Fabric Requirements	Yardage	Cutting Instructions (WOF = width of fabric)
80782-54 Fabric A 	3/8 yd	Cut 2 – 4 ½" x WOF strips ➤ Sub-cut 12 – 4 ½" squares
80782-28 Fabric B 	1/4 yd	Cut 2 – 2 ½" x WOF strips ➤ Sub-cut 12 – 2 ½" x 4 ½ strips
80780-28 Fabric C 	1/4 yd	Cut 2 – 2 ½" x WOF strips ➤ Sub-cut 12 – 2 ½" x 6 ½ strips
80784-23 Fabric D 	1/4 yd	Cut 2 – 2 ½" x WOF strips ➤ Sub-cut 12 – 2 ½" x 6 ½ strips
80787-28 Fabric E 	1/4 yd	Cut 3 – 2 ½" x WOF strips ➤ Sub-cut 12 – 2 ½" x 8 ½ strips
80784-59 Fabric F 	1/4 yd	Cut 3 – 2 ½" x WOF strips ➤ Sub-cut 12 – 2 ½" x 8 ½ strips
80787-56 Fabric G 	1/4 yd	Cut 3 – 2 ½" x WOF strips ➤ Sub-cut 12 – 2 ½" x 10 ½ strips
80781-99 Fabric H 	1 1/2 yds	Cut 2 – 11" x WOF strips ➤ Sub-cut 6 – 11" squares Cut 6 – 4 ½" x WOF strips (Middle Border)
81204-10 Fabric J 	2/3 yd	Cut 2 – 11" x WOF strips ➤ Sub-cut 6 – 11" squares
80786-84 Fabric K 	1/2 yd	Cut 6 – 2 ½" x WOF strips ➤ Sub-cut 24 – 2 ½" x 10 ½" strips
80784-62 Fabric L 	1/2 yd	Cut 6 – 2 ½" x WOF strips (Inner Border)
80785-99 Fabric M 	1 1/8 yds	Cut 7 – 2 ½" x WOF strips (Outer Border) ➤ Sub-cut 6 – 2 ½" squares from one strip Cut 8 – 2 ½" x WOF strips (Binding)
80781-99 Backing 	5 1/2 yds	Cut the fabric in half along the length to get 2 – 2 ¾ yd pieces. Sew pieces together along the selvage edges to get a lengthwise backing measuring approximately 84" x 99".

All seams are sewn using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

The quilt center is made up of 6 – 22" blocks as shown, each with two half log cabin units, two HST units, plus sashing and center square in between the blocks, making construction of the quilt center fast & easy!



Half Log Cabin Unit Assembly:

1. Starting with a Fabric A square, add strips to two sides of the square in the order of Fabric B, C, D, E, F & G, alternating between the two sides as shown.
2. Repeat to make a total of 12 Half Log Cabin Units.



HST Unit Assembly:

1. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the 6 – 11" Fabric K squares.
2. Pair a Fabric H 11" square with a Fabric K 11" square.
3. With right sides together, sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on each side of the drawn line.
4. Cut on the drawn line. Open and press to the dark side. Trim each unit to 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".
5. Repeat with remaining 11" squares to make a total of 12 HST Units.

Block Assembly:

1. Lay out two Half Log Cabin Units, two HST Units, 4 sashing strips and one center square as shown.



2. Sew units together into rows. Then sew rows together to complete block.
3. Repeat to make a total of 6 blocks.

Quilt Top Assembly:

1. Sew blocks together into three rows of two blocks each. Then sew rows together to complete quilt center.
2. Join the Fabric L Inner Border strips end-to-end. From that long strip, cut 2 – 66 ½" side border strips and 2 – 48 ½" top & bottom border strips.
3. Sew a side border strip to each side of the quilt top. Then add the top & bottom border strips.
4. Join the Fabric H Middle Border strips end-to-end. From that long strip, cut 2 – 70 ½" side border strips and 2 – 56 ½" top & bottom border strips.
5. Sew a side border strip to each side of the quilt top. Then add the top & bottom border strips.
6. Join the Fabric M Outer Border strips end-to-end. From that long strip, cut 2 – 78 ½" side border strips and 2 – 60 ½" top & bottom border strips.
7. Sew a side border strip to each side of the quilt top. Then add the top & bottom border strips.

Finishing the Quilt:

1. Layer quilt top with batting and prepared backing. Quilt as desired.
2. Join the Fabric M Binding strips using diagonal seams. Fold in half wrong sides together along the length of the strip and press.
3. Bind quilt using your favorite method.
