Fabric A	ICE-204	¼ yd.
Fabric B	ICE-205	⅓ yd.
Fabric C	ICE-208	⅓ yd.
Fabric D	PE-404	⅓ yd.
Fabric E	ICE-201	⅓ yd.
Fabric F	ICE-207	⅓ yd.
Fabric G	EN-OYD-6000	⅓ yd.
Fabric H	ICE-202	⅓ yd.
Fabric I	ICE-209	⅓ yd.
Fabric J	DSE-701	⅓ yd.
Fabric K	DSE-700	F8
Fabric L	DSE-702	F8

## CUTTING DIRECTIONS

¼" seam allowances are included.  
WOF means width of fabric.

### Fabric A:

- Cut four (4) 2<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub> X 2<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub> squares
- Cut Template 2

### Fabric B:

- Cut Twelve (12) 2<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub> X 2<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub> squares
- Cut Template 2

### Fabric C:

- Cut Ten (10) 2<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub> X 2<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub> squares

### Fabric D:

- Cut Six (6) 2<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub> X 2<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub> squares

### Fabric E:

- Cut Six (6) 2<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub> X 2<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub> squares

### Fabric F:

- Cut Eight (8) 2<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub> X 2<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub> squares

### Fabric G:

- Cut Four (4) 2<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub> X 2<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub> squares

### Fabric H:

- Cut Two (2) 2<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub> X 2<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub> squares

### Fabric I:

- Cut Two (2) 2<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub> X 2<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub> squares

### Fabric J:

- Cut Fifty Four (54) 2<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub> X 2<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub> squares.
- Cut Twelve (12) 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> x 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> squares
- Cut Four (4) 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> x 4<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> rectangles
- Cut Two (2) 30" x 1" strips

### Fabric K:

- Cut Template 3
- Cut Template 1

### Fabric L:

- Cut Template 3
- Cut Template 1

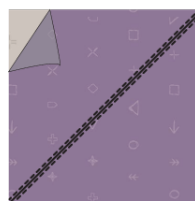
## CONSTRUCTION

Sew all rights sides together with ¼" seam allowance.

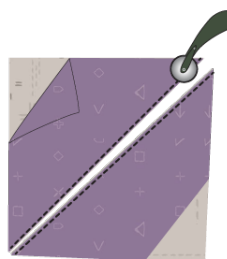
For this bag we will be using the HST method. (See diagram below)



Place the one (1) 2<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub> x 2<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub> square from fabric J and one (1) 2<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub> x 2<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub> square from fabric B right side together and mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of the square



Sew a ¼" on both sides of the marked diagonal line



Using a rotary blade cut the square into two triangles

HST Combinations:

We will have nine (9) different HST combination ( See Diagram below.

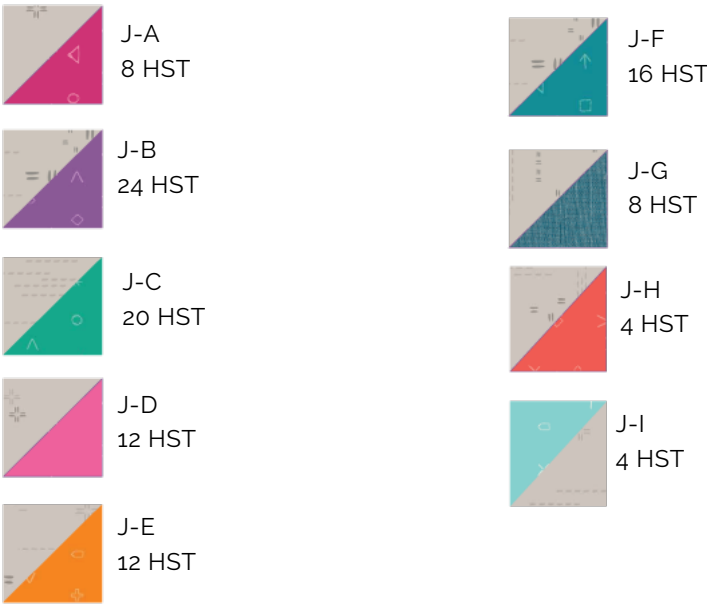

Block 2 is the same as block 1 but mirrored . Follow Diagram bellow for HST arrangements. (Make two of these blocks2)

## Center Piece

Take Four (4) HST from fabric J-H, sew them as show on diagram below  
 Take Four (4) HST from fabric J-F sew them as show on diagram below  
 Take Four (4) HST from fabric J-A sew them as show on diagram below  
 Take Four (4) HST from fabric J-I sew them as show on diagram below  
 Take Four (4) HST from fabric J-B sew them as show on diagram below  
 Take Four (4) HST from fabric J-C sew them as show on diagram below

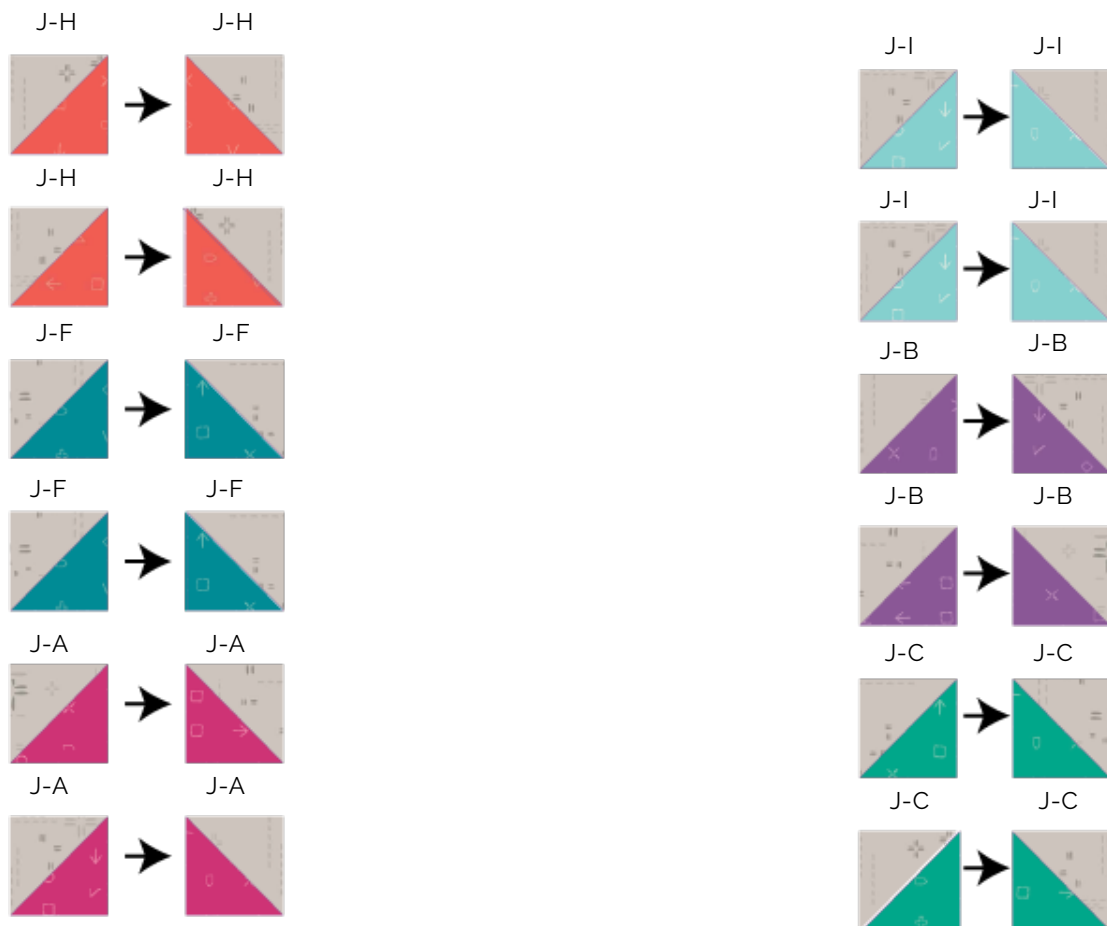

Take the HST sewn previous step and arrange them in the order shown on diagram 6

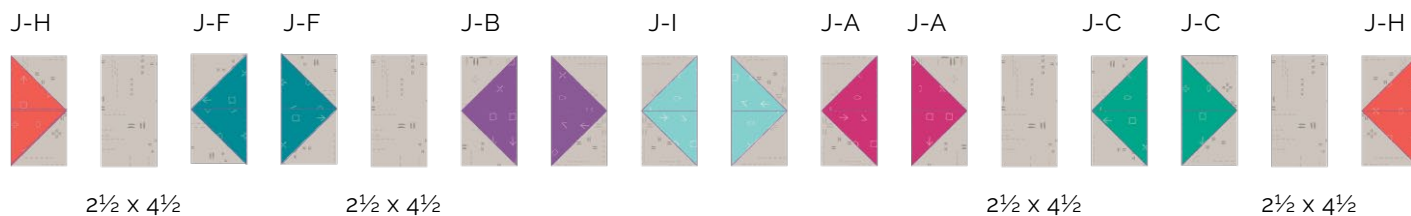
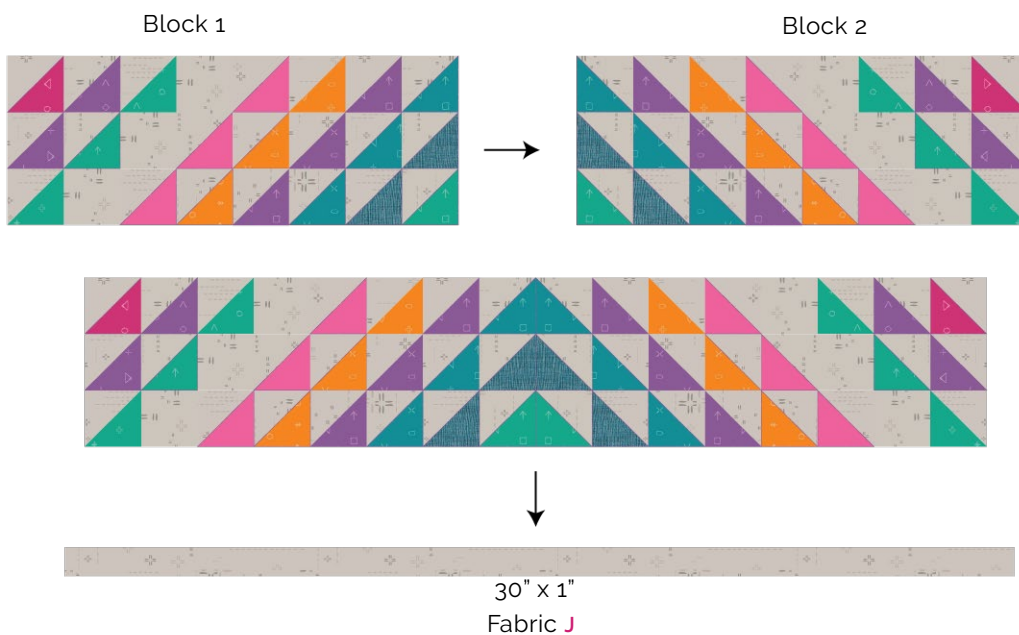


DIAGRAM 6

Sew Block 1 and Block 2

Attach the 30" x 1" strip from fabric J to the bottom



- Sew Block 2 and Block 1
- Attach the 30" x 1" strip from fabric J to the top of sewn block 2-block 1

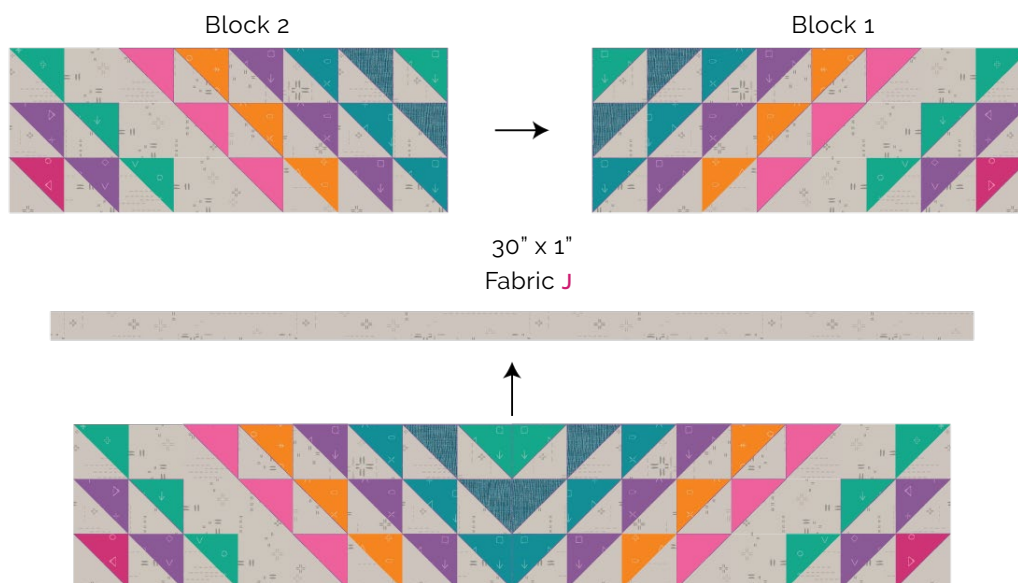

Add the center piece in between the two blocks previously sewn. See Diagram below.

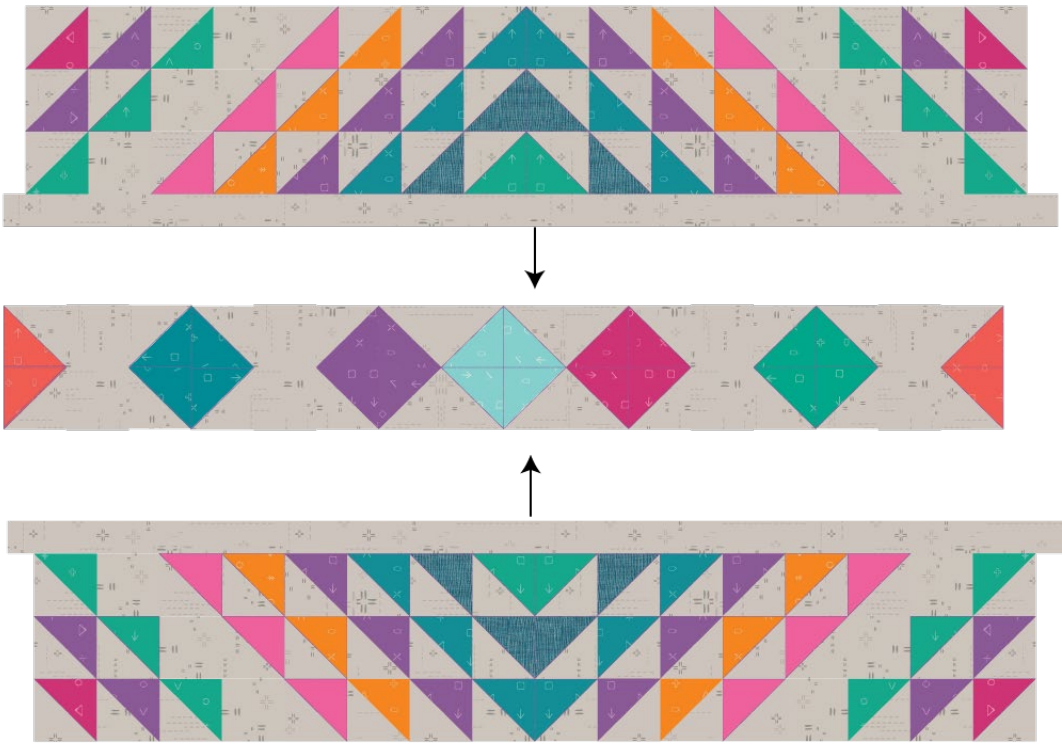

Take Template 1 from fabric K, Template 2 from fabric B and Template 3 from fabric L and sew it as show on diagram below

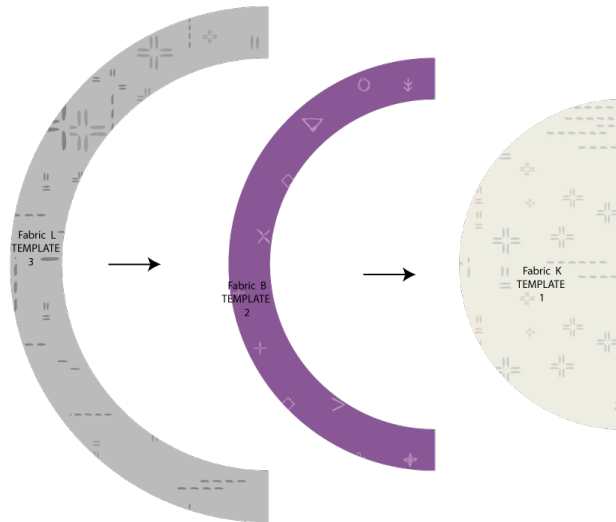

Take Template 1 from fabric L, Template 2 from fabric A and Template 3 from fabric K and sew it as show on diagram below

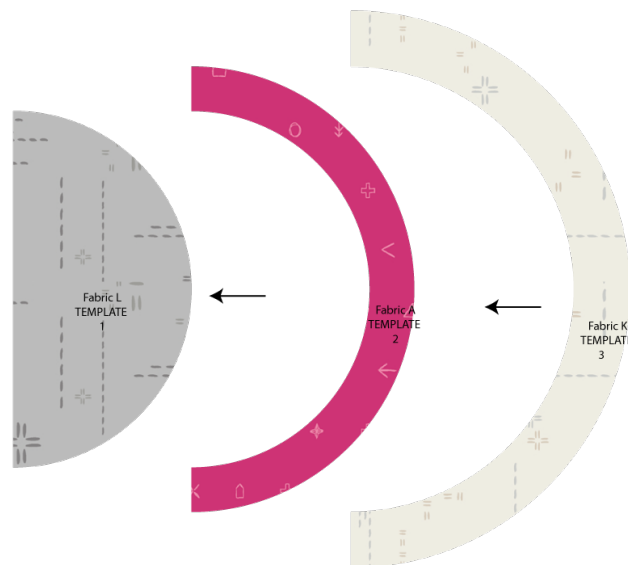

Sew both half circles and that will be the bottom of the purse.

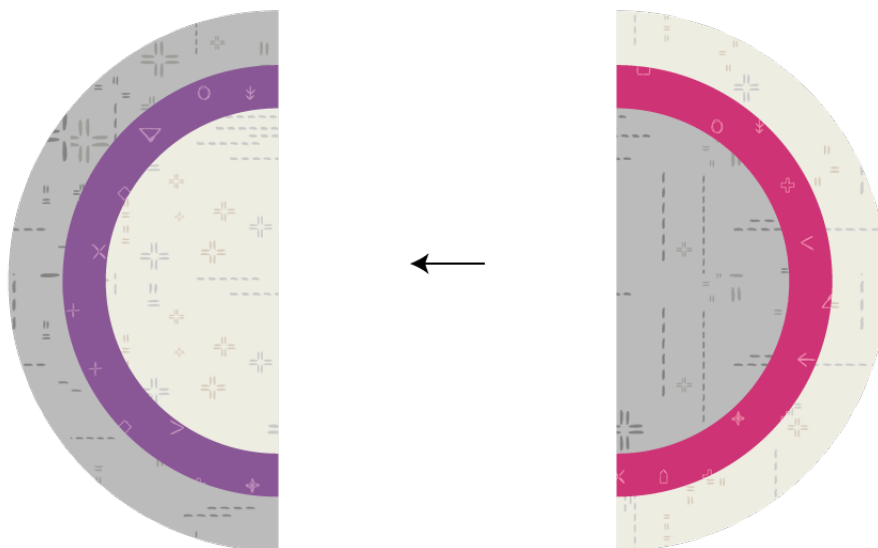
