.
2. Sew blocks together.
3. Quilt and bind as desired!
