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Fabric

8-1/2" blocks (9" raw edge to raw edge) + 4-1/2" sashin

7901-B Blue 2-1/4 yds	7905-EG Background..... 4-5/8 yds
7902-S Gold V's 3-1/4 yds	7909-B Middle Border 5/8 yd
7909-G Lt Green 7/8 yd	7907-S Outer Border / Binding 2-1/8 yds
7902-G Dk Green 7/8 yd	your choice..... Backing 8-1/4 yds

Cutting

7901-B Blue

- Cut (2) 9-3/4" strips into:
 - (6) 9-3/4" squares
 - (3) 6-7/8" squares
- Cut (5) 9" strips into:
 - (20) 9" squares
- Cut (1) 6-7/8" strip into:
 - (5) 6-7/8" squares

7902-S Gold V's

- Cut (22) 4-3/4" strips into:
 - (320) 4-3/4" x 2-5/8"

7909-G Lt Green

- Cut (2) 9-3/4" strips into:
 - (6) 9-3/4" squares
 - (3) 6-7/8" squares
- Cut (1) 6-7/8" strip into:
 - (5) 6-7/8" squares

7902-G Dk Green

- Cut (1) 7-1/4" strip into:
 - (5) 7-1/4" squares
- Cut (4) 4-3/4" strips into:
 - (31) 4-3/4" squares

7905-EG Background

- Cut (11) 4-3/4" strips into:
 - (160) 4-3/4" x 2-5/8"
- Cut (9) 3" strips for the Inner Border
- Cut (22) 2-5/8" strips into:
 - (320) 2-5/8" squares
- Cut (5) 2-1/2" strips into:
 - (80) 2-1/2" squares

7909-B Middle Border

- Cut (9) 2" strips

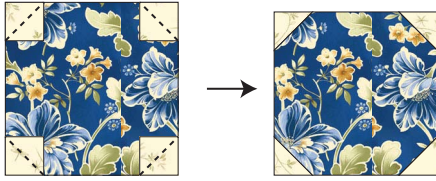
7907-S Outer Border / Binding

- Cut (10) 4-1/2" strips for Outer Border
- Cut (10) 2-1/2" strips for Binding

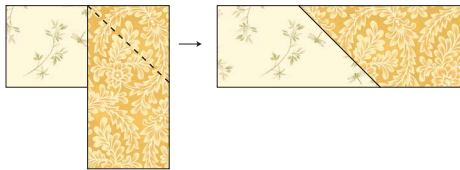
This pattern is planned with precise 1/4" seams throughout. To test your 1/4" seam to see if it's 'right on', cut two pieces of fabric EXACTLY 2-1/2" x 5". Stitch them together along the 5" length. Measure across the two - at the mid-point. They should be exactly 4-1/2" wide. If not, adjust your seam allowance, and repeat this procedure until correct.

Construction

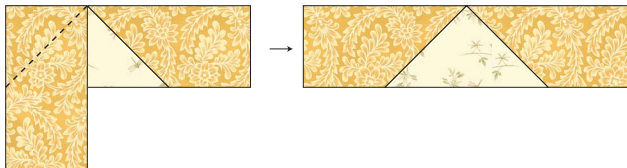
1. Diagonally stitch a 2-1/2" square of 7905-EG Background across each of the four corners of 9" squares of Blue 7901-B. Trim the excess from the corners and press toward the Blue. Make 20.



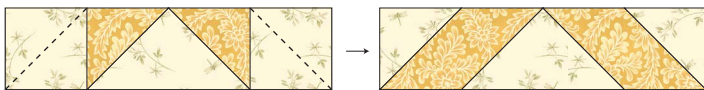
2. Position a 4-3/4" x 2-5/8" 7902-S right sides together on a same size 7905-EG Background, exactly as shown. Diagonally stitch across the corner. Trim and press toward the Outer edge. Make 160.



3. Place another 4-3/4" x 2-5/8" 7902-S right sides together on the other end of the Step 2 unit. Diagonally stitch across the corner. Trim and press toward the previous press. Both seams go the same direction, and all are alike. Make 160.



4. Following the angles exactly as shown, place a 2-5/8" square of 7905-EG Background right side down at each end of the Step 3 units. Stitch diagonally. Trim. Press so all four seams are going the same direction. Make 160. Be mindful of the angles!



5. Stitch two Step 4 units together. The seams should 'nest'. Make 80. Press the center seam open. These units will measure 9" x 4-3/4" from raw edge to raw edge.



6. Cut the 9-3/4" squares of Blue 7901-B and Light Green 7909-G in fourths, like an 'X'. There are 6 of each, generating 24 triangles of each.



7. Stitch the Step 6 Triangles together into (12) 4-patch Triangle squares. They will measure 9" square from raw edge to raw edge.



8. Cut the 6-7/8" squares of Blue 7901-B and Light Green 7909-G diagonally in half. There are 8 of each, generating 16 triangles of each.



9. Stitch the Step 8 Triangles together into (7) pair with Green on the left and (7) pair with Green on the right. They will have the straight of grain on the long edge. There will be 2 triangles of each color left unstitched.



10. Cut the 7-1/4" squares of Dark Green 7902-G in fourths like an 'X'. These are for the outer edges of the quilt.



11. Using all the pieces made and cut so far, plus the 4-3/4" squares of Dark Green 7902-G, lay out the quilt. Stitch it together, taking care to not stretch any of the Bias pieces. Be mindful of the placement of the Step 9 Triangle Pairs. It should measure 72-1/2" x 90-1/2". (see diagram below)

12. Stitch the 3" strips of Background 7905-EG together, end to end. From them cut (2) 90-1/2" lengths for the sides and (2) 77-1/2" lengths for the top and bottom. Attach them to the quilt.

13. Stitch the 2" strips of Middle Border 7909-B together, end to end. From them cut (2) 95-1/2" lengths for the sides and (2) 80-1/2" lengths for the top and bottom. Attach them to the quilt.

14. Stitch the 4-1/2" strips of Outer Border 7907-S together, end to end. From them cut (2) 98-1/2" lengths for the sides and (2) 88-1/2" lengths for the top and bottom. Attach them to the quilt.

15. Prepare to quilt your masterpiece. You might want to outline the shapes and possibly stitch a feathered wreath in the large blocks.

16. After quilting, use the 2-1/2" strips of Binding, and follow the instructions with the Binding Miter Tool. See the Video Demo of this tool at www.animasquilts.com
