Template material

Basic sewing supplies

Preparation and Cutting

Cut out the template shapes, trace them onto cardstock or another sturdy template material, and label. Use the templates to cut the pieces listed from the fabrics indicated. Each block is made from four fabrics: the background (Fabric A), the body (Fabric T), and an inner and outer wing fabric. Sort the pieces into a pile for each butterfly block.

From the background Fabric A, cut:

Eleven 3-1/2" x 42" strips for sashing and borders; subcut three strips into six 3-1/2" x 18-1/2" strips

Nine background #1 pieces

Nine backgound #1 reversed pieces

One inner wing #1

From each of Fabrics C, E, G, I, K, M, O, Q, and S, cut:

One outer wing #1

One outer wing #1 reversed

One outer wing #2

One outer wing #2 reversed

One outer wing #3

One outer wing #3 reversed

One outer wing #4

One outer wing #4 reversed

One outer wing #5

One outer wing #5 reversed

One outer wing #6

One outer wing #6 reversed

From Fabric T, cut: Nine body #1 pieces

From Fabric U, cut:

Seven 2-1/2" x 42" strips for binding

Make the Blocks

1. Working with one butterly block pile, sew an inner wing #1 piece to a background #1 piece. Sew an outer wing #1 piece to a background #2 piece. Join the wing units together to create the left upper wing. In the same way, use the reverse units to make a right upper wing.





2. To make the left center wing, join outer wing piece #2 to background piece #3. Join background piece #4 to outer wing piece #3. Join these units together, and add inner wing #3 to the right edge. In the same way, use the reverse units to make a right center wing.





3. Sew the left upper wing to the left center wing, and join the right upper wing to the right center wing. Sew body piece #1 to background piece #5. Sew the wing sections to opposite sides of the body/background unit.





4. To make the lower wing, sew outer wing #4 and background #7 to the left side of background piece #6. Sew outer wing piece #4 reverse and background piece #7 reverse to the right side.



5. To make the wing tail, Join outer wing piece #5 and #5 reverse to opposite sides of background piece #8. Sew outer wing piece #6 and #6 reverse to background piece #9. Sew the #5/#8 unit to the top edge. Add background piece #10 and #10 reverse to the outer edges.



6. Sew the wing tail section to the lower wing section. Sew to the wing/body section to complete the block. Square up to 18-1/2" square.



7. Repeat with each butterfly block pile to make a total of nine blocks.

Assemble the Quilt


- 1. Sew the 3-1/2" x 42" Fabric A strips short ends together into a long strip. Cut four 60-1/2" lengths and two 66-1/2" lengths.
- 2. Lay out three blocks alternating with two 3-1/2" x 18-1/2" Fabric A sashing strips as shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Sew three rows. Alternate these rows with four 3-1/2" x 60-1/2" sashing strips. Sew the rows and sashing strips together.
- 3. Sew the remaining 3-1/2" x 66-1/2" Fabric A strips to the sides of the quilt

Finish the Quilt

1. Layer the quilt back right side down, batting, and quilt top right side up. Baste layers together and quilt as desired. Trim backing and batting to edge of quilt top.
2. Use the seven 2-1/2" x 42" Fabric U strips to bind the quilt.





Quilt Assembly Diagram







