



Finished block size: 9" x 9"


Tip 1: The feature fabrics used here are directional, so be mindful when cutting the pieces for the blocks, if you care.

Tip 2: It is recommended that you practice on butcher paper first, to work out the fit and appropriate layouts.



 <p>S4727-Light Gray Fabric A</p>	3 1/4y	<p>a. patch blocks and sashing pieces (6) 1 1/2" x wof. Sub-cut (4) 1 1/2" x 29 1/2" strips from (4) wof strips, and (4) 1 1/2" x 19 1/2" strips from remaining (2) wof strips. (6) 9 1/2" x wof. Sub-cut (4) 9 1/2" x 10 1/2", (4) 9 1/2" x 20 1/2" and (50) 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" rectangles.</p> <p>b. pieced blocks (4) "A" and (8) "C" pieces using provided templates.</p> <p>c. outer border (8) 2 1/2" x wof. Piece strips and sub-cut (2) 2 1/2" x 63 1/2" and (2) 2 1/2" x 79 1/2" strips.</p>
 <p>S4728-Navy Fabric B</p>	1 1/8y	<p>a. pieced blocks (8) "A" and (5) "B" pieces using provided templates.</p> <p>b. binding, cut (8) 2 1/2" strips wof.</p>
 <p>S4729-Royal Fabric C</p>	1/2y	<p>a. pieced blocks (6) "B" pieces using provided template.</p>
 <p>S4730-Seafoam Fabric D</p>	5/8y	<p>a. pieced blocks (8) "B" pieces using provided template.</p>
 <p>S4731-Aqua Fabric E</p>	5/8y	<p>a. pieced blocks (5) "A", (4) "B" and (1) "C" pieces using provided templates.</p>
 <p>S4732-White Fabric F</p>	5/8y	<p>a. pieced blocks (4) "B" and (2) "C" pieces using provided templates.</p>


Constructing pieced blocks















1. Matching the centers, ease and pin (1) **Fabric 1** "A" piece to the inner curve of (1) **Fabric 2** "B" piece together. Sew slowly and curve piece together pinned pieces.



2. Matching the centers, ease and pin the curved edge of previously sewn unit to the curved edge of (1) **Fabric 3** "C" piece. Sew slowly and curve piece together pinned pieces to complete (1) block.



3. Make a total number of blocks for the following **Fabric 1/Fabric 2/Fabric 3** combinations. Use this grid if you want the prints to be directional (one way).

Quilt center assembly


1. Pieced rows. Refer to quilt image for block placements and orientations, arrange and sew together pieced blocks and sashing pieces to make a pieced row. Make a total of (8) pieced rows.

Rows 1 & 8: Sew together (2) pieced blocks, (1) $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 9\frac{1}{2}''$ **Fabric A** sashing rectangle, (2) $9\frac{1}{2}'' \times 20\frac{1}{2}''$ **Fabric A** patch blocks.

Rows 2 & 7: Sew together (4) pieced blocks, (3) $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 9\frac{1}{2}''$ **Fabric A** sashing rectangles, (2) $9\frac{1}{2}'' \times 10\frac{1}{2}''$ **Fabric A** patch blocks.

Rows 3 & 4 & 5 & 6: Sew together (6) pieced blocks, (5) $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 9\frac{1}{2}''$ **Fabric A** sashing rectangles.

Row 1 is shown below.



2. Pieced sashing rows. Sew together $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 1\frac{1}{2}''$ **Fabric L** squares and **Fabric A** sashing pieces to make a pieced sashing row.

Pieced sashing rows 1 & 7. Sew together (2) $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 29\frac{1}{2}''$ **Fabric A** rectangles and (1) $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 1\frac{1}{2}''$ **Fabric L** square.




Pieced sashing rows 2 & 6. Sew together (2) $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 19\frac{1}{2}''$ **Fabric A** rectangles, (2) $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 9\frac{1}{2}''$ **Fabric A** rectangles and (3) $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 1\frac{1}{2}''$ **Fabric L** squares.




Pieced sashing rows 3 & 4 & 5. Sew together (6) $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 9\frac{1}{2}''$ **Fabric A** rectangles and (5) $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 1\frac{1}{2}''$ **Fabric L** squares.




3. Sew together pieced rows and pieced sashing rows to complete quilt center.






