### FINISHED QUILT SIZE 49 ½" x 55 ½"

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

**WOF** = Width of Fabric

**RST** = Right Sides Together

**SNF** = Stitch and Flip

**HST** = Half-Square Triangle

# **FABRIC REQUIREMENTS**

- (1) Live, Love, Glamp Home Dec Panel (HD13507)
- (1) Live, Love, Glamp 5" Stacker (5-13500-42)

11/2 yards Mushrooms (C13505-DENIM) binding

% yard Main (C13500-MIST)

¾ yard Confetti Cottons (C120-LECREME)

# **OTHER SUPPLIES**

**Basic Sewing Supplies** 1¾ yards Wide Backing 57" x 63" Batting

# **CUTTING REQUIREMENTS**

- Please read instructions before cutting fabrics.
- Cutting Instructions are based on a 42" WOF.
- Refer to the cover art for the placement of fabrics.
- Use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter to cut fabrics.
- Label pieces as you cut.

# **Panel**

Before trimming, ensure there will be at least a ¼" between the outermost panel illustrations and the trimmed edges of the panel then carefully trim the panel to measure 17" x 23".

Fussy-cut (2) decorative rectangles 5" × 8 ½" (refer to cover art of flowers and camping vehicles in pieced border).

### 5" Stacker

Select (14) pairs of matching prints.



# **Mushrooms Denim**

Cut (13) strips 2½" × WOF; subcut:

(2)  $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 41" strips Α

(2)  $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 23" strips\* В

(2)  $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 21" strips\* C

(6) 2 1/2" WOF strips for binding

(1) 2 1/2" WOF strip\*

\* This strip and the remainder from strips B and C will be used to piece the 2nd inner border. D



### **Main Mist**

Cut (5) strips 5" x WOF.

### **Confetti Cottons Le Creme**

Cut (4) strips 5" x WOF; subcut:

(28) 5" squares F

(2)  $3" \times 8 \%"$  rectangles G

# **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS**

- Follow diagram pressing arrows for successful piecing.
- Orient pieces according to their pertinent diagrams. Doing so is essential to following relational instructions such as top, bottom, left, right and so on.


### **1ST INNER BORDER**

- 1. Sew a **B** strip to each side of the panel.
- 2. Sew a C strip to the top and bottom of the panel  $(21" \times 27")$ .




### **ARROW BLOCKS**


- 3. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of (2) F squares (a).
- 4. Align (1) square from a pair of matching Stacker squares, with an F square RST (b).
- 5. Sew a scant ¼" on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line (c).
- 6. Open and lightly fingerpress to yield (2) HSTs (d). Repeat with the second print and F square to make a set of (4) matching HSTs.
- 7. Repeat Steps 1–4 using all matching Stacker pairs and F squares for a total of 14 sets of (4) matching HSTs.



- 8. Arrange a set of (4) HSTs in (2) rows of (2). Match print to print in the top row; background to background in the bottom row.
- 9. Following the pressing arrows, press each HST as shown and square up to 4 1/2" as needed.



10. Sew the HSTs together in rows. Sew the rows together to complete an Arrow Block (8 ½" square).




11. Repeat Steps 6–8 to make a total of (14) Arrow Blocks.

### PIECED BORDER

Refer to the Quilt Layout Diagram on page 3 for an overview.

# Right Side Border


- 12. Using (3) Arrow Blocks and a G rectangle, arrange the arrows in a row, arrow points all facing the same direction.
- 13. Sew the blocks together end-to-end in a row adding the G rectangle to the end with an arrow point to complete the Right Side Border (27" × 8 ½").

### Left Side Border

14. Repeat Steps 1 & 2, this time adding the G rectangle before the last block on the far right as shown to complete the Left Side Border (27"  $\times$  8  $\frac{1}{2}$ ").



15. Sew the Right and Left Side Borders to each side of the quilt, making sure to orient the arrows correctly (37" × 27").

# Top Border

16. Sew (4) Arrow Blocks and (1) fussy-cut camper rectangle together in a row, making sure all arrows point right and the rectangle is positioned in the center as shown to complete the Top Border (37" × 8 ½").

17. Sew the Top Border to the quilt.

### **Bottom Border**

18. Repeat Step 5, using the fussy-cut flower rectangle, positioning it before the last Arrow Block on the far right, and making sure all arrows point left to complete the Bottom Border (37" × 8 ½").

19. Sew the Bottom Border to the quilt  $(37" \times 43")$ .

# **2ND INNER BORDER**

- 20. Sew (2) D strips and a remaining scrap strip together endto-end.
- 21. Cut (2) strips 43" long and sew one to each side of the quilt.
- 22. Sew an A strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top. The quilt top now measures 41" × 47".

#### OUTER BORDER

- 23. Sew (3) E strips together end-to-end.
- 24. Cut (2) strips 47" long and sew one to each side of the
- 25. Sew (2) E strips and the remaining strip from Step 2 endto-end.
- 26. Cut (2) strips 50" long, and sew one to the top and bottom of the guilt to complete the guilt top. Quilt should measure 50" x 56".

# **FINISHING THE QUILT**

Finish your quilt by layering the quilt top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind with the remaining (6) 2 ½" x WOF Mushrooms Denim **D** strips.
